This writer along with Lieutenant R. Banks #0547, conducted a follow-up investigation in reference to the travels of OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE during the month of July 1981. The particular information had been received that on July 24, 1981 OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE had received assistance from the Salvation Army located in Newport News, Virginia. These writers traveled to Virginia in order to retrace the bus route and obtain any information that would be pertinent to this homicide investigation.

11-17-83 - 1600 HOURS

These writers made contact with Detective ROTH of the Newport News Police Department located in Newport News Virginia, phone number area code 804-247-8477.

Detective BILL ROTH had been contacted by DETECTIVE J. HOFFMAN with reference to certain records pertaining to OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE during the period of July 22 to the 24th, 1981. DETECTIVE ROTH had obtained a Search Warrant for records from the Riverside Hospital located in Newport News, Virginia. The undersigned requested assistance from DETECTIVE ROTH in conducting the follow-up investigation with respect to the travels of OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE on the above specified dates.

11-17-83 - 1830 HOURS

These writers then proceeded to the Greyhound Bus Station located at 9702 Jefferson Avenue, Newport News, Virginia. Contact was then made with the station manager identified as white male WILLIAM FRIZZELL, phone number area code 804-599-3900.

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MR. FRIZZEL was interviewed with respect to the bus company procedure when an individual was in fact given transportation paid for by the Salvation Army in Newport News, Virginia. MR. FRIZZELL went on to state that a check was issued by the Salvation Army and the individual requiring transportation would then present this ticket to the desk personnel at the bus station. Said ticket was made out to the Greyhound Bus Line and that once the individual received the ticket it was a non-transferable item. When asked if a person could use the ticket at a later date, MR. FRIZZELL stated that a person could get off at any stop along the way and re-board several days later utilizing the same ticket.

MR. FRIZZELL stated that he had no information with regards to the identities of the drivers and that information would have to be obtained from their main office in Arizona.

The bus leaving on this particular date would have traveled the following route: Newport News, Virginia to Richmond, Virginia; from Richmond to Raleigh, North Carolina, then on to Fayetteville, North Carolina making a stop in Savannah, Georgia and subsequently arriving in Jacksonville, Florida. At this time the undersigned returned to the Newport News, Virginia Police Department and a complete records check was conducted on OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE and HENRY LEE LUCAS. There was no record of contact with the local police department, sheriff's department, and no criminal history was on file with the State of Virginia pertaining to any misdemeanor or felony arrest of either individual.

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11-18-83 - 0915 HOURS

The undersigned then proceeded to the Salvation Army located at 5872 Jefferson Avenue, Newport News, Virginia, phone number, 804-245-2622. Contact was made with the receptionist identified as BETTY BURAK. MS. BURAK stated that on July 24, 1981 OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE had received a bus ticket from their agency. She went on to state that this transaction was handled by NANCY CHANDLER of 16 South 6th Street, Hampton, Virginia, area code 804-850-0257. It was further learned that NANCY CHANDLER is no longer employed by the Salvation Army and as stated in previous supplemental reports, telephone contact had been made with her reference to information regarding OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE.

BETTY BURAK advised the undersigned that in most cases individuals requiring traveler's aide would come to the Salvation Army for assistance. These writers looked at the records and it was determined that OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE had come in to their office requesting assistance to return to Jacksonville, Florida. He had used the address of 708 Day Avenue in Jacksonville, Florida listing his Social Security number [REDACTED]. Also on this transient record it was shown that a telephone call had been placed to MR. JOHN REED of the Southeastern Roofing Company, who was a past employer of OTTIS TOOLE. The call had been placed to Jacksonville, Florida at 3:20 P.M. on July 24, 1981 and said call had terminated after two minutes of conversation. The reason for this was to verify if MR. TOOLE would be re-employed back in Jacksonville.

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The copies of the Salvation Army Transient Record Forms, as well as the cancelled check made out to the Greyhound Company, and phone records will be forwarded to the Hollywood Police Department to become a permanent part of this investigation.

Previously NANCY CHANDLER had been interviewed by this agency and these writers attempted to re-contact her but there was no answer at her residence phone number. It was requested that BETTY BURAK attempt to contact her at a later date.

These writers again talked with BETTY BURAK and she advised that she had been in telephone contact with NANCY CHANDLER, but she could remember no further information with respect to OTTIS TOOLE.

1100 HOURS

These writers then made contact with STEVEN PAPA of the Penisular Rescue Mission located at 3700 Huntington Avenue, Newport News, Virginia, area code 804-380-6908. MR. PAPA was requested to check his records for the month of July and was unable to come up with any record pertaining to OTTIS TOOLE or HENRY LUCAS. MR. PAPA has been the resident manager of the Rescue Mission for the last ten years and was shown a photograph of OTTIS TOOLE but stated that he had never seen him before.

1145 HOURS

These writers then proceeded to the Riverside Hospital located at 500 J. Clyde Morris Avenue, Newport News, Virginia. These writers made contact with personnel in the Medical Records Division of the hospital and advised

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them that the records obtained previously by a Search Warrant had not arrived in Florida as of this date. They, at this time, allowed these writers to view the records on a Microfish Machine. It was learned that OTTIS TOOLE had been brought to the hospital by Father GRIFFIN of the Immaculate Conception Church in Hampton, Virginia. This occurred on 7-22-81 at 2000 hours. Mr. TOOLE had been found on the Church grounds and was complaining of being depressed, suicidal as well as being disoriented. Father GRIFFIN then transported OTTIS TOOLE to the medical facility where he was interviewed by the Crisis Counselor identified as SUZANNE HARRIS. Contact was then made with the Crisis Unit of the hospital and MS. JUDY WALKLEY was interviewed. MS. WALKLEY stated that MS. HARRIS was not working at this particular time but she would try to contact her at home. MS. WALKLEY then made telephone contact with SUZANNE HARRIS and asked her if she remembered OTTIS TOOLE. She stated that any and all information she would have obtained from the patient would in fact be on hospital records. She was unable to relate any further information with respect to OTTIS TOOLE. In reviewing the hospital records it was found that MR. TOOLE had been interviewed on July 22, 1981 and was released that evening around twelve midnight. Father GRIFFIN then transported MR. TOOLE to the Warrick Hotel located in downtown Newport News, Virginia and the Parish paid for one night's stay at the hotel. It should be noted that this hotel is one utilized for transient type individuals.

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On the following morning Father GRIFFIN then returned to the hotel and subsequently returned MR. TOOLE to the hospital where he was admitted. MR. TOOLE was admitted to the hospital on July 23, 1981 at 10:29 A.M. and was placed in the Psychiatric Unit of the hospital. He subsequently signed himself out of the hospital on the morning of July 24, 1981 at approximately 2:36 P.M. and did so against medical advice.

It was learned through these interviews that OTTIS TOOLE had been interviewed by DR. DONALD KILLIAN. Attempts were made to contact said doctor but it was learned that he was out of town and it was unknown when he would return to the hospital.

These writers reviewed the records in attempts to see whether or not MR. TOOLE had any personal property such as car keys, etc. and the only personal items listed on the hospital records were in fact a wallet that contained various pieces of miscellaneous papers and telephone numbers. It was also determined that MR. TOOLE was given no prescription or other medication once he left the hospital. It was shown that while staying in the hospital for the one day he received Dilantin, Phenobarbital, Navene. No other medication was given to MR. TOOLE.

This writer then telephonically contacted the Immaculate Conception Church located at 2150 Cunningham Drive, Hampton, Virginia attempting to locate Father GRIFFIN. This writer talked with Father BOB PERKINS and he stated that Father GRIFFIN was no longer at the Parish and had been transferred to the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart which was located in Richmond, Virginia.

1212 HOURS

Contact was then made with Father GRIFFIN in Richmond Virginia. Father GRIFFIN is now assigned to the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart Church located at 107 North Morris Street, Richmond, Virginia. Father GRIFFIN stated that he first came into contact with OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE on July 22, 1981 at approximately 1930 hours. Father GRIFFIN stated that one of the parishioners advised him of a white male that was in the bathroom of the Church Hall and at this point he proceeded to that location and made contact with MR. TOOLE. He stated that OTTIS TOOLE seemed to be very disoriented and stated that he was enroute from New York to Jacksonville, Florida. Father GRIFFIN felt through the conversation with OTTIS TOOLE that he was possibly in need of medical attention and was rambling on with respect to getting back to Jacksonville. Father GRIFFIN was not sure of the conversation in its entirety but felt that the individual was possibly suicidal due to his depressed condition. Father GRIFFIN further stated that an unknown parishioner advised him that a Police Officer unknown whether or not he was from the City, County or State, had dropped this individual off on the Church grounds. He, at this time along with another parishioner JOHN JOHNSON transported MR. TOOLE to the Riverside Hospital. They waited for approximately four hours during which time MR. TOOLE was interviewed by SUZANNE HARRIS of the Crisis Unit. They were unable to admit him at this particular point in time and Father GRIFFIN and MR. JOHNSON transported OTTIS TOOLE to the

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Warrick Hotel. The Church paid for one night's stay and on the following morning he again returned to the hotel and took MR. TOOLE back to the hospital. He was unable to relate any additional information with respect to OTTIS TOOLE, but only stated that several weeks ago he had seen a photograph in the local newspaper with respect to MR. TOOLE being in custody. The undersigned then returned to the Newport News Police Department and contact was then made with DETECTIVE HICKMAN of the Hollywood Police Department with respect to drivers information on the Greyhound Bus. From the information gathered previously with respect to the telephone call made by the Salvation Army to Jacksonville, Florida, at 3:20 P.M. on July 24, 1981 and lasting for approximately two minutes, several bus schedules could be eliminated at this particular time. It should be noted that the bus station is located approximately three miles from the Salvation Army and would have taken an individual twenty to twenty-five minutes to walk from that particular point. The Salvation Army personnel advised that once the necessary information was verified it would take a period of time for this information to be so noted and a check signed by the supervisors of that particular organization.

For this reason the bus departing at 4:00 P.M. on July 24, 1981 had been ruled out by the undersigned and it was felt that the 6:30 P.M. on said date was the one utilized by OTTIS TOOLE.

Contact with DETECTIVE HICKMAN was made and it was determined that the following drivers had driven the bus on that particular route.

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The only information available from Greyhound Bus Company was that a MR. FIGGERS had taken the bus from Newport News, Virginia to Richmond, Virginia. At this time MR. TOOLE would have had to get off this particular bus and re-board another one that was destined to stop in Raleigh, North Carolina. This bus was operated by a MR. INGRAM. The bus then continued on its route from Richmond, Virginia to Raleigh, North Carolina, Fayetteville, North Carolina, Savannah, Georgia and Jacksonville. The bus company records stated that a MR. ROBERTS handled the route from Richmond, Virginia to Jacksonville.

11-19-83 - 10:00 A.M.

The assigned made contact with Detective RAY WILLIAMS of the Richmond, Virginia Police Department located at 501 North 9th Street, Richmond, Virginia area code 804-780-8143. Detective WILLIAMS was apprised of the on-going investigation being conducted by the Hollywood Police Department and it was requested that he assist us.

Detective WILLIAMS was given the names of both OTTIS TOOLE and HENRY LUCAS and it was requested that he do a records check on these individuals. A local check as well as a State-wide criminal history was conducted with negative results.

Detective WILLIAMS contacted the Crisis Unit at the Hospital which at this time proved negative. Travelers Aid was called (804-643-0279) and was advised that no information would be available until the following Monday. Detective WILLIAMS also contacted the Medical College Hospital of Virginia,

1120 HOURS

These writers then proceeded to the Greyhound Bus Station located in downtown Richmond Virginia. Contact was made with the District Manager identified as W.E. CHADWELL, Jr. phone number 804-643-0173. MR. CHADWELL stated that one of the drivers identified as FRANK H. FIGGERS now resides at 346 Magnolia Avenue, Buena Vista, Virginia, phone number is 703-261-6533. MR. CHADWELL went on to state that in July of 1981 MR. FIGGERS did in fact drive the route from Newport News, Virginia to Richmond, Virginia but had subsequently been transferred to the western portion of Virginia. These writers attempted to contact FRANK FIGGERS but were unable to make contact with him. Arrangements will be made at a later date to forward a photograph of OTTIS TOOLE to the local police department to see whether or not this particular bus driver remembers OTTIS TOOLE or any unusual circumstances on the bus. MR. CHADWELL advised that the bus from Richmond, Virginia would then go to Raleigh, North Carolina and the driver would in fact be a MR. INGRAM who lives in the Raleigh, North Carolina area. He went on to state that subject ROBERTS is possibly working out of the Jacksonville Office.

1151 HOURS

These writers then proceeded to the Volunteers of America located at 1125 West Clay, Richmond, Virginia, phone number 804-359-3588.
