Dear Mr. Smith:

On January 19, 1995 our laboratory received from you the following five (5) items of evidence:

- 1) Box of tape from machete
- 2) Machete and sheath
- 3) Envelope of taped debris from machete
- 4) Carpet standard
- 5) Standard of A.W. head hair

Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) extractions were conducted on stains found on the machete (Item #2); however, no detectable DNA of human origin was obtained. PCR analysis with HLA DQ $\alpha$  produced no results. No additional comparisons have been made in this analysis since no results were obtained from the primary item of interest. The remainder of the packaging and evidence is enclosed.
