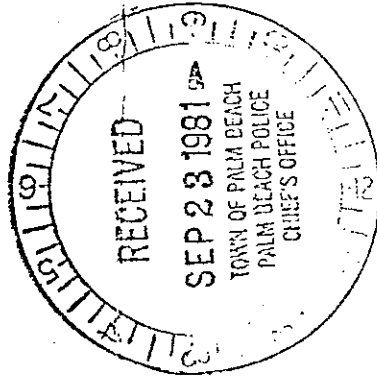

I dont know Toby ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ last name or address but I understand that he lives in a three or 4 story building on the side street that Saint Edwards rectory is on in PB. He , I understand lives on the top floor.

Details: On 9/23/81 at approximately 9:15am, I received a letter and envelope from Chief Terlizzese for the purpose of obtaining possible latent prints from same. I processed these items for possible latent fingerprints with chemical ninhydrin, which reacts to amino acids present in perspiration. On 9/24/81 at approximately 9:30am, I examined two partial latent prints which had developed on the letter, and compared them with the standard inked impressions of Chief Terlizzese and his secretary, Marian Crook, the only known persons handling the letter. It is my opinion that the two partial latent prints obtained do not match the inked impressions of Chief Terlizzese or Secretary Crook. It should be noted that the two partial latent prints obtained are of questionable value, as they contain only seven to ten points of identification. (approximately) Other partial impressions did develop on the letter, however they were of no value as they do not contain any ridge detail. The envelope itself was not compared at this time, as it was handled by U.S. mail employees and possibly by other unknown persons prior to its delivery at police headquarters. It will be maintained in the event a suspect is identified, for comparison purposes at that time. Photographs of the envelope, letter, and latent fingerprints were taken by this officer.

Details: 11:00 AM: I was instructed by Captain Shetron to do follow-up investigation on a letter received by Chief Terlizzese from an unidentified citizen pertaining to possible information on unsolved homicide.

11:10 AM: I phoned the Episcopal Churches in West Palm Beach in an attempt to determine at what church the group called Acceptance meets at and I met with negative results.

Noon: I telephoned Crisis Line in an attempt to obtain any information on the group known as Acceptance and met with negative results. I was advised a homosexual alcoholics anonymous group known as "Live and Let Live" meets at Holy Trinity Episcopal Church, 622 South Olive Avenue, WPB, Fla.

12:20 PM: I phoned Holy Trinity Church, 655-8650 and was advised the group has not met there for the past several months and are currently meeting at Community United Church of Christ, 730 5th Street, Lake Park, Florida.

1:15 PM: I phoned the above-mentioned church, 848-3003 and was informed that the group meets every Thursday evening at 8:00 PM and the subject to contact for information concerning the group is Gary Hanna, 1501 Crescent Circle, Apartment #E-44, Lake Park, Florida 844-7854.

2:30 PM: I arrived at Mr. Hanna's residence and was unable to make contact. A message was left with the manager Mrs. Becky Frandser to have Mr. Hanna contact me at his earliest convenience.

4:00 PM: I received a phone call from Mr. Hanna and at this time arrangements were made to interview him tomorrow morning 9-24-81 at 10:00 AM at his residence.

Thursday September 24, 1981 @ 10:00 AM:

Sgt. Croft and I arrived at Mr. Hanna's residence and obtained the following information. He advised that he had met the subject known as Toby approximately ten months ago at a group meeting. Mr. Hanna stated he had heard of the group known as Acceptance but he was not a member. Mr. Hanna advised a subject known as Charles Beck belongs to Acceptance and may have additional information. Beck is employed as a butler by some family in Palm Beach.

Mr. Hanna stated that the name Toby is a pen name and the subject using that name is a poet. Hanna does not know the subject's real name. Hanna stated that Toby lives in Palm Beach, address unknown and supposedly drives a older white van, year and make unknown.

Mr. Hanna stated that Toby generally makes all the meetings generally being held by the Live and Let Live Organization and he is expected to attend tonight's meeting.

Hanna will attempt to obtain additional information pertinent to Toby and he will contact me.

Friday, September 25, 1981 at 9:10 AM:

I received a phone call from Hanna requesting I meet with him at the park at U.S.1 and Park Avenue in Lake Park,

9:40 AM:

I arrived at the above-mentioned park and I met with Hanna who related the following information. After Sgt. Croft and I left him yesterday, he gave a lot of thought as to why we were interested in Toby and he went to church this morning to seek God's guidance as to what he should do. Mr. Hanna asked me if we were looking for Toby because of the incident

that happened several months ago where the little boy was kidnapped and then they located his head somewhere north of here. I advised Hanna we received information that Toby might be involved in that offense and we are investigating that possibility.

Mr. Hanna advised that he recalls seeing the photograph of the suspect on television and it closely resembled Toby. It should be noted at this time the photograph Mr. Hanna referred to probably the composite likeness that Hollywood Police Department broadcast. Mr. Hanna advised several days after seeing the photograph he had coffee with Toby and mentioned the photograph to him and advised him that if he had anything to do with it, he should contact the police department. Mr. Hanna stated that Toby said, "That's not me", and would not discuss the matter any further.

Mr. Hanna stated he was wrong when he stated Toby had a white van and he stated it is a blue van and he believes it has windows on the rear doors. Hanna advised the tag on Toby's van is POET and he has had the tag for the past four or five months.

Hanna described Toby as 5'7", to 5'8", 170-175 lbs. light complexion, curly blonde hair, small mustache, smooth complexion, 25-30 years of age, speaks with a New England accent and dresses in ivy league style.

Toby is self-employed and sells threads. Hanna is unsure if Toby sells material, clothes or anything similar.

Mr. Hanna has not seen Toby for two weeks and believes he is presently at some sort of retreat at an unknown location. Hanna further stated he believes that Toby at one time had a business in Massachusetts under the name of TOBY T.

Mr. Hanna was unable to supply the correct name of Toby and advised he

lives in Palm Beach in a three story house location is unknown. Hanna is going to attempt to obtain additional information pertinent to Toby and then will contact me.

Mr. Hanna advised the reason he is supplying information on Toby is that if he is involved in this offense he should receive some sort of medical help and if he is not involved he should have all suspicion erased.

12:10 PM:

A record's check on Florida tag POET shows it is registered to George Nicholas, 612 NW 12th Avenue, Miami, Florida on a 1959 four-door Rolls Royce, phone number obtained from directory assistance for Nicholas is 324-5557.

1:45 PM:

I attempted to contact Nicholas at the above-mentioned phone number and I was unable to make contact with him, message was left for Nicholas to contact me at his earliest convenience.

2:10 PM:

I phoned Miss Alice Walsh, Division of Corporation, Secretary of Commonwealth, Boston, Mass. 617-727-2850 and was advised there is no corporation known as TOBY T. Miss Walsh advised the company might not have been licensed through the State but could possibly have been licensed through a Town or City and not incorporated through the State.

2:30 PM:

A check through our electrician showed a Charles Beck employed at the Dreitzer residence at the Palm Beach Towers. I attempted to contact Mr. Beck, 655-2818 and was informed all calls were being taken at 212-752-1197.

2:50 PM:

I phoned Mr. Beck at the above New York phone number and was informed he had met subject Toby at an Acceptance Meeting and the last time he saw him was sometime in the Spring at Howard Johnsons Restaurant in West Palm Beach, Florida and Mr. Beck believes that Toby was driving an older VW van red and white in color. Beck could not supply any additional information pertinent to Toby and stated that the group Acceptance is supposed to be an anonymous group and therefore would not give any additional information.

3:40 PM:

I phoned Mr. Nichols 324-5557 and was informed that he does not know anyone named Toby and the tag Poet is still attached to his vehicle. Mr. Nicholas could not supply any additional information which would assist in this investigation.

Monday, September 28, 1981:

A phone message was received showing Mr. Hanna had phoned this department on Saturday 9-26-81 at approximately 3:30 AM. advising the tag on Toby's vehicle is a green tag with white letters and is possibly a Connecticut tag.

A record's check of Connecticut tag POET shows it is registered to David M. Schwartz, 68 Binney Lane, Old Greenwich, Conn. on a 1974 Triumph Spitfire convertible.

11:00 AM:

I phoned Mr. Hanna, 844-7854 and attempted to obtain additional information pertinent to the tag Poet. Hanna stated he is sure the tag is green with white letters.



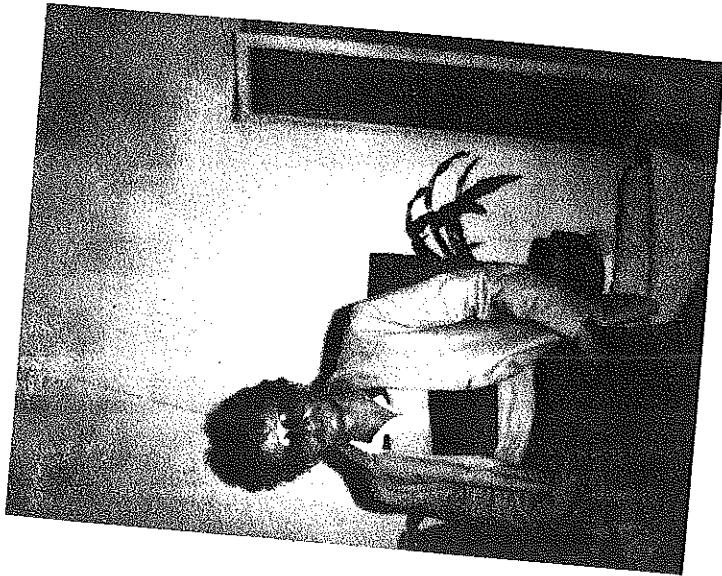
