The following will be a voluntary sworn statement reference to an abduction/homicide that occurred on or about July 27th, 1981, occurring at the Sears Mall, located at 300 Hollywood Mall, in the City of Hollywood, County of Broward, State of Florida. This statement is being taken by Detective J. Hoffman #0038 of the Hollywood Police Department. This statement is being obtained from witness KNIGHT, EILEEN, DOB: 5-12-44 who resides at 498 Branscomb Road, Green Cove, Springs, Florida, telephone 904-282-4012.

Prior to taking your statement Miss Knight are you aware that it is a crime under the Florida State Statutes to knowingly furnish false information while under oath?

A. Yes.

Q. At this time I'm gonna place you under oath by virtue of my commission as a Notary Public for the State of Florida, Broward County. At this time will you please raise your right hand. (Let the record reflect that the witnesses right hand is raised) Eileen Knight do you solemnly swear to tell the truth the whole truth and nothing but the truth so help you God?

A. Yes.

EILEEN KNIGHT HAVING APPEARED BEFORE ME A NOTARY PUBLIC FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA, BROWARD COUNTY, AND HAVING BEEN DULY SWORN DEPOSES AND STATES:

Q. For the record would you please state your complete given name, date of birth and home address.

A. Ah EILEEN KNIGHT, May 12, 1944, 498 Branscomb Road, Green Cove Springs Florida.

Q. What is your place of employment maam?

A. Southeastern Color Coat.

Q. Okay and how long have you been so employed here?

A. Four years.

Q. Four years. And what is your position with the company?

A. I'm the bookkeeper and office manager.

Q. Okay. Ah I'd like to recall your attention to an individual known to

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this agency as OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE. Did you know such an individual?

A. Yes I did.

Q. And was he employed by Southeast Color Coat at one time?

A. Yes he was.

Q. Okay do you recall the time period that he was employed there?

A. Ah he was employed from 76 through 1981.

Q. Okay now do you what was his position with the company?

A. He was a laborer.

Q. Laborer.

A. Uh huh.

Q. And your company is a roofing company?

A. We are a roofing contractor.

Q. Okay. Now his job as a laborer, would he require any type of tools to do his work?

A. Ah, basically the tools that would furnished by the company such as shovels, ah, wheelbarrows, ah things of that nature.

Q. Okay ah, let me ask you this. In past occasions have those type of tools ah turned up missing at times?

A. Of course, these are expendable tools as far as we're concerned because they are tools that don't last a long time and that ah have a tendency to just be left on the job of walk off the job with employees ah, you know just go missing in general.

Q. So it wouldn't be difficult for an employee such as Mr. TOOLE to ah remove a shovel from the companies equipment room?

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A. No it would not.

Q. Okay are there any other type of tools that OTTIS TOOLE may have used other than a shovel?

A. Ah yes I'm sure there probably is such as you know crowbars and anything that ah, any type of hand tools that would be used to tear off an old roof or in a clean up operation.

Q. Do you know if any type of bladed instrument may be used by the company? Such as large knives or anything like that?

A. Ah, that I'm not familiar enough with. You'd probably have to talk to some of the men on the job. We do use an assortment of hand tools you know but ah...

Q. Right, okay fine. Alright during the time period that you have known Mr. TOOLE have you ever seen him operating any vehicles?

A. Ah no I have not.

Q. Okay let me ask you this. Do you have any knowledge if he would have any keys to ah, ah, the compound located over at R.G. GAY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY? At one time did he work for them?

A. Ah yes I believe OTTIS has worked for R.G. Gay before but as far as having any keys I would not think that he would have any you know access to any keys in their facility.

Q. That's just your opinion?

A. Right, uh huh.

Q. You don't have total knowledge if he was there and maybe cleaned up the office or anything like that and had tools to the compound or anything?

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A. No he cleaned up our office here also but he didn't you know he didn't have access to keys or anything.

Q. Okay and you're not familiar with any vehicle that he may have owned or operated while he was working for your company?

A. Ah no he did not.

Q. Okay. According to the record I have obtained, ah it indicated that OTTIS' last date or last week of employment was June 4, 1981.

A. Yes that was the last pay period he worked here.

Q. Okay. Since that date okay, right after that date ah, during the same calendar year had he ever returned ah to obtain his job back.

A. Ah he would call in off and on and you know talk to some of the people here in the office and he would tell JOHN that he was coming back to work because he wanted to come back and pay him the money that he had borrowed from him but ah...

Q. How much money did he borrow from JOHN?

A. Four hundred dollars.

Q. Do you know what the purpose of that \$400 dollars was for?

A. Ah to bury his ah mother, funeral expenses.

Q. I see okay. But if he did return to work you would have records of him showing him returning to work?

A. He came back in December of 81 and worked one day.

Q. December of 81 so he didn't work for Southeast Color Coat from June of 81 until December of '81.

A. Right.

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Q. I see okay fine.

A. And then he worked one day and we haven't, you know he never came back.

Q. Did his brother work for your company?

A. Which brother, Howard, both HOWARD and VERNON have worked for our company.

Q. And they are no longer employed by your company?

A. Ah HOWARD isn't no.

Q. Is VERNON?

A. Yes.

Q. Is he ah working today?

A. Ah I don't have any idea, he usually is.

Q. Okay fine. Well I appreciate that Eileen and thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Is there anything else you would like to add to your statement at this time concerning this incident?

A. Ah no.

Q. Has everything ^{you said} in your statement been the complete truth as you know it to be?

A. Yes it is.
