Remarks: On Monday, February 1, 1982, this writer met with Det. Scarbrough at the Broward Medical Examiner's Office, 5301 W. 31st Avenue, Fort Lauderdale. Also present were Detectives Hickman and Hoffman of Hollywood Police Department, and serologist George Duncan of the Broward Sheriff's Office.

Using a 35 mm camera and one roll of color film, photographs were taken of a 1973 Plymouth Fury, 4 door, brown in color with brown vinyl top, Florida Tag #BWK-509, Vehicle Identification Number PH41K3F186823, noting seals intact on all doors and trunk. The seals were broken and additional photographs were taken of the interior of the vehicle.

Det. Hickman removed the front driver seat. Using a vacuum cleaner with a special filter, the areas under the front and rear seat were vacuumed. Serologist George Duncan checked the interior of the vehicle for blood (see Duncan's report for details). The evidence was transported to the Forensic Services locked evidence room.

On 2 February 1982, this writer forwarded the evidence via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the Florida Department of Criminal Law Enforcement Crime Laboratory in Tallahassee.

Negatives developed and kept in the Forensic Services case file. A copy of this report and one set of 8 x 10 photographs delivered to Det. Scarbrough. No further action.
