(1) observed the suspect vehicle come eastbound on Eaton Street. Victims number (1), (2), and (3) were walking in front of 7481 Eaton Street when the suspect vehicle pulled into the driveway one house east of 7481 Eaton Street. The suspect vehicle then backed out and headed westbound on Eaton Street, stopping in front of the three victims, at which time the suspect stopped the Van, and inside the Van he stood up and the three victims then observed that the suspect had no pants on, and his male organs were fully exposed to them and he had also played with his penis. At this time the suspect vehicle then continued east on Eaton Street where the victims lost sight of it. Victim number (1) further related that after the incident had happened, the suspect vehicle then rode by them again, however, did not expose himself at that time. They then went to the Boulevard Heights Elementary School, where they spoke to the Summer Coordinator, white female, McLOUGHLIN, SIOBHAN, of 110 South 56th Avenue, Hollywood. Date of birth is 9/16/57. Victim number (1) then related to the Summer Counselor, the incident that had happened to them on their way to school that morning. At this time Miss McLOUGHLIN then put the three victims in her car to search the area, at which time they observed the suspect vehicle parked in front of a residence, located at 7271 McArthur Parkway. At this time the victims along with Miss McLOUGHLIN observed that the Van was unoccupied. They then went around the block and circled back to the house and observed the Van to be gone. At this time the victims along with Miss McLOUGHLIN then went back to the Boulevard Heights Elementary School and telephoned police.

Victim number (1) and Miss McLOUGHLIN also advised of a green truck that was parked in the driveway when they had drove by this morning and observed the suspect vehicle. Miss LATORRE advised that the white male suspect had gone inside the residence and was in there for awhile and then came out and left. the other white male all day long. The white male denied that he had done such a thing and also that there must be a mixup. After being apprised of the incident, MRS. CONLEY then placed the children into her vehicle and drove throughout the neighborhood in attempts of locating the suspect vehicle. This met with negative results and the witness then transported the children to the Boulevard Heights Elementary School located at 72nd
