The following will be a voluntary taped statement taken from JOHN TERRY, W/M DOB 3/4/26, whose permanent address is in Johnson City, Tenn. the Mountain Home Tenn. Old Soldiers Home. MR. TERRY has been in the South Florida area for approximately 5 weeks. Two of those weeks he spent at Lake City, Florida at the Veterans Administration Hospital. The remaining three weeks MR. TERRY spent in the Broward County Jail in Ft. Lauderdale, Broward County, Florida. Mr. TERRY advised he possesses certain information possibly relevant to the investigation of the murder of ADAM WALSH on or about Monday 7/27/81 at approximately 12:00 noon according to the City of Hollywood, Broward County, Florida. This statement is being obtained by DET. R. HICKMAN #0434 and DET. SGT. J. B. SMITH #0401 of the Hollywood Police Dept. This statement obtained from MR. TERRY is being obtained at the Deerfield Beach Florida Police Dept. commencing on Wednesday 11/25/81 at approximately 9:51 P.M.

Q. MR. TERRY, before I obtain this statement from you by virtue of my commission as a Notary, Republic at large in and for the State of Florida, I am going to place you under oath for your testimony. Do you understand what it is to be placed under oath?

A. Yes

Q. Would you raise your right hand. Do you solemnly swear the information you are about to relate in this statement at this time is the truth the whole truth so help you God?

A. Yes

Q. Would you for the record MR. TERRY state your complete given name, your date of birth and where you presently are residing?

A. My name is JOHN R. TERRY

Q. Your date of birth sir?

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Q. And where are you presently staying?

A. I had presently raised a family....

Q. Are you living anywhere in Florida right now or are you at large in Florida?

A. No, I just come here just because I got tired of the V.A. I just come down and I'm on my way back.

Q. Would that be back to Johnson City, Tenn.?

A. Yes

Q. Can you read and write and understand the English language?

A. Yes I received a GED at the age of 45. I know how to read and write.

Q. How old are you right now sir?

A. 55

Q. That was 10 years ago?

A. Right

MR. JOHN RUSSELL TERRY HAVING APPEARED BEFORE ME A NOTARY PUBLIC AT LARGE IN AND FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA HAVING BEEN DULY SWORN DEPOSES AND STATES:

Q. MR. TERRY we would like to know what knowledge you have concerning an individual that you named to me as being an EDWARD JAMES that you met in the Broward County Jail in Ft. Lauderdale, Broward County, Florida some time after the 17th day of November, 1981. The information that you have been giving to us is that you met this man in the Broward County Jail and he had certain information that he related to you that you thought might be relevant to investigation of a homicide of a young boy in south Florida, is that correct?

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A. Yes and the child's name I did not know.

Q. Direct what information this individual JAMES told you concerning this. Did he tell you how he got into jail to begin with?

A. Yes

Q. Start right from there and just tell us the whole thing?

A. He said that he wasthey had raised the rent on his apartment and he was in the process of looking for another rental, a place to live, a cheaper place cause they raised it \$100.00 on a month only or something, like \$280.00 or something. I forget what dates and what....I mean numbers that he gave me and in the process of checking out the want ads in the paper for apartments he...there was a bunch of children. Not only just this boy, there was other kids there you know. That's what he says it. He says there was other children there and he said that he'd had his car in the shop that day.

Q. What kind of a car did he say they owned?

A. He owned a Plymouth Fury

Q. Did he mention the year?

A. '63, '63 Plymouth Fury III alright and he said that it was making a noise click, click, click. So he stopped the car right where the kids were and he got out and he took his feet and he kicked the hubcap to make them be tighter so the wheel cover, you know so it wouldn't be click, clicking you know making that noise you know and he said this kid come up to me...to him and he said he was a very attractive young boy 5-4-5-6-7 years old. I can't remember the age but he said he had a beautiful haircut and attractive you

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know and he said "where are you going". He said well I'm going up here to the store to buy some ice cream and he said "well I'm going with you" and he said the kid opened the door and jumped in the car on his own. That what he said. He said he drove two or three blocks and he said not over here he said I got no business with you in this car and he opened the door and he made the kid get out and when he made the kid get out, he went on and parked his car at his home and walked to the convenient or the 7-11 or which ever was closest by where he lived. I don't know exactly where he lived, he lived behind a bus station. I'm fairly acquainted with Pompano a little bit and he said when he come back, he had two bags of groceries in his hand and he said there was about 8 policemen there waiting for him and he got in jail and he don't know why and he's there and he don't know.

Q. Did he at one time tell you that that case was nothing to compared to one he was actually involved in?

A. No, he said he's always been doing these to kids. He said he'd always been good to kids. He said he's been divorced. He said he had a grandson two years old and a son 25 years old and he'd loved .. children and that he had molested no children.

Q. What did he actually tell you about killing a child?

A. He said the child threated him because he was good to the kids. He said he had bought him Burger King and he had bought him ice cream and he bought him everything thatthe kid threatened him and he wanted money from him and then he said "I'm gonna have to do away with you boy" you know.

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Q. Did he ever mention how old this boy was?

A. Around 5 or 6 years old, he didn't say. I don't know, I wasn't even here.

Q. I realize that. Did he mention where he got this boy from, where he picked him up?

A. In Jacks Ice Cream Parlor in Hollywood Shopping Center, something like that.

Q. Did he mention when this happened?

A. I can't remember them dates.

Q. I'm not asking if he gave you date. Did he mention about how long ago this happened?

A. Several months

Q. What did he say he would do to the boy when he killed him, how did he kill him?

A. He said he cut his God Damm head off.

Q. And where is the boy's body?

A. He said he took it out in the field.

Q. Did he mention approximately where?

A. Where theyou know when you come south from Stuart down that way you know, you know where all that...where all those sulpher you know and stuff...mines and stuff is in there. Part was left here and part was left there.

Q. Where did he put the head?

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A. In the canal

Q. The best you can recollect of what he was saying to you when he was talking about the boy from Hollywood, tell us in your own words just from the beginning all the way through just what you remember he told you?

A. He said that the boy told him he said, "you take me back within a block of my house and he said you give me \$500.00 or he said your ass is mud you know he said and I didn't have the money. He said I didn't even have the money in the savings and he said I couldn't even have got it you know.

Q. What did he say he did then?

A. He said he ripped his God damm head off is what he said he done. That's why I'm here telling it.

Q. Did he say how he ripped his head off?

A. He had one of those knives with a holster.

Q. You are indicating he had knife on his belt?

A. Yeh

Q. In a knife holder?

A. Yeh, something

Q. Did he say where he was when he cut his head off?

A.It wasn't at the bridge, it was out the bridge. There is a place where you pull off the bridge, pull a car off the bridge in the woods like and here is the canal running this ...or this or which ever ever way it goes you know.

Q. So he said he pulled his car off from a bridge, he pulled off into a

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wooded area by a canal?

A. Yes

Q. And that's where he said he cut this boy's head off?

A. Right.

Q. What did he say he did with the head at that time?

A. And he took it by the hair of the head and took it held it like a football and he said he kicked it just as far out in the middle of the water he could throw it.

Q. What did he say he did with the body?

A. He said he carried it on down the road down there where that there uh..

Q. Sulpher mines are?

A. Sulpher mines are you know and that's where the remains.

Q. Did he say he buried it there or did he just throw it into the....?

A. He didn't go into details. He got all kinds of way.

Q. What condition were you in when he was telling you all this?

A. I was in good condition. I've been sober 12 days, 13 days.

Q. What kind of condition was he in, was he in good condition?

A. No he wasn't

Q. Why?

A. Well he just faced the floor and just talked about the body all the time, talked about the head all the time, talked about the kid all the time. He never talked about the robbery or the other...or the parents that was planning against him.

Q. You mentioned that he got very excited when he was telling you about

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this, is that correct?

A. Yes

Q. And would you explain that for us, what you were saying?

A. You mean when he got very excited about it?

Q. Yeh?

A. Yeh he got very excited. He said yeh God Damm you , you tell them nothing. You'll tell momma, you'll tell daddy nothing, yeh he says, you'll nobody nothing.

Q. Did he mention exactly how he killed the boy. I mean was it just cuttin the head off or did he do something else to kill him?

A. He was telling he cut his God Damm head off and throwed it God Damm and he said I held it up higher than the head and held it like a football and took a kicked it out in the middle of the canal.

Q. Why did he say he picked this boy up?

A. Because the boy was pressing him for...

Q. No when he first met the boy, why did he say he took him with him?

A. He took him, he had him with goodies.

Q. You said before it was ice cream?

A. Yeh right, right, right

Q. Did he have ever talk much about the type of an area where he got the boy from?

A. He said there was ...he said there was kinda new shopping center in Hollywood that had about maybe 8 or 10 stores in it there and he said he used

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to go there and just look around and roam around you know and see who he could pick up because he said he was a woman hater because he had lived with his wife 20 years and found out that she was living with a guy who was 13 years younger than she was and that they were shacking up in some trailer park in Deerfield out here off of Hillsboro out here. I used to live on 51st St. over here, I owned a home over there. I know the area there you know

Q. What car was he using when he picked that little boy up.

A. Plymouth

Q. You said something before that he mentioned that there was no blood in the car. Would you tell us what he was saying about that?

A. He says he was gonna make sure there was no blood in the car.

Q. Did he say how he made sure of that?

A. No

Q. Did you believe when he was telling you this that he was being truthful?

A. I believe it enough that I walked all the way from Sambos here to talk to the chief of police here who I do know personally to talk to him about and I got money to ride the bus. But I walked here and I stopped and I said I thought about this. Should I say something about it or shouldn't I say something about it you know. Should I let it go or shouldn't I let it go. Shouldn't I get involved or should I get involved you know. I have bone marrow cancer, I don't know how long I am going to live and to me it don't matter a Godd Damm you know but I'm telling you the facts what the man told me here is a fact and I'll sign it if you believe it or don't believe it and

Q. But you don't know of anyone other than yourself that he told?

A. No, no I don't

Q. How many days were you actually in that cell with him JOHN?

A. Three

Q. Three days?

A. Three days

Q. Did he talk to you right away to you down there or did he wait a day?

A. He didn't wait 30 seconds

Q. Did he ever mention about any detectives coming up there and talking to him about this boy?

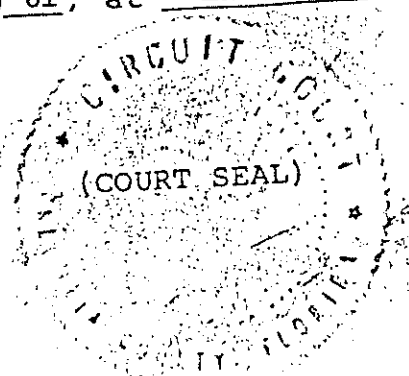
