February 1, 1962—The undersigned on this date, received from Detective D.E. Scarborough, one front car seat from a 1973 Plymouth Fury, Tag number 6-82 YLA. BXK 309.

February 1, 1962—The undersigned on this date, as requested by Detective Donald Hickman of the Hollywood Police Department, presented the front car seat for trace evidence. The undersigned removed the seat cover. An examination revealed that the entire fiber used to pad the seat cover adhered to the original seat. An examination for hair and foreign fiber proved negative results. An attempt was made to process the original seat for latent impressions using fuming and latent powder, both methods failed to develop any friction ridge details.

An examination was then conducted by Criminalist George Busan, for blood. See Lab. Report by Criminalist George Busan.

The impounded seat was then turned over to the Hollywood Police Department, 501 WESTERN AVENUE.

AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

Before me, H. MARK PURDY, a Judge of

the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, in and for Broward County, Florida personally appeared DETECTIVE RONALD HICKMAN, of the City of Hollywood, Broward County, Florida, Police Department, who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he has probable cause to believe that in a motor vehicle described as:

1973 Plymouth Fury 4 door, which is dark brown in color and has dark tan vinyl top. Said vehicle bears on the rear license plate mount a current Florida license tag which bears the numerals RNK509, a current Florida license decal with the month of June is located in the upper left and right of this license tag and bears the numerals 3006124. The vehicle identification number of this said vehicle is located below the windshield on the left front and said numbers are PH41K3F186823. This motor vehicle presently is located at 1701 North Dixie Highway, Pompano Beach, Broward County, Florida at Driscoll's Towing and Carrier Service. This location being the location where the Pompano Beach Police Department placed this vehicle after taking the vehicle into custody as evidence on November 17, 1981 at 7:30 P.M. from 232 N.E. 23rd Ave., Pompano Beach, Florida under Pompano Beach case number 144934. A division of motor vehicles check of the license tag mentioned above indicates this vehicle is registered to JAMES, EDWARD. H. date of birth June 3, 1931 with an address of 232 N.E. 23rd Ave., Pompano Beach, Florida.

There exists property stored and concealed therein, to wit:

human blood, fingerprints, human hair follicles, and clothing fibers which constitutes evidence relevant to proving that the felony offenses of murder and kidnapping have been committed.

~~The~~ <sup>X</sup> affiant's reasons for his belief and the facts establishing the grounds for this Affidavit and the probable cause for believing that

" On Monday, July 27th, 1981, between the hours of 12:00 noon to 12:30 P.M. a kidnapping occurred at the Sears and Roebuck store located at 300 Hollywood Mall, City of Hollywood, Broward County, Florida. The victim of this offense was one ADAM WALSH, whose date of birth was November 14, 1974 and whose home address was 2801 McKinley Street, Hollywood, Florida. The disappearance of ADAM WALSH was reported by the victim's mother, REVE WALSH. REVE and ADAM WALSH arrived at the Sears store on the date and time mentioned above for

the purpose of MRS. WALSH shopping at said location.

REVE WALSH stated that ADAM was allowed to remain in the toy department unattended. Upon MRS. WALSH'S returning to the toy department she could not find her son where he had been instructed to stay.

MRS. WALSH gained the assistance of store personnel in an attempt to locate ADAM. This was done through the use of the paging system and a physical search of the store and mall area. The Hollywood Police were notified and responded for the purpose of conducting additional systematic searches. Hollywood Police personnel searched the area and were unable to locate ADAM WALSH.

From July 27th, 1981 through Monday August 10th, 1981, continual investigations were conducted for any clues with respect to the whereabouts of ADAM WALSH. At no time during this period were any communications received by either the Hollywood Police Department or the WALSH family with respect to a ransom demand, even though a substantial reward had been offered for ADAM'S return of over \$100,000.00.

On Monday, August 10th, 1981, at approximately 6:45 P.M., the severed head of a young white male child was found floating in a drainage canal in Indian River County near the Florida Turnpike. The head was found by MR. ROBERT HUGHES and MR. VERNON BAILY, who are employees of "EVANS PROPERTIES", which is located at mile marker 130½, Indian River County, Florida.

On Tuesday, August 11th, 1981, a close friend of the victim's family was allowed to view the severed head at the Indian River County Examiner's Office and a positive identification was made of the head as that of ADAM WALSH. This identification was also verified through a comparison of ADAM WALSH'S dental records.

On Wednesday, November 25th, 1981, at 9:20 P.M. your affiant along with DET. J.B. SMITH met with a MR. JOHN RUSSELL TERRY, white male, date of birth March 4, 1926. The meeting with MR. TERRY was at his request and took place at the Deerfield Beach Police Department, Deerfield Beach, Florida.

MR. JOHN RUSSELL TERRY when interviewed gave the following information to your affiant in a sworn tape recorded statement concerning MR. TERRY'S contact with one EDWARD HAROLD JAMES, white male, date of birth June 3, 1931.

MR. JOHN RUSSELL TERRY stated he had been incarcerated in the Broward County Jail on the charge of a stolen motor vehicle, from the dates of November 5th, 1981 through November 24th, 1981. The case was dismissed against MR. JOHN RUSSELL TERRY due to lack of information.

EDWARD HAROLD JAMES from the dates of November 23rd, through November 24th, 1981. During this time period JOHN TERRY stated that while he was in jail with EDWARD JAMES, EDWARD JAMES told JOHN TERRY certain facts concerning circumstances that caused EDWARD JAMES' arrest by the Pompano Beach Police Department reference EDWARD JAMES kidnapping a three year old White Female in Pompano on November 17th, 1981. Also, EDWARD JAMES told JOHN TERRY how he had abducted a five year old White Male from a shopping center in Hollywood, Florida during the summer months and how he, EDWARD JAMES, had cut the boys head off with a knife when the boy wanted to be returned and had threatened to tell on EDWARD JAMES if he wasn't taken home.

MR. JOHN TERRY, in his sworn statement, stated that EDWARD JAMES

told him that he manipulated the five year old boy out of the department store the same way he manipulated the three year old girl, that he thought was a boy, by offering to buy him ice cream.

JOHN TERRY further stated that EDWARD JAMES had told him that he had driven the boy in his car onto the Florida Turnpike north of Stuart, Florida, where he killed the boy when the boy threatened EDWARD JAMES, demanding that JAMES give him money or he would tell his parents what EDWARD JAMES had done with him. MR. JOHN TERRY stated that EDWARD JAMES told him he took the boy out of the car, his Plymouth Fury, dark brown in color, and he parked the car by a canal and bridge on the Florida Turnpike, where he cut the boys head off with a knife that he had carried in a holster, and then held the head by the hair and kicked it into the canal like a football.

It should be noted that ADAM WALSH's head was found floating in a canal adjacent to the Florida Turnpike near mile marker 130. The canal area at mile marker 130 is bridged by the Florida Turnpike with bridge rails on either side of the Turnpike, which gives the appearance of a bridge.

MR. JOHN TERRY stated that JAMES said he killed the boy because the boy was too smart for his age. TERRY stated JAMES became very excited when telling how he killed the boy and had stated he told the boy "God damn you, you'll tell mama, you'll tell daddy nothing" and then killed the boy.

MR. JOHN TERRY stated JAMES told him he took the body and buried it in an area where there appears to be sulphur mining south of Stuart, Florida. JAMES related that he made sure there was no blood left in his car. This statement leads your affiant to reasonably believe that at one point in time there was human blood contained within the car and that a certain scientific procedure could reveal said blood.

MR. JOHN TERRY stated that JAMES continually talked about how he had killed the boy and how he kicked his head into the canal.

After the statement of MR. TERRY, he was asked if JAMES mentioned keeping any item that belonged to the boy. JAMES told MR. TERRY that he kept an article of the boy's clothing under the front seat of his vehicle for a while until things got too hot at which time the article of clothing was removed from JAMES' vehicle.

It should be noted that your affiant reasonably believes that it is a customary practice of certain sex offenders to keep an item of property belonging to their victim as a memento.

On November 17, 1981, when JAMES was arrested by Pompano Police, he did not possess the holstered knife described by TERRY, as mentioned by JAMES.

MR. TERRY also stated that JAMES had told him that two Hollywood Detectives met with him in jail the night after he was arrested. JAMES told MR. TERRY that the detectives asked him questions about his knowledge of the ADAM WALSH case and what he observed on television. JAMES further told TERRY that he spoke with the two detectives for ten minutes about the case and then got upset with them and stopped talking.

Your affiant believes that if ADAM WALSH had in fact been in JAMES' car, it is highly probable that the victim's fingerprints, hair follicles from falling hair and clothing fibers would be in the vehicle.

It is your affiant's opinion that MR. JOHN TERRY has related what he knows to be the truth. This opinion of your affiant

is due to your affiant's thirteen years experience in police investigations, the last six years being involved exclusively in homicide investigations and persons involved in those investigations.

Your affiant and DETECTIVE JACK HOFFMAN did in fact meet with MR. JAMES on Wednesday, November 18, 1981, at approximately 11:30 A.M., on the first floor area of the Broward County Jail.

It should be noted that MR. JOHN TERRY when meeting with your affiant on Wednesday, November 25, 1981, was not aware of the meeting your affiant had with MR. EDWARD JAMES on Wednesday morning of November 18, 1981. In the sworn statement obtained from MR. JOHN TERRY he relayed information to your affiant from a conversation he had with EDWARD JAMES concerning JAMES' arrest by Pompano Police. It should be noted that MR. TERRY gave your affiant the same identical information concerning the arrest of EDWARD JAMES that MR. JAMES gave your affiant on November 18, 1981. This further shows that MR. TERRY was not fabricating the information he relayed to your affiant in his sworn statement but was only relaying what he had been told by EDWARD JAMES while in custody with JAMES on the dates of November 23, 1981 and November 24, 1981.

During your affiant's interview with MR. EDWARD JAMES, he was asked about his knowledge of the ADAM WALSH case, and if he could verify his whereabouts on the date of Monday, July 27th, 1981, 12:00 noon. MR. JAMES stated that he only knew of the case through the news media. Further he stated he was working on the date in question for the "TED GRATZ" Construction Company in Plantation, Florida and had worked with this business for the last two years.

On Tuesday, December 1, 1981, at approximately 1:30 P.M., DETECTIVE JACK HOFFMAN of the Hollywood Police Department met with MR. TED GRATZ and conducted an interview with him. During this interview with MR. TED GRATZ, he did confirm that EDWARD JAMES was an employee with his company for the past two years as a general laborer. MR. TED GRATZ was asked to confirm MR. 

Apartment number 1, of a single story CBS apartment complex, consisting of four individual apartments. Said complex is located at 232 N.E. 23rd Ave., within the City of Pompano, Broward County, Florida. This apartment complex is the third building south of the intersection of N.E. 4th Street and N.E. 23rd Ave. and is located on the east side of N.E. 23rd Ave. within said City. Said apartment complex is white in color and trimmed in green. The roof of said complex is a hip design and is covered with a white flat tile. Within said complex is located apartment number one, located at the north western most end of said complex. The access door of apartment one faces north and is a wood framed jalousie type. Said door is painted green in color. The single numeral one being white metal in color appears on the west side of this door. The numerals 232 appear on the north west roof trim board of said complex. There are two hurricane awnings attached to the western wall of apartment number one. To the west of the access door of this apartment is a black in color mailbox with the names E. JAMER and KRYSIAK in blue.

TERRY further stated that JAMES had told him he had taken the boy on to the turnpike north of Stuart, Florida where he killed the boy when the boy threatened JAMES and demanded that JAMES give him money or he would tell his parents what JAMES had done with him. MR. TERRY states that JAMES told him he took the boy out of the car, JAMES' Plymouth Fury dark brown, and he parked the car by a canal and bridge on the turnpike where he cut the boy's head off with a knife that he had in a holster and then held the head by the hair and kicked it into the canal like a football.

It should be noted that MR. JOHN TERRY when meeting with your affiant on Wednesday, November 25, 1981, was not aware of the meeting your affiant had with MR. EDWARD JAMES on Wednesday morning of November 18, 1981. In the sworn statement obtained from MR. JOHN TERRY he relayed information to your affiant from a conversation he had with EDWARD JAMES concerning JAMES' arrest by Pompano Police. It should be noted that MR. TERRY gave your affiant the same identical information concerning the arrest of EDWARD JAMES that MR. JAMES gave your affiant on November 18, 1981. This further shows that MR. TERRY was not fabricating the information only relaying what he had been told by EDWARD JAMES while in custody with JAMES on the dates of November 23, 1981 and November 24, 1981.

During your affiant's interview with MR. EDWARD JAMES, he was asked about his knowledge of the ADAM WALSH case, and if he could verify his whereabouts on the date of Monday, July 27th, 1981, 12:00 noon. MR. JAMES stated that he only knew of the case through the news media. Further he stated he was working on the date in question for the "TED GRATZ" Construction Company in Plantation, Florida and had worked with this business for the last two years.

On Tuesday, December 1, 1981, at approximately 1:30 P.M. DETECTIVE JACK HOFFMAN of the Hollywood Police Department met with MR. TED GRATZ and conducted an interview with him. During this interview with MR. TED GRATZ, he did confirm that EDWARD JAMES was an employee with his company for the past two years as a general laborer. MR. TED GRATZ was asked to confirm MR. EDWARD JAMES' employment on Monday, July 27th, 1981. MR. TED GRATZ informed DETECTIVE JACK HOFFMAN that after checking his records for July 27, 1981, he could not confirm that MR. EDWARD JAMES worked on that date in question. MR. GRATZ did however advise that although he does not keep permanent records of his employees, he remembers that MR. EDWARD JAMES was absent without notification to MR. GRATZ for one or possibly two days during the summer months between the months of July and August of 1981.

On Sunday, December 6, 1981, at approximately 4:30 P.M., your affiant made contact with SGT. DANIEL of the Martin County Sheriff's Office, Martin County, Florida. your affiant questioned SGT. DANIEL concerning what type of mining is going on in his county by the Florida Turnpike. SGT. DANIEL advised that there is no mining in Martin County by the Florida Turnpike, however, when traveling south on the Florida Turnpike in the area of Port St. Lucy, Martin County, Florida, there is an area under construction where canals are

being dug which would give the appearance of some type of mining possibility being conducted. Sgt. DANIEL did advise that the construction has been underway for at least two years. This would also be consistent with the information given Mr. JOHN TERRY by Mr. EDWARD JAMES.

A background check of Mr. JOHN TERRY revealed that he has served in the United States Navy from the dates of February 7, 1945 through August 30, 1945 at which time he was honorably discharged. A check with the Lake City, Florida State's Attorney's Office revealed that Mr. JOHN TERRY has been treated at the Lake City Veteran's Hospital in the recent past for alcohol abuse. A further check into Mr. JOHN TERRY's background has revealed that he has only been treated for alcohol abuse as far as the medical records indicate."

On Tuesday, December 8, 1981, the said vehicle was searched and the following items were removed and sent to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement Crime Laboratory for analysis:

One (1) folded brown bag, one (1) multi-colored tissue box, one (1) leather-like tan zipper bag 5" x 8", one (1) black eyeglass case with glasses, one (1) man's pocket comb, one (1) key ring with two keys, one (1) shoehorn, one (1) 3-1/2 oz. bottle of Brute, one (1) bandaid, one (1) "Zip" graphite tube, one (1) tire gauge, two (2) blue blankets, one (1) section of white carpet, one (1) white bed sheet, three (3) vacuuming samples, one (1) from the back seat area, one (1) from the front floor area. The vacuuming samples contain suspect hair. Said items have not as yet been examined or analyzed by said crime lab.

On Tuesday, January 26, 1982, a Mr. WILLIAM CHARLES WINDHURST, white male, date of birth 10/22/47, who resides at 232 N.E. 23rd Avenue, Apartment #2, Pompano Beach, Florida, presented himself at the Hollywood Police Department and met with Detective Ronald Hickman and Detective Jack Hoffman. In a sworn taped recorded statement, furnished to the above said officers, Mr. WILLIAM CHARLES WINDHURST stated that he has known Mr. EDWARD HAROLD JAMES for four (4) years and lives in Apartment #2 which is next door to Mr. EDWARD HAROLD JAMES' apartment located at 232 N.E. 23rd Avenue, Pompano Beach, Florida.

In said sworn statement, Mr. WILLIAM CHARLES WINDHURST stated that he observed that Mr. EDWARD HAROLD JAMES was missing or absent from the apartment complex for a period of over two weeks during the last week of July, 1981, and into the month of August 1981. Further,

WILLIAM CHARLES WINDHURST stated that he observed that Mr. EDWARD HAROLD JAMES had changed the upholstery on the front seat of his 1973 Plymouth Fury when Mr. JAMES returned in August 1981. WILLIAM CHARLES WINDHURST further stated he had often times observed the interior of JAMES' vehicle and noted that it was in excellent condition. WILLIAM CHARLES WINDHURST stated that he asked JAMES in August, 1981, why he changed the seat covering to the front seat of his vehicle, and JAMES responded by telling Mr. WINDHURST that he had the front seat covered due to it being old and worn. WINDHURST stated to your Affiant that the front seat covering was not old and worn.

EDWARD HAROLD JAMES had also told Mr. WINDHURST that the new covering cost over \$80.00 and that the cover was installed by an upholsterer located on Dixie Highway in Pompano Beach, Florida.

Your Affiant believes WILLIAM CHARLES WINDHURST to be a truthful person and the information he furnished to be reliable. Your Affiant has learned that WINDHURST was honorably discharged from the U.S. Army. He is a member of Labor Local No. 938, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

On Wednesday, January 27, 1982, your Affiant met with the owner/operator of Pompano Trim Shop, Incorporated, a Mr. ELWOOD LEE PINNELL, white male, date of birth, 9/11/40. Mr. PINNELL was asked to check his records to ascertain if a Mr. JAMES had purchased a seat cover from Mr. PINNELL. Mr. PINNELL located an original sales slip for a seat cover sold to JAMES and showed same to your Affiant. The sales slip was dated 8/27/81, and is made out to Mr. ED. JAMES, address, 232 N.E. 23rd Avenue, Pompano Beach. The sales slip recites that the seat cover was purchased for \$88.40. A copy of said receipt is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

As your Affiant now has probable cause to believe that the front seat covering was changed and therefore concealed the seat covering which was exposed prior to August 27, 1981, your Affiant prays that a subsequent Warrant be issued for said vehicle. The fact that your Affiant did not know this information on December 8, 1981, resulted in a less than thorough search of said vehicle which your Affiant has probable cause to believe may contain certain property of evidentiary value, to wit: human blood, fingerprints, human hair, follicles, and clothing fibers.

WHEREFORE, Affiant prays that a Search Warrant be issued commanding the Sheriff of Broward County, Florida and his Deputies and all Police Officers of the City of Hollywood, and the Director of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement or his duly constituted Agents and all Police Officers in Broward County, and all Officers of the Florida Highway Patrol, with the proper and necessary assistance, to search forthwith the

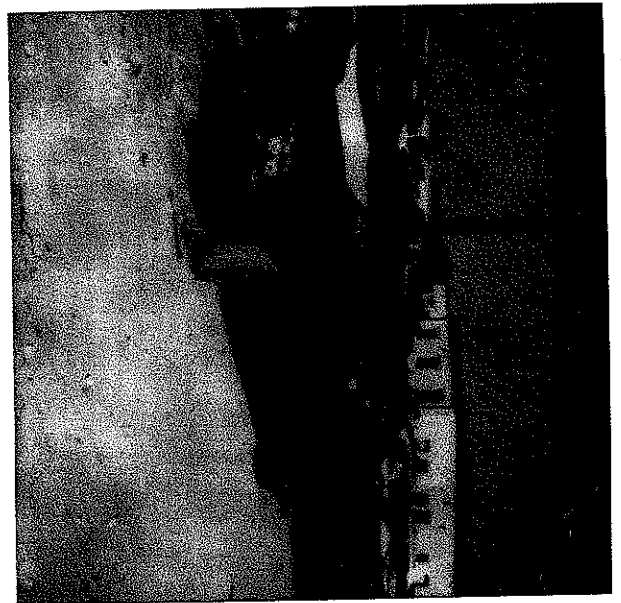

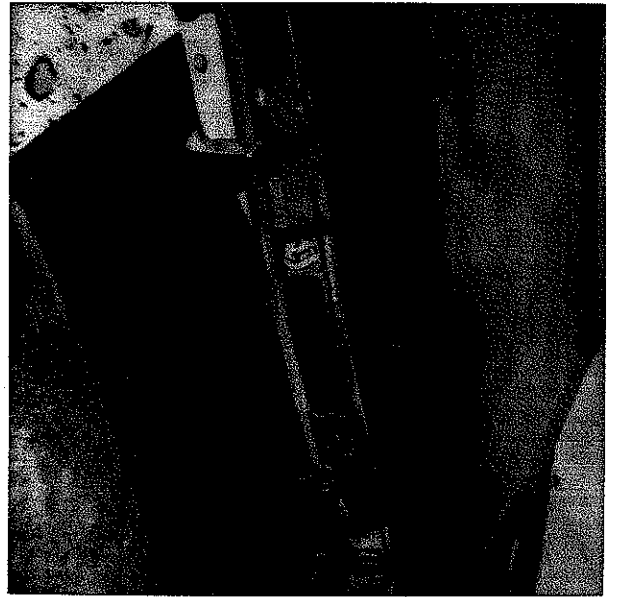

I wrote the # of the green car down & hoped for some help PNM 593. Our vacation will end in 2 more days I'm glad my son finally told me about what happened. but even though we will still be here I could not come in & report this in person my husband has a terrible temper & if he found out he would go over there & tear the kids head off. as you can see this would create more of a problem. Also we come down here every year this is a place to come to relieve tensions if we were to have embarrassing publicity our relatives that we stay here with would probably not attend the invitation as they have always done - they are old & very quiet people - I do hope you can understand why we are not making a formal complaint. P.S. My son did describe the other boy to me but I had neglected to put it in before. He said his name is Thomas Barry, he was slender, mid 20's, dark hair, about 5'5"-5'8"

This was all he could remember. I tried to put myself into his  
12 yr old mind by thinking back when I was that young & it  
seems to me that I can't even remember what I looked like at  
12. I'm not sure that the description is all that accurate but it

Dear Mr + Mrs. Walsh,

I don't know if this will reach you or not but I knew of no other way to contact you.

I am a concerned mother of two boys, ages six and three, who saw you on the Phil Donahue program and I was very moved to do something about the safety of my children and others and, with regard to the Missing Childrens Act, do something about the plight of those parents - guessing and wondering about their missing children.

I am aware that safety should be initially taught at home but recently my

son's school had a fireman speak to them regarding fire safety who apparently had quite an impact on the children because when my son and a friend came home they told me what seemed word for word what the fireman had said.

I thought if a policeman or some other qualified person could speak to the children in the same manner about personal safety and strangers etc., it might also have just such an impact, so I have spoken to my son's principal about this and she agreed that it was an excellent idea and would try to get someone to speak on



that topic.

I also called the office of my representative, who is Daniel Mica, and requested a copy of Bill # 3781, which I have received.

From listening to you and the other parents on Mr. Donahue's program, I'm led to believe that if this bill can be passed, many grieving parents can be at least aware of the fate of their unfortunate children rather than spend their lives not knowing.

I thought if perhaps enough concerned people would sign a petition and those petitions then be sent to their representatives, maybe this bill

could be passed.

I am willing, as I'm sure other people are also, to be at a local shopping mall with just such a petition to get signatures.

I am writing to you because you seem to be on top of the matter and most aware of what needs to be done.

If you think my suggestion might work, please contact me and I'll be glad to help in any way I can.

I deeply sympathize with you both for the loss of your son and hope that the person responsible will be found.

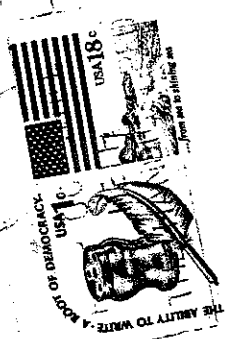

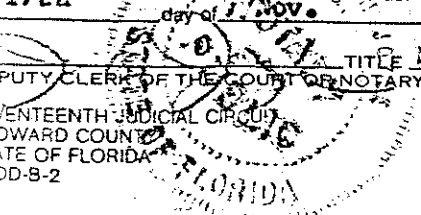
A .32 cal. loaded revolver was found beneath the seat of the driver. Pornographic photos were also found in the vehicle as were several pairs of women's underwear.

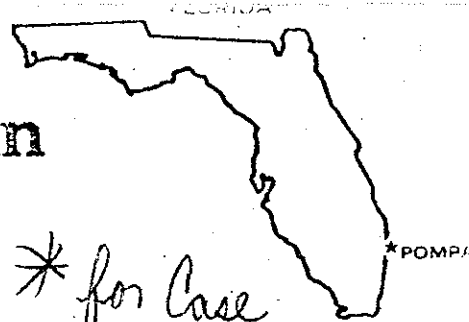

The undersigned along with Det Dunlap and aides Thomson and Coley were advised of the above offense, in which the victim was lured into a "big brown car" and taken to an apartment where the victim had his pants pulled down and the unknown suspect then had oral sex with the victim in which the suspect performed the "oral sex on the victim". The suspect then drove the victim back to the area of his apartment located at

From numerous interviews with the victim it seems the suspect drove the victim somewhere east of No. Federal Hwy. between Atlantic Blvd. and NE 6 Street. The victim does remember passing MacDonalds Hamburgers, Burger King and the Picture Lounge located at 200 No. Federal Hwy. Pompano Beach Fla. The victim also stated that when he was in the apt. he could see pictures on the walls, and the bathroom and kitchen all in the same area. It seems the victim was trying to describe a studio/efficiency apartment.

The victim was driven to the area where the offense possibly occurred several times with his mother and father present. All streets were carefully checked with the victim in the police unit during these times, giving the victim an opportunity to carefully look at homes & apartments in the area. The results of these outings with the victim and his parents were negative as far as locating the actual locations.

Because of the victims young age, a concrete description of the suspect is still uncertain at this time. The physical description of the suspect is still general and vague as contained in the original report. During the course of the investigation, the victim was shown numerous pictures of past sex offenders and other suspects/vehicles of persons that were developed as possible suspects. All of these attempts to identify a person or vehicle were negative.

Several persons were extensively investigated but were ruled out as suspects as some were in prison at the time of the offense and other had alibi's that were verified. The undersigned also went to the Broward County Rape Center and reviewed their suspect files for possible leads in this case. As a result several cases occurring in surrounding agencies were looked into by the undersigned (cases in Lighthouse Point, Oakland Park, and the Broward County Sheriffs Office). It appears none of the cases however were actually related to the above offense.

Also be advised that for several days a plain clothes surveillance was conducted in the area of the victims home in hopes that the suspect may return. This attempt also had no results. (conducted on the dates of 1/6-7-8-9/81).

There is no physical evidence in this case, nor actual crime scene. The totality of the investigation as far as make and model of vehicle and close suspect description was hampered due to the fact of the victims very young age. An

HE STATES HE ALSO SAW A WOODEN LARGE K SOMEWHERE. THIS OFFICER THOUGHT HE MIGHT HAVE MEANT K-MART WHICH WOULD BE FURTHER NORTH BUT HIS MOTHER STATES HE KNOWS K-MART AND THAT'S NOT WHAT HE WAS TALKING ABOUT. THIS OFFICER COULD NOT LOCATE A LARGE WOODEN K IN SOMEBODY'S FRONT YARD OR ON A CORNER. IT IS UNKNOWN WHAT WAS REFERRING TO AT THIS TIME. AT 901 PINE DR. THE UNDERSIGNED MET WITH SERGEANT PELLGRINO OF THE POMPANO BEACH ROAD PATROL. SERGEANT PELLGRINO ADVISED THE UNDERSIGNED THAT A SMALL CHILD HAD BEEN PLAYING OUT IN THE YARD NEAR HER APARTMENT WHEN SHE WAS TAKEN BY A WHITE MALE TO A VEHICLE. SERGEANT PELLGRINO ADVISED THAT A WITNESS HAD OBSERVED THIS AND THEN SPOKE TO THE PARENTS OF THE CHILD AT WHICH TIME THE PARENTS ADVISED THAT THEY HAD NOT GIVEN PERMISSION TO ANYONE TO TAKE THE CHILD. SERGEANT PELLGRINO ADVISED THAT BOTH THE WITNESS AND THE FATHER OF THE CHILD GAVE PURSUIT OF THE SUBJECT IN SEPARATE VEHICLES. THE SUBJECT WAS LOST AND THE POLICE WERE THEN SUMMONED. APPROXIMATELY THREE TO FOUR MINUTES BACK TO WHERE THE SUBJECT HAD BEEN LOST FOR THE LAST TIME, THE CHILD WAS LOCATED NEAR 901 PINE DR. THE UNDERSIGNED ALONG WITH THE ROAD PATROL OFFICERS SURROUNDED THE SUSPECT'S HOUSE AND ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT THIS INDIVIDUAL. OFFICERS KNOCKED AT THE DOOR OF THE SUSPECT'S HOME. THE HOME IS ACTUALLY AN EFFICIENCY APARTMENT LOCATED ON THE WEST END OF AN APARTMENT COMPLEX. THE PHONE WAS ALSO HEARD TO BE RINGING FROM THE SUSPECT'S APARTMENT DURING THIS TIME. NO ONE ANSWERED THE BELL OF THE PHONE IN THE APARTMENT. APPROXIMATELY 10 MINUTES AFTER THE ARRIVAL OF THE ASSIGNED AT THE SCENE, THIS INVESTIGATOR OBSERVED A WHITE MALE WALKING ON NE. 1 ST. IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION. AS THE SUBJECT APPROACHED NE. 23 AVE. AND NE. 1 ST., THE SUBJECT TURNED SOUTHBOUND. JAMES WAS PLACED IN A POLICE UNIT WITH HIS BAG OF CLOTHINGS AND BROUGHT TO THE POMPANO BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT. THE UNDERSIGNED ALSO RETURNED TO THE POMPANO BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT TO OBTAIN A STATEMENT FROM MR. EDWARDS. BUT AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO OBTAINING THE STATEMENT FROM EDWARDS, THE UNDERSIGNED MET WITH MR. JAMES AND ADVISED MR. JAMES OF HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS. MR. JAMES STATED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD ALL OF HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS AND SIGNED A RIGHTS WAIVER. AT THAT TIME THE UNDERSIGNED OBTAINED A COLOR PHOTOGRAPH OF MR. JAMES. THE PHOTOGRAPH WAS PLACED INTO A PHOTOGRAPHIC LINEUP CONSISTING OF FIVE OTHER COLOR PHOTOGRAPHS. THE UNDERSIGNED THEN MET WITH MR. LARRY EDWARDS, THE WITNESS TO THIS OFFENSE.

DURING THE SWORN STATEMENT MR. EDWARDS RELATED THE FOLLOWING TO THE UNDERSIGNED. MR. EDWARDS STATED TO THIS INVESTIGATOR THAT HE HAD BEEN IN THE APARTMENT OF THE MANAGER OF THE APARTMENTS AT 901 PINE DR. MR. EDWARDS STATED THE MANAGER IS ALSO THE FATHER OF THE VICTIM IN THIS OFFENSE. DURING THE STATEMENT MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT AS HE WAS LEAVING THE APARTMENT, HE OBSERVED A WHITE MALE TO BE CARRYING THE MANAGER OF THE APARTMENT'S DAUGHTER. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT HE HEARD THE WHITE MALE SAY TO THE YOUNG GIRL THAT HE

WOULD BUY HER SOME ICE CREAM AND WENT BACK TO THE MANAGER'S ASSOCIATED THIS WITH POSSIBLE BAD CONNOTATIONS AND WENT BACK TO THE MANAGER'S APARTMENT. MR. EDWARDS STATED HE ADVISED THE MANAGER THAT SOMEONE WAS TAKING HIS DAUGHTER TO GET SOME CANDY AND ICE CREAM, AND IF THEY HAD PERMISSION. THE FATHER OF THE VICTIM STATED THAT HE HAD NOT GIVEN ANY PERMISSION TO ANYONE TO TAKE THE CHILD TO GET ANYTHING. BOTH THE MANAGER/FATHER AND THE WITNESS RAN OUT TO WHERE THE SUBJECT WAS LAST SEEN. BOTH THE FATHER AND WITNESS ENTERED SEPARATE VEHICLES AND BEGAN TO PURSUE TO THE AREA THAT THE SUBJECT HAD BEEN SEEN DRIVING. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT HE OBSERVED THE SUBJECT VEHICLE AHEAD OF HIM AND PULLED IN FRONT OF HIM TO STOP THE VEHICLE. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT THE CAR DROVE AWAY AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED AND THAT HE BEGAN CHASING IT AS WAS THE FATHER OF THE VICTIM. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT THEY CHASED THE VEHICLE FROM THE SOUTHEAST SECTION OF POMPANO INTO THE NORTHEAST SECTION WHICH REQUIRE CROSSING ATLANTIC BLVD. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT THEIR SPEEDS WERE VERY HIGH AND POSSIBLY OVER 60 TO 70 MILES AN HOUR. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT THE SUBJECT DRIVING THE CAR WITH THE WHITE FEMALE VICTIM IN IT WAS RUNNING STOP SIGNS AND WAS ABLE TO LOSE BOTH HE AND THE FATHER OF THE VICTIM IN THE NORTHEAST SECTION OF POMPANO. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT HE WAS NOT ABLE TO GET A TAG NUMBER AT THAT PARTICULAR TIME AND DROVE BACK TO THE INTERSECTION OF SE. 10 AVE. AND ATLANTIC BLVD. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT HE PASSED HIS VEHICLE IN THE INTERSECTION OF SE. 10 AVE. AND ATLANTIC AND APPROXIMATELY ONE MINUTE TO ONE MINUTE AND A HALF LATER THE SAME SUBJECT VEHICLE THAT HE OBSERVED EARLIER DROVE THROUGH THE INTERSECTION BACK INTO THE NORTHEAST SECTION OF POMPANO BEACH. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT HE AGAIN GAVE CHASE, THIS TIME OBTAINING THE TAG NUMBER FROM THE SUBJECT VEHICLE. THE TAG WAS GIVEN TO THE UNDERSIGNED BY MR. EDWARDS AS RNK-509. MR. EDWARDS ALSO STATED THAT DURING THE FIRST INITIAL CHASE HE WAS ABLE TO SEE THE YOUNG GIRL BOUNCING AROUND IN THE CAR. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT DURING THE SECOND PORTION OF THE CHASE HE WAS NOT ABLE TO SEE THE GIRL IN THE CAR AND ASSUMED THAT SHE WAS NO LONGER THERE. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT ONCE AGAIN SPEEDS WERE DRIVEN AT 60 TO 70 MILE AN HOUR AND THE SUBJECT WAS DRIVING THROUGH STOP SIGNS TO ELUDE BEING CAPTURED. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT HE WAS UNABLE TO CATCH THE SUBJECT AND LOST THE SUBJECT AGAIN IN THE NORTHEAST SECTION OF POMPANO. IT WAS AT THAT TIME MR. EDWARDS TOLD THIS INVESTIGATOR THAT HE RETURNED BACK TO THE SCENE WHERE POLICE HAD ALREADY ARRIVED. A PHOTOGRAPHIC LINEUP WAS PRESENTED TO

HE HAD SEEN TAKE THE SMALL CHILD FROM HER APARTMENT COMPLEX TO THE AWAITING  
VEHICLE. MR. EDWARDS STATED THAT THERE WAS NO DOUBT IN HIS MIND PERTAINING

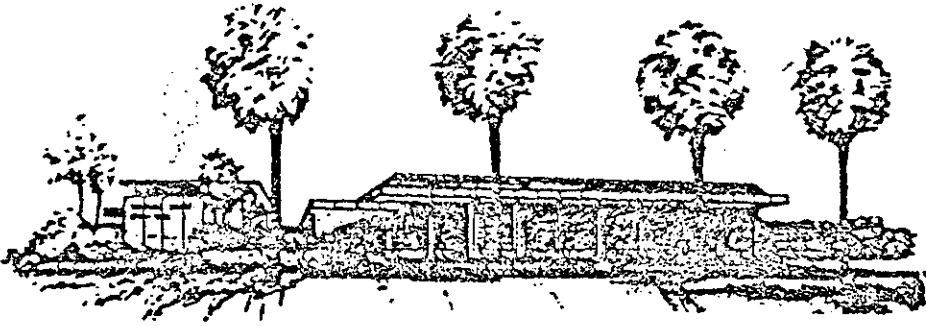

- Q. FOR THE RECORD LET IT REFLECT THAT THE DEFENDANT IN THIS PARTICULAR CASE HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED BY MR. EDWARDS. NOW THEN WHEN YOU SAW THIS YOUNG GIRL BEING CARRIED BY THIS MAN THAT YOU JUST IDENTIFIED, WHAT DID YOU DO?  
A. I WENT TO THE MANAGER AND ASKED IF THEY KNEW WHERE THEIR CHILD WAS. WHEN THEY SAID NO I SAID THAT THERE WAS SOMEBODY TAKING HER TO THE STORE TO GET SOME CANDY AN ICE CREAM.

- Q. OKAY THEN WHAT HAPPENED?  
A. THEN WE ALL RAN OUT OF THE HOUSE AFTER THE GUY.
- Q. DID THE MANAGER OR THE FATHER OF THE CHILD SAY ANYTHING LIKE, ANYTHING AT ALL?  
A. HE TOLD ME TO JUMP IN THE CAR AN CHASE THE GUY.
- Q. DID YOU ASSUME AT THAT POINT THAT THIS MAN DID NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO HAVE THIS CHILD WITH HIM?  
A. YES I DID.
- Q. DID YOU IN FACT CHASE THIS PARTICULAR PERSON  
A. YES I DID.
- Q. WOULD YOU TELL ME WHAT ALL HAPPENED DURING THIS TIME?  
A. THE CHASE.
- Q. YES  
A. I GOT IN MY CAR AN I STARTED DOWN PINE DRIVE, WEST, CAUSE THATS THE WAY THAT I FELT THAT HE WENT. I DON'T KNOW WHY BUT I WENT THAT WAY AN HERE HE WAS PULLED OVER ABOUT A QUARTER OF A MILE DOWN THE ROAD. I CAME UP REAL FAST. AS SOON AS HE SEEN ME BARRELIN DOWN THE STREET HE TOOK OFF IN HIS CAR RIGHT IN FRONT OF ME AN I FOLLOWED HIM ACROSS THE INTERSECTION AN DOWN THE STREET. I PULLED IN FRONT OF HIM TO STOP HIM WITH MY CAR. HE TURNED RIGHT REAL SHARP AND GOT AWAY CAUSE I WAS GOIN TO FAST TO STOP. THE APARTMENT MANAGER WAS RIGHT BEHIND HIM SO HE FOLLOWED HIM.
- Q. THE FATHER OF THE CHILD?  
A. YES.
- Q. OKAY.  
A. HE FOLLOWED HIM AN THEN I LOST HIM COMPLETELY. BY THE TIME I TURNED AROUND THEY WERE GONE. SO I STARTED TO COME BACK HOME AN I STOPPED IN THE MIDDLE OF ATLANTIC THERE.
- Q. WHERE AT 11 AVENUE?  
A. NO.
- Q. BY THE BANK?

- A. ITS RIGHT THERE AT 10TH AND ATLANTIC. I PARKED MY CAR IN THE MIDDLE OF THE STREET AN I WAS JUST HOPIN OR WISHIN OR SOMETHIN THAT THIS GUY WOULD COME BACK AROUND OR MAYBE TRY AN LEAVE OR SOMETHIN. GET OUT ON THE STREET AN ON THE FREEWAY. SO I JUST FROZE THERE FOR ABOUT A MINUTE AN A HALF 2 MINJTES. HE CAME BARRELING DOWN 10 STREET.
- Q. WHO DID?
- A. THE GUY THAT TOOK THE GIRL?
- Q. 10TH AVENUE IT WOULD BE.
- A. 10TH AVENUE. SO I FOLLOWED HIM AGAIN, THIS TIME I TURNED MY BRIGHT LIGHTS ON ANO I GJT HIS LICENSE PLATE NUMBER.
- Q. DO YOU RECALL FROM THE TOP OF YOUR HEAD, I KNOW YOU BEEN THROUGH A LOT BUT DO YOU RECALL THE TAG NUMBER?
- A. YES. RWK-509.
- Q. DO YOU RECALL THE COLOR OR BEST, THE BEST DISCRIPITION OF THE CAR YOU CAN GIVE ME?
- A. I THOUGHT THAT IT WAS A DARK MAROON COLOR, IT WAS A REAL DARK CAR, I DIDN'T EVER GET CLOSE ENOUGH TO HIM TO SEE THE EXACT COLOR. BUT I KNEW THERE WAS A DARK PLYMOUTH. I SAY 75 TO 78, SOMEWHERE IN THAT YEAR.
- Q. SO YOU CHASED THE PERSON AGAIN. WHERE DID THIS PERSON COME FROM, YOU SAID FROM 10TH?
- A. HE CAME OUT FROM 10TH STREET AND WENT ACROSS ATLANTIC AN I WAS SITTING RIGHT THERE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE INTERSECTION WHEN HE WENT RIGHT PAST ME.
- Q. SO WHEN HE CAME FROM 10TH, WHAT AREA WAS HE COMIN FROM. WAS HE COMIN FROM THE AREA THAT YOU LIVE IN?
- A. YES.
- Q. SO, SKAY NOW THE FIRST TIME THAT YOU ALL CHASED HIM AND YOU LOST HIM, DID HE GO ACROSS ATLANTIC AGAIN?
- A. YES.
- Q. SO YOU WERE INTO WHAT WE CALL THE NE SECTION?
- A. YES.
- Q. CAUSE YOUR AREA IS THE SE SECTION?

- A. YES.
- Q. OKAY YOU ALL LOST HIM IN THE NE SECTION?  
A. YES.
- Q. SO THE SECOND TIME YOU SAW HIM WAS COMING BACK FROM THE SE SECTION?  
A. YES.
- Q. FROM THE AREA YOU LIVE IN?  
A. YES.
- Q. WHEN YOU WERE CHASING HIM DID YOU SEE THE GIRL IN THE CAR?  
A. I SAW HER BOUNCE ONE TIME OR JUMP UP IN THE AIR OR SOMETHIN. I THOUGHT THAT IT WAS A RAG DOLL OR SOMETHING, BUT I NATURALLY JUST ASSUMED THAT IT WAS HER. SHE DISAPPEARED, I SEEN HER FOR A SECOND AN THEN SHE DISAPPEARED.
- Q. COULD YOU TELL IF SHE WAS IN THE BACK OR THE FRONT?  
A. SHE WAS IN THE FRONT.
- Q. NOW THE SECOND TIME YOU CHASED THIS INDIVIDUAL OR SAW HIM DID YOU SEE THE GIRL IN THE CAR?  
A. NO.
- Q. SO UNCE YOU CHASED THE PERSON THE SECOND TIME THEN WHAT HAPPENED?  
A. I FOLLOWED HIM DOWN THE STREET HEADING NORTH, BACK INTO THE NE SECTION AND I GOT UP TO ABOUT 65 OR 70 AND HE JUST KEPT GOIN FASTER AN FASTER, I WAS RUNNIN STOP SIGNS TRYIN TO CATCH HIM AN HE WASN'T EVEN SLOWIN DOWN AT THEM. FINALLY HE GOT ABOUT 4 OR 500 FEET AHEAD OF ME AN HE TURNED. WHEN HE TURNED, I CAME AROUND THE CORNER, I SAY ABOUT 20 OR 30 SECONDS AFTER HIM AND THERE WAS NOTHING BUT A BIG PILE OF DIRT, SMOKE FROM THE GROUND WHERE I GUESS HE SKIDDED AROUND THE CORNER IN THE DIRT OR SOMETHIN.
- Q. WHEN YOU SAW THE TAG WAS IT A FLORIDA TAG OR AN OUT OF STATE TAG?  
A. IT WAS A FLORIDA TAG.
- Q. THEN WHAT HAPPENED AFTER YOU LOST THE MAN THE LAST TIME?  
A. I FLAGGED AN OFFICER DOWN ON THE STREET, AND I TOLD HER WHAT I SEEN, SHE TOOK MY NAMES AN THINGS AN THEN SHE TOLD ME TO GO HOME OR DOWN TO THE MANAGERS APARTMENT IS WHERE I LIVE IN THE SAME BUILDING. SO I WENT DOWN THERE.

Q. SUBSEQUENT TO ALL OF THAT, DID YOU HAVE OCCASION TO GO WITH A POLICE OFFICER FROM THE POMPANO BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT TO AN AREA EAST OF FEDERAL HIGHWAY?

A. YES.

Q. WHILE YOU WERE PARKED THERE DID YOU HAVE THE OCCASION TO WATCH ANYONE WALK BY THE CAR?

A. YES.

Q. DID YOU RECOGNIZE THE PERSON THAT WALKED BY THE CAR?

A. YES.

Q. WHO DID YOU RECOGNIZE THAT PERSON AS?

A. THE PERSON THAT WAS CARRYING THE GIRL.

Q. WHAT WAS THIS PERSON DOING WHEN YOU SAW HIM WALK BY THE CAR?

A. HE WAS LOOKIN AT WHAT WAS GOIN ON IN FRONT OF HIS APARTMENT.

Q. WAS THE PERSON HOLDING ANYTHING?

A. YEA HE WAS HOLDING A BAG OF SOMETHING, LARGE PAPER BAG

Q. WERE ANY POLICE OFFICERS AROUND THIS PERSON AT THIS TIME?

A. NO.

Q. DID HE JUST COME WALKING UP ON HIS OWN FREE WILL AS FAR AS YOU COULD TELL?

A. YES HE DID.

Q. DID THE PERSON WALK OVER TO WHERE THE OTHER POLICE OFFICERS WERE ACROSS THE STREET?

A. I DON'T BELIEVE SO.

Q. DID HE GO UP TO WHERE THE POLICEMEN WERE IN FRONT OF AN APARTMENT?

A. YES.

Q. DID THIS PERSON EVER TURN AROUND?

A. YES.

Q. WHERE YOU COULD SEE HIS FACE?

A. YES.

- Q. WERE YOU ABLE TO RECOGNIZE HIM AGAIN?  
A. YES.
- Q. WERE YOU ABLE TO RECOGNIZE, I DROVE YOU DOWN THE STREET IS THAT CORRECT?  
A. YES.
- Q. APPROXIMATELY HOW MANY CARS WOULD YOU SAY WE DROVE BY ON THE STREET?  
A. TEN OR TWELVE.
- Q. AND THATS JUST IN ONE PARTICULAR AREA. WE DROVE BY OTHER CARS IS THAT CORRECT?  
A. YES.
- Q. WERE YOU ABLE TO IDENTIFY OUT OF ALL OF THE CARS WE DROVE BY TONIGHT, ANY ONE PARTICULAR CAR AS THE CAR YOU CHASED?  
A. YES I DID.
- Q. WHERE WAS THAT CAR AT?  
A. PARKED IN FRONT OF AN APARTMENT BUILDING.
- Q. OKAY IS THAT THE SAME PLACE WHERE WE TOOK THIS PERSON THAT YOU IDENTIFIED AT?  
A. YES.
- Q. LATER ON AFTER THIS PERSON WAS GONE DID YOU GO UP AND EXAMINE THE CAR CLOSER?  
A. YES.
- Q. WERE YOU ABLE TO MAKE ANY DETERMINATIONS ABOUT THAT CAR?  
A. ABSOLUTELY.
- Q. ABSOLUTELY, AS WHAT?  
A. AS TO THE CAR IN FACT THAT I WAS CHASING.
- Q. DID THAT CAR HAVE A TAG ON IT WHEN YOU SAW IT WHEN WE WERE OVER THERE TOGETHER?  
A. YES.
- Q. WAS THAT THE SAME TAG YOU SAW ON THE CAR?

A. YES.

Q. IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE RIGHT NOW THAT YOU CAN ADD TO THIS STATEMENT THAT I FAILED TO ASK YOU?

A. NO.

Q. HAVE WE COVERED JUST ABOUT EVERYTHING?

A. YES.
