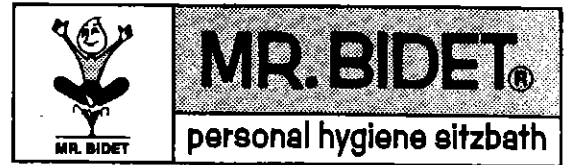

Dear Lt. Hynds:

With reference to the above subject, the following idea is submitted in the event that same has not already been considered.

The person(s) who abducted Adam Walsh may have purchased gas or other items at Sears during the time period before the incident occurred. If so, there is the possibility such a purchase may have been paid for with a Sears charge card, personal check or cash where the customer's name and address was taken. In that event, Sears' records should be able to document that occurrence. Even if that theory did not prove out, you would be provided with a partial list of persons who were at the Sears scene of the crime during that time period. Obviously, if all such persons have not come forth to identify themselves to date, your department would be able to now contact them for questioning.

The preceding theory could also be expanded to include other stores in the Mall during the time period in question, and also gas stations on the Turnpike. It's too bad the Florida Turnpike does not document tag numbers of all vehicles using that highway.
