REFERENCE:

This report is in reference to a vehicle processing done by the Jacksonville Crime Scene Unit as requested by Detective Jack Hoffman of the Hollywood Police Department.

SCENE:

On October 20, 1983, the Crime Scene Unit went to the Wells Brothers Used Car Lot located at 4334 Brentwood Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida. Parked on the lot was a white 1971 Cadillac Sedan de Ville, VIN 683491Q134601 and bearing no license tag.

On October 31, 1983, the vehicle was delivered to the Jacksonville Regional Crime Laboratory at 120 Platen Road, Jacksonville, Florida for further processing.

ASSISTANCE RENDERED:

On October 20, 1983 the interior of the vehicle was processed for serological and microanalytical evidence. The seats, carpets, and trunk were sprayed with luminol, a chemical presumptive test for trace amounts of blood.

ASSISTANCE RENDERED (cont.):

On November 2, 1983, the interior and exterior of the vehicle was photographed. The interior carpets were removed for further luminol spraying and collection of serological and microanalytical evidence. The vehicle was then given to the Latent Print Section for processing.

ITEMS COLLECTED:

The following items were collected on October 20, 1983:

- 1- Hairs collected from backrest area of front passenger seat
- 2- Vacuum sweepings from front seat and floor area
- 3- Vacuum sweepings from rear seat and floor area

DISPOSITION OF ITEMS:

All items were turned over to the Evidence Intake Section for distribution.

Items 1 through 6 were assigned to the Microanalysis Section of the Tallahassee Regional Crime Laboratory.

Items 7 through 14 were assigned to the Serology Section of the Jacksonville Regional Crime Laboratory.

DISPOSITION OF ITEMS (cont.):

Results of the examinations will be the subject of a separate report by the appropriate section.

REMARKS:

On October 20, 1983 the spraying of luminol gave positive indications on the left front and left rear interior floorboard carpets. These non-descript areas were photographed and sketched.

On November 2, 1983 the carpets were re-examined with the application of luminol. The areas of luminescence were photographed and samples were taken. A report on the results of the luminol sprayings will be issued from the Serology Section of this laboratory.

Four (4) rolls of 120mm and one (1) roll of 35mm color negative film were used to photograph the scene.

The film will be developed by laboratory personnel and the negatives retained in the files of this department.





This report has reference to Hollywood Police Department case number 81-56073. On October 25, 1983 the Crime Scene Section of the Sanford Regional Crime Laboratory responded to a request by Captain Steve Davis to search for the buried body of Adam Walsh.

SCENE:

The scene was located northeast of the 126 mile marker on the north side of the Florida Turnpike.

ASSISTANCE RENDERED:

The area was searched for signs of a gravesite and arrangements made with the United States Department of Agriculture to utilize a ground radar.

REMARKS:

Visual examination and use of probe rods revealed no suspected gravesites. Several areas where the ground radar indicated underground disturbances were examined with negative results.



RESULTS:

Exhibits #7 thru #14

The "carpets and padding from the front and rear floorboards of the 1971 White Cadillac Sedan de Ville" were treated with luminol, a presumptive chemical test for bloodstaining. Areas of strongly persistent luminescence were noted on the portion of "carpet from driver's side", on the portion of "carpet from left rear floorboard", and on the "padding underneath the carpet from left rear floorboard". These results as well as separate chemical tests demonstrated the presence of a trace of bloodstaining on these carpets and padding. There was an insufficient amount of blood for further tests.

Exhibit #15

Chemical tests on the blade edge of the "machette" demonstrated the presence of a trace of bloodstaining in a quantity that was insufficient for further testing.

Chemical tests for bloodstaining on the "canvas sheath" were inconclusive.

REMARKS:

Debris from the "machette blade" and from the "canvas sheath" will be forwarded to the Microanalysis section of the Tallahassee Regional Crime Laboratory. Results of their analysis and the disposition of the evidence will be the subject of a separate report.



RESULTS:

The "carpets and padding from the front and rear floorboards of the 1971 White Cadillac Sedan de Ville" were treated with luminol, a presumptive chemical test for bloodstaining. Areas of strongly persistent luminescence were noted on the portion of "carpet from driver's side", on the portion of "carpet from left rear floorboard", and on the "padding underneath the carpet from left rear floorboard". These results as well as separate chemical tests demonstrated the presence of a trace of bloodstaining on these carpets and padding. There was an insufficient amount of blood for further tests.

Exhibit #15

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Chemical tests for bloodstaining on the "canvas sheath" were inconclusive.

REMARKS:

Debris from the "machette blade" and from the "canvas sheath" will be forwarded to the Microanalysis section of the Tallahassee Regional Crime Laboratory. Results of their analysis and the disposition of the evidence will be the subject of a separate report.

The evidence in question was in fact submitted to the Jacksonville Laboratory in October and November, 1983 and then several items were transferred to the Tallahassee Laboratory for analysis:

Submission 01 and 03 were transferred to Tallahassee on November 8, 1983 via certified mail, #P276000227.

Submission 04 was transferred to Tallahassee on November 23, 1983, via certified mail, #P276000241.

Submission 06 was transferred to Tallahassee on November 21, 1983, via certified mail, #P446862136.

After reviewing the complete documentation in both the Micro and Latent case files it is clear that all the evidence that was transferred to Tallahassee Regional Crime Laboratory was returned to the Hollywood Police Department on February 11, 1984. This is documented by US Postal Return Receipt (# 191905) that is attached to the Micro case file. The package was signed for by someone named *Sykes* (initials ineligible).

Writer also spoke with Bureau Chief Steve Platt, on this date, reference the same case number and inquired as to what documentation that they had on any submissions from the case (#831043357) that were analyzed in the Jacksonville Regional Laboratory. He informed me that all items that were submitted to the Jacksonville Laboratory had also been returned. The returns had either been by registered mail with return receipts or were returned to a Detective Buddy Tearey, Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (now retired). He further stated that he has had two other inquiries about the case in the past several weeks from the Hollywood Police Department and informed them of this same information.

Writer was unable to contact SA Hobbs on this date (1/30/95) as he was out of the office until Tuesday, January 31, 1995. I will attempt to contact him then and provide him with the findings of this inquiry.

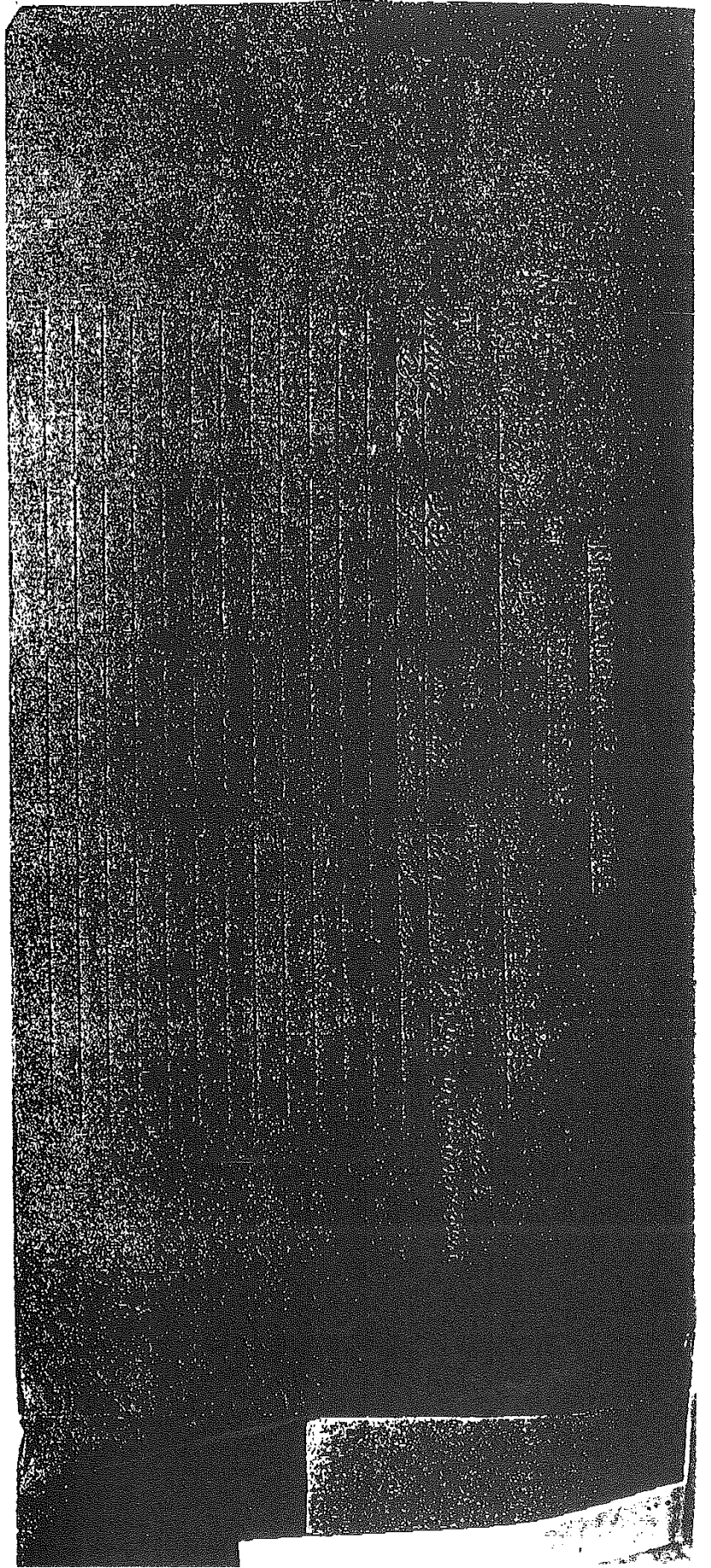
