

SUBJ: Sears Employees - Photo Line-up

RE: Homicide Investigation of Adam WALSH

There were five Sears employees who were working July 27, 1981 in the vicinity of the toy department where Adam WALSH was last seen alive. These employees were not interviewed after October 1983 when Ottis TOOLE surfaced as a suspect, nor were they asked to view a photo line-up. Despite the passage of time it was felt that these two steps should still be taken.

The employees re-interviewed were: Richard CISNEROS - toy Department, Aurora DELGADO, John B. KING, and Joanna BRAUN - catalog department, Verna BARCLAY - garden department. None of the employees had anything to add to their original statements. When asked to view the lineup each was asked to look for anyone that they might have seen in the store, not necessarily on July 27, 1981, but also before or after that date. None of the witnesses made an identification of any photo.
