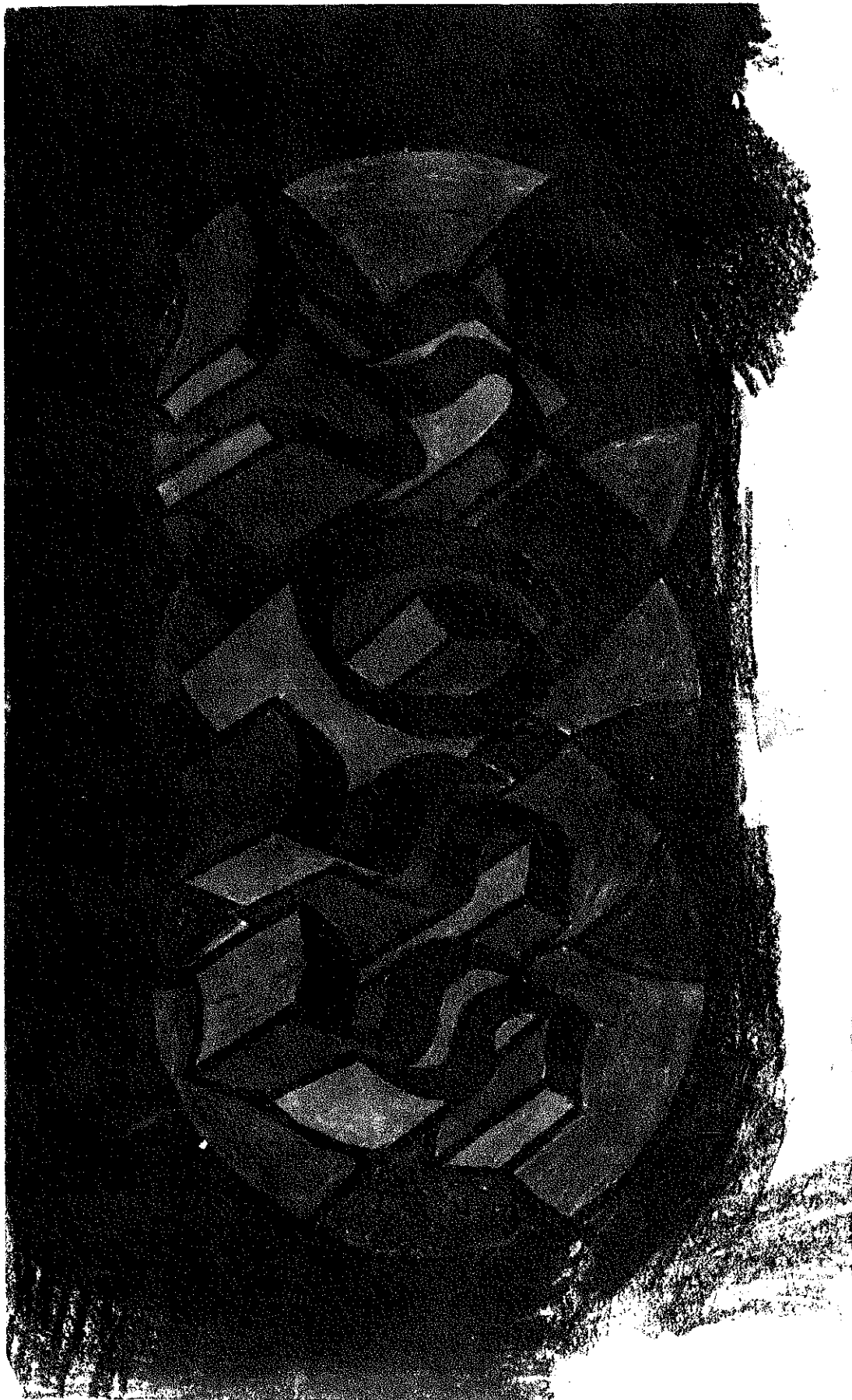

UPON ARRIVAL CONTACT WAS MADE WITH A W/M RONNIE WAYNE CARROLL A 17 YEAR OLD, WHO ADVISED THIS OFFICER HE HAD CERTAIN INFORMATION CONCERNING THE ADAM WALSH CASE. UPON INITIAL CONTACT WITH CARROLL HE ADVISED HIS NAME WAS ALANZO WILLIAMS, AND AFTER FURTHER CONVERSATION CARROLL REVEALED HIS TRUE IDENTITY. 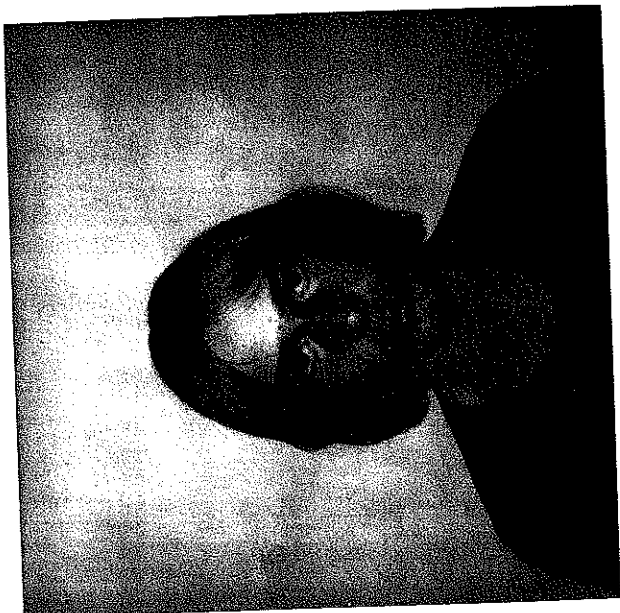
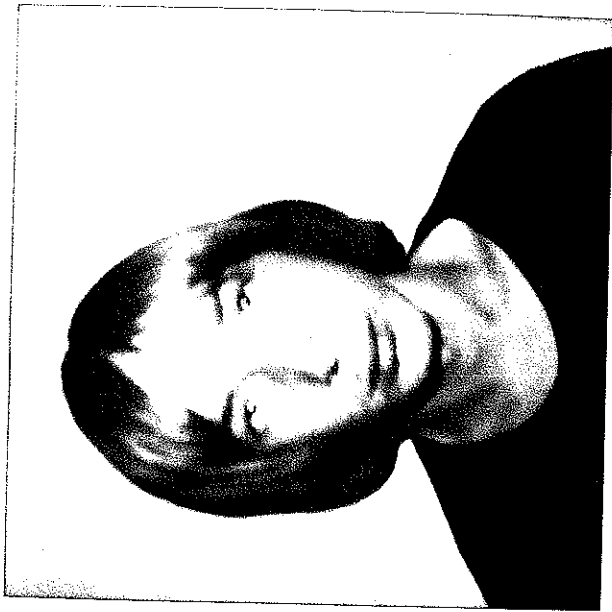

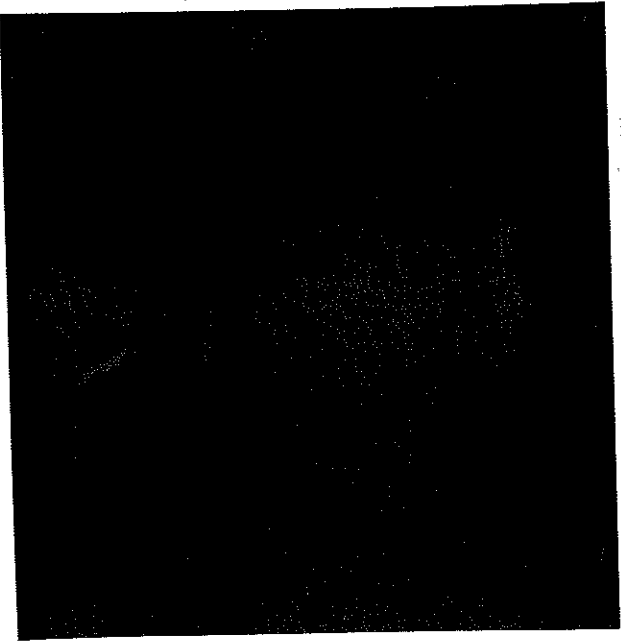
