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The intent of this report is to record the investigative action taken and the results of the inquiry in regard to a Larry Leon Waldo, white male, date of birth, July 27, 1955.

On November 2, 1983 Dets. R. Dunbar and F. Hogan of the Hollywood Police Department obtained a statement from Larry Leon Waldo in which Waldo claimed that on July 27, 1981 which was his birthday he was in the company of Ottis Toole in Jacksonville, Florida. As Waldo is questioned further in the statement he agreed with the detectives that he is apparently mistaken about the date he was with Toole and concedes to them that he was not in Jacksonville until September, 1981.

Dets. Hickman and Hoffman submitted a report on November 8, 1983 detailing their investigation of Larry Leon Waldo and his claim that he was with Ottis Toole on July 27, 1981. The detectives report concluded that they believed Waldo met Toole in 1982 as opposed to 1981.

As will be shown in this report Larry Waldo was a troubled individual who was burdened with both psychiatric and alcohol problems. This would bring into question his ability to recount past details with any accuracy as well as an inclination to be easily persuaded by persons in authority. While this may not have been the case in this situation it was part of the reason for thoroughly reviewing the investigation of Larry Waldo's claims even at this late date. In reviewing Waldo's statement as well as Detectives Hickman and Hoffman's follow up report it was not shown conclusively where Larry Leon Waldo was on July 27, 1981. In as much as Adam Walsh was abducted and presumed murdered on July 27, 1981 the question of Waldo's whereabouts on that date warranted further study.

Initially the question of how and why Waldo came to the attention of the Hollywood detectives was addressed. Also, Waldo's statement was taken at 1608 N. 27th Avenue, Hollywood and it was not known why the interview was conducted at that location. Det. Mark Smith questioned the detectives originally involved with Waldo

but none recalled how they came upon him specifically or why the statement was taken at 1608 N. 27th Avenue. Det. Mark Smith, Hollywood Police Department, was able to contact the owner of 1608 N. 27th Avenue and remembered Waldo quite simply as someone to whom a room had been rented to in 1983. This fact would fit with the lifestyle of Larry Leon Waldo, a semi-transient type individual.

Ottis Toole confessed to the murder of Adam Walsh in October of 1983 and it is recalled by this investigator that there was wide spread news coverage of this event as well as the events that immediately followed his revelation. It would seem safe to conclude that Waldo called the authorities as a result of his seeing this news coverage. As will be seen later in this report this also would fit with the behavior of Larry Leon Waldo.

In November, 1983 Larry Waldo would have been 28 years old. He died on May 2, 1990 in the City of Hollywood of natural causes.

Waldo's last known address was 3220 SW 64th Terrace in Miramar. The owner of this property, Nancy Durando (phone 966-1099), was interviewed and it was learned that she had rented a room to Larry Waldo for almost one year prior to his death. In fact she related that Larry Waldo died at her home and she was present at his death. She described Waldo as some what of an alcoholic and believed if he was not retarded he was at least intellectually impaired. Ms. Durando was aware that most if not

all of his family was now living in or near Jasper, Alabama but she has had no contact with them since Waldo's death. She also advised that Larry Waldo's father was deceased but that Larry did have a living mother whose name was Gertrude. She also mentioned the name of a Mr. Chuck St. John of Berry Hill Investigations who apparently is a friend of Larry Waldo's. Ms. Durando indicated that prior to living with her Larry Waldo was living with a Mr. Denver Simcox of 81 SW 41st Street, Miramar, phone 966-0919 and prior to that she believes he had been living alone in a trailer but she did not know the location.

Ms. Durando indicated that Waldo was receiving some sort of social security benefits but she did not know the amount or the actual source. She further advised that she suspected that Mr. Waldo was receiving some sort of psychiatric care somewhere in Hollywood.

Ms. Durando indicated that to the best of her knowledge Mr. Waldo did not hold down any sort of permanent job but she often dropped him off at 1080 NE 213th Street and believes that he did odd jobs in that area. She stated she also believed he sometimes frequented a location known as Sally's Bar in the Ives Dairy Road area.

Ms. Durando advises that the family took all of his property and so there was nothing to research from that source.

Ms. Durando explained that she lives at this location along with her daughter and up until his death with Larry Waldo, and during that time she never had any problems with Larry Waldo. She was informed by me that Waldo had given a statement to the police regarding the homicide of Adam Walsh and when told that Ms. Durando responded that there was a time where she believes the three of them were watching the Unsolved Mystery program on television and the Adam Walsh case was either being portrayed or discussed and out of the blue Larry Waldo said to her that he had been arrested for the Adam Walsh murder. Ms. Durando and her daughter questioned Larry initially about that statement and reached the conclusion that he had not been arrested for the Adam Walsh murder and that this was probably just another wild statement that Waldo was making. She also advised that to the best of her recollection he provided no further details about the comment nor did he ever mention the name Ottis Toole. She also offered a statement that she would not believe that in any event because she doesn't feel that Larry Waldo would be capable of committing a violent crime.

Contact was made with a Mr. Charles St. John, phone 962-8460 who advised that he met Larry Waldo in 1984 or perhaps 1985 and basically befriended him. He was aware of some of the problems that Waldo had and from time to time and allowed him to perform some odd jobs. Beyond that he really had no information relevant to this investigation.

The social security office was contacted in hopes that they might be able to provide a mailing address for Waldo's benefit check in July, 1981 and July, 1982. Unfortunately it was learned that records dating back that far have been purged. It was also learned that when an individual changes his mailing address for his benefit check the old mailing address is immediately purged.

With the assistance of the Attorney General's Medicaid Fraud Division a search was made via that office in the hopes of tracking Larry Waldo's use of Medicaid. They reported back that they were unable to locate any records for Larry Leon Waldo.

Various contacts at HRS were contacted and again no record was found for Larry Leon Waldo including a check of their Child Abuse Division, Adult Health Service Division and their Economic Services Unit. This was a statewide check. However it should be noted that the records dating back as far as 1981 were not necessarily complete or readily accessible.

For the record contact was made with Hollywood Medical Center and they advised there was no record of a Larry Leon Waldo in 1981 or 1982. Hollywood Memorial Regional Hospital did report that Waldo was a patient for three weeks in 1979 and also in 1988 and his medical records number was 0379220. The Broward General Medical Center would acknowledge that they did have a record of treating Larry Leon Waldo at their facility but not during the year of 1981 or 1982.

In Larry Leon Waldo's statement to police he indicated that he was somewhere near Jacksonville just off Interstate 10 when he became distressed and sought medical assistance. It was recalled by this investigator that Ottis Toole had a connection with The Church of God at 5755 Ramona Blvd. in Jacksonville in 1981. Contact was made with Pastor Gary Wiggins of what is now the Assembly of God church at that location. Pastor Wiggins advised that the name Larry Leon Waldo is not familiar to him and they have no records that might help him refresh his memory. He also commented that transients pass through the church each day and some of them are given some financial assistance but this is in the form of cash and there is no record kept. Pastor Wiggins indicated that Ottis Toole was an exception to that and was paid by check because he had worked there for several days. Pastor Wiggins advises that the church is located at the major Interstate 10 exit and a large number of transients stop there each day. Further the state hospital is only about 20 miles east of the church's location.

There were some records wherein Larry Leon Waldo listed an address of 141 West 10th Street, Jacksonville, Fla. for 1982. In addition in the statement that he gave to the Hollywood detectives he indicated that he was staying at a rooming house in Jacksonville. Between April 9 and 11 of 1996 this investigator and Detective Mark Smith made contact with Ann Ezell of Madges Guest



House at 1321 Laura Street and displayed the photograph of Larry Leon Waldo which no one there including Ms. Ezell recognized. In addition no records could be found going back to 1981 on Larry Leon Waldo. Detectives Hickman and Hoffman already commented regarding Betty Goodyear's records being absent as regards to Larry Leon Waldo but that she did know him. The 141 West 10th Street address was visited and found to be abandoned.

Larry Leon Waldo's criminal history record indicates that he was a single state offender (Florida) and showed two date of births, July 27, 1955 and July 27, 1956, FBI #125929AA4, and his correct social security number and address of 141 West 10th Street, Jacksonville. Waldo was first arrested on June 10, 1982 in St. Johns County for a DWI and no driver's license. On February 3, 1983 he was arrested by Green Grove Springs Police Department in Clay County for Disorderly Intoxication and on February 5, 1985 by Duval County Sheriff's Office for Disorderly Intoxication.

In a continuing effort to pinpoint Waldo's whereabouts in July of 1981 various police agencies were contacted both in Broward County and in northeast Florida for a records search on Larry Leon Waldo, not for arrest but for police service type calls but no record was found.

The exception to this records search and quite significantly was that the Hollywood Police Department had a record of what was then known as a field interrogation stop of Larry Leon Waldo in the City of Hollywood on August 8, 1981. Unfortunately the record only indicates that a field interrogation stop was made and there are no details regarding what transpired between the officer and Larry Waldo and in fact the officers name is not even recorded. However, it is still significant to know that Larry Leon Waldo is now placed in Broward County on August 8, 1981.

The police and court records of the June 10, 1982 arrest were eventually obtained. The reports do not indicate one way or another whether or not Larry Leon Waldo was with anyone at the time of his arrest on June 10, 1982 at the Anastasia Park in St. Johns County. At that time he did list the address of 141 West 10th Street in Jacksonville and the records indicated that he was operating a 1967 Ford, 4-door, blue, bearing a 1983 Florida tag VKM 864. A records search was requested on the Florida tag and it came back registered to a Samuel L. Banks and Lorraine Warren of 843 Alderman Road #252, Jacksonville, Fla. 32211 on a 1976 Chevrolet 2-door bearing a VIN# 1B08E6Y181046. Efforts were made to contact the registered owners but these efforts met with failure based on the scant information available and so it cannot be explained how the tag VKM 864 came to be on the vehicle that was being driven by

Larry Waldo when he was arrested. The police report and court records contain no further information regarding the vehicle or it's disposition. There is a possibility that the arresting officer wrote down the wrong tag number as one letter or one digit would invalidate any records search.

Larry Waldo was not known to normally drive a motor vehicle. And if he was driving one that day, which he obviously was, it very well could have been borrowed from one of his transient friends from the rooming house area in Jacksonville. This investigator does not recall a 67 Ford 4-door blue vehicle being mentioned anywhere in the Adam Walsh investigation and in particular in connection with Ottis Toole.

It should be mentioned at this time that later in this investigation of Larry Waldo contact was made with his family in Jasper, Alabama. During that contact it was learned that Gary Waldo a twin brother of Larry's at one time owned a similar vehicle, however, it was finally determined from speaking with Gary that that vehicle was a 2-door car and it was wrecked prior to 1982 and had to his knowledge never left the state of Alabama.

The DUI and no driver's license charges according to the court documents were nolle prossed on June 25, 1982 and there is a notation on the announcement of nolle proesse "To be picked up by HRS". Efforts were made by this investigator to try and determine

what happened to Larry Waldo upon his release from the St. Johns County Jail particularly in view of the notation on the court document. Apparently the State Attorney's Office became aware of Larry Waldo's mental problems and decided not to pursue prosecution in this case. In addition, apparently arrangements were made for Waldo to be placed into some sort of adult facility because there is also a document amongst the court records indicating that was the case. The records indicate that Mr. Waldo was to go to a facility at 6300 Arlington Expressway in Jacksonville and it has been determined that that facility has changed hands three times since 1981 and there are no records going back to 1981. In addition this investigator made numerous contacts with various HRS offices in Jacksonville and was unable to determine what happened to Waldo after he left jail on June 25th. It had been hoped that he could be tracked through at least till July, 1982 but such is not the case.

Larry Waldo had claimed he was enroute back to south Florida in 1980 when he went to a local hospital because his "nerves was going bad on him". Waldo related to the police that he was then admitted to the state hospital (Macclenny State Hospital), and that he remained there for several months. After his release he eventually meets Ottis Toole and from this recollection Waldo believes he was with Toole on or about July 27, 1981.

Detectives Hickman and Hoffman conducted an investigation into this which is covered in their report of November 8, 1983. They note that with assistance from the Jacksonville homicide unit they learned that Larry Waldo was a patient at Macclenny from November 16, 1981 through June 10, 1982. Apparently at that time they did not obtain the actual medical records from Macclenny. Based on the information they had and some other circumstances enumerated in their report they concluded that Larry Leon Waldo was not with Ottis Toole on July 27, 1981. It did appear that he may have been and probably was in Jacksonville in July of 1982. However the investigation did not really show with certainty where Waldo was on July 27, 1981.

With the assistance of State Attorney Investigator Joey Dobson of the 8th Judicial Circuit a court order was obtained and the medical records on Larry Waldo from what is now the Northeast Florida State Hospital were obtained. In reviewing the medical records it was noted that although he was admitted to Macclenny on November 16, 1981 he had presented himself at the Lake City Mental Center on November 8, 1981. His complaint at that time was "they have sent me here, because I have been bad with animals". Waldo was admitted as a schizophrenic. On May 11, 1982 Larry Waldo failed to return to his ward in the hospital. On June 10, 1982 Larry Waldo was dropped from the patient rolls. So in fact Waldo

was a patient from November 8, 1981 to May 10, 1982. The discharge date of June 10, 1982 is really incorrect and in fact that is the day he was arrested by the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office. The medical records contain a great deal of information concerning his treatment and diagnosis as well as family background and these medical records are now a part of this case file.

With the assistance of Det. Danny Robinson of the Walker County Sheriff's Office (phone 205-384-3471) the family of Larry Leon Waldo was located in Jasper, Alabama. Contact was initially made with Waldo's aunt and uncle Patricia Ann and Clyde Kenneth Waldo. Route 3 Box 51-E Dauvo, Alabama 35578, telephone 205-387-8913. Statements were eventually taken from Mr. and Mrs. Waldo and will be commented upon further. Mr. Waldo is a retired Deerfield Beach Police Officer.

Waldo's sister, Nadeen Millican (DOB:7/2/53) of Route 7, Box 299, Jasper, Alabama, phone 205-221-0740 was also contacted by telephone. In the conversation with Ms. Millican she commented that there was a time where she had run around with Larry Waldo and both of them were basically rolling stones as she phrased it. To get some insight into Waldo she advises that her brother had some psychiatric problems, he was a habitual liar, and he saw things on TV and would become part of it. She recalled one incident where there had been a news report of a robbery and her brother went to

the police station to turn himself in. The police of course realized that he was fantasizing and he was not arrested. Ms. Millican advised that she had no idea what her brother's sexual preference was. In addition to that she was not aware that he had the use of any motor vehicles and was surprised to learn that he had in fact been arrested for DUI. Ms. Millican referred me to her aunt and uncle for further details regarding Larry Waldo. It was also learned from the Waldo's that Larry's mother is still living under the name of Gertrude Odom and she previously had been married under the name of Gertrude VanZant and to the best of their knowledge she was now living in Crystal River, phone 904-563-5635. Mr. and Mrs. Waldo indicated that they felt that Gertrude may herself have some mental problems and they have had no contact with her in several years. It was also learned that there are four brothers, one of whom is a twin, Gary, and two sisters.

A statement was taken from Patricia Waldo who is Larry's aunt by marriage to Kenneth Waldo. The Waldo's have been living in the Jasper Alabama area since 1978. Kenneth and Patricia Waldo indicated that Larry would visit there often and he would hitchhike up from South Florida. In conversations with him he indicated that there were several places along the way where he knew where to stop to obtain food and shelter. So he apparently traveled the same route basically all the time. They couldn't recall with any

certainty if Larry had been there in December of 1980 and January of 1981 but very possible that he was.

Patricia Waldo's statement reflects that she did see Larry Waldo in the City of Hollywood in August of 1981 at Waldo's grandmothers Pearl Zadie Waldo's home. Pearl is now deceased. Mr. and Mrs. Waldo were there to gather up the furniture and belongings of Pearl Zadie Waldo to take her back to Alabama to live with them. Pearl Waldo was apparently in poor health and had just spent some time in the hospital. Patricia and Kenneth Waldo recall Larry Waldo assisting them in moving Waldo's grandmother. And while they do not recall the exact date they do know it was in August, 1981 and it will be recalled that the Hollywood Police Department had a field interrogation report on Larry on August 8, 1981.

The Waldo's indicated that they were left with the impression that Larry Waldo had been staying with his grandmother and sometimes with a woman named Jody but they did not know her name or address only that she operated a fruit stand somewhere on 441. The Waldo's commented that Larry Waldo was not very good on his recollection of dates. However, had he been away in July, 1981 they are certain that his grandmother would have mentioned it to them as that was her habit.

During the preparation of this report a phone call was received from the Waldo's indicating that they had continued to



think about where Larry Waldo was on July 27, 1981 and it finally came to them that they remembered telephoning Pearl Waldo on that day and that she had mentioned that she had made Larry Waldo a banana cake and so they are now certain that Larry Waldo on July 27, 1981 spent that birthday with his grandmother Pearl in the City of Hollywood.

A supplemental statement will be taken via telephone from Patricia and Kenneth Waldo at a later time and submitted under separate cover.

Just for the record the Waldo's were not aware that Larry had been a patient at Macclenny Hospital nor did they know about the June, 1982 arrest for DUI.

Mr. and Mrs. Waldo also mentioned that they seem to recall with fair certainty that Larry Waldo spent the Christmas of 1982 in Jasper. And so it would appear that Larry Waldo very likely had been in Alabama in December of 1980 and January of 1981 and he may have in fact had been enroute back to Alabama in November of 1981 when he became a voluntary patient at Macclenny State Hospital and thus missed spending the holidays in Alabama in December of 1981. They then recalled that he was there in 1982 which would fit into this pattern.

None of the Waldo family recall Larry ever mentioning the name of Ottis Toole or Adam Walsh. A photograph of Ottis Toole was shown to them and no one recognized Ottis Toole as anyone they have ever seen.

The Waldo's mentioned that Larry would often give out his address in Hollywood and they would not be surprised if he had given it to someone like Ottis Toole. If Larry Waldo hitchhiked back and forth from South Florida to Jasper, Alabama from 1978 up until the time of his death in 1990 it is anybody's guess as to whether or not he had ever run into Ottis Toole prior to 1982.

Kenneth and Patricia Waldo never knew Larry Waldo to be violent or to harm anyone and as far as they know he never had any problems with children.


They commented that if Larry had given a statement to the police regarding Ottis Toole and the Adam Walsh homicide they would not be at all surprised if he later told Nancy Durando that he had been arrested for that crime. In Larry's mind he may have construed the statement to be an arrest.

They commented that Larry Waldo's accuracy and his credibility should always be held in question.

A brief statement was also taken from Clyde Kenneth Waldo and he basically agrees with the information provided by his wife Patricia.

This report has been detailed so that any future reader inquiring of Larry Leon Waldo will have a record of what has been done in regards to his connection with this case. Based on the investigation of Larry Leon Waldo at this time it is believed that he was in fact in Hollywood on July 27, 1981 with his grandmother Pearl Waldo. It does not appear that he had the ability to be connected with the abduction and murder of Adam Walsh. It would seem that Larry Waldo did in fact know Ottis Toole but in all probability did not make his acquaintance until the summer of 1982.

A copy of this report, copies of statements of Patricia and Kenneth Waldo, the medical records and the court and police records from St. Johns County will be forwarded to Det. Mark Smith of the Hollywood Police Department for their files.



PM: As an investigator with the State Attorney's Office and a police officer I have the authority to take your statement under oath, so I need you to raise your right hand, and do you solemnly swear and affirm that the statement that you are about to give will be the truth, the whole truth so help you god?

PW: Patricia Ann Waldo, January 3, 1942.

PM: Can you recall whether or not Larry Leon Waldo visited your family up here in Alabama in December of 1980 and perhaps into January of 1981?

PW: Very possible.

PM: But you really can't say for certain?

PW: Not for certain.

PM: What was the circumstances and where?

PW: At 6360 Johnson Street, Hollywood and it was at the home of Pearl Zadio Waldo and we had gone down there to move her back up here.

PM: Do you remember the date?

PW: Not the exact date.

PM: Approximately?

PW: It was around the middle of August toward the end of August.

PM: And when you saw we, who was with you?

PW: My husband Ken and my daughter Sharon.

PM: Is Sharon's last name Waldo?

PW: Yes.

PM: When you went to Hollywood in August of '81, do you remember seeing Larry?

PW: Yes I do.

PM: And how long did you stay there?

PW: We were there at least a week possibly a few days over.

PM: Did anything come to your attention that would indicate to you where Larry was prior to your arrival? By then I mean where he might have been living or sleeping or whatever.

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PW: He had been living with a person by the name of Jody. She had a fruit stand on 441 highway, down around Pembroke Road somewhere.

PM: Had you ever met this Jody?

PW: No. I have never seen her.

PM: How do you know he was living with her?

PW: He told me he was.

PM: Apparently you must have had conversation with Larry where he related who he was living with?

PW: Yea.

PM: Do you remember if he indicated to you how long he had been staying with this Jody person?

PW: Not the length of time that he had been there. Before that he had been staying with Mrs. Waldo so I don't know exactly how long he had been there.

PM: When you say Mrs. Waldo, do you mean Pearl?

PW: Pearl, yea.

PM: So he is staying with Jody when you arrive down here in mid August, do you when he had been staying with Pearl prior to that?

PW: Not exacts dates.

PM: A month?

PW: A month probably yes.

PM: I am just trying to get an idea how long he had been staying with Jody then. Would he have been staying with Jody only a month?

PW: I don't know that for sure. He would stay with Jody for awhile and then he would go back and stay with Ms. Waldo for awhile and then go back to the other one.

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PM: Back and forth between this Jody person and his grandmother?

PW: Right.

PM: His birthday, is July 27th. When you were down there in August of 1981 did any conversation with anybody come up regarding his birthday?

PW: No.

PM: Did you ever since then get any information to indicate where he might have been on his birthday in July of '81?

PW: No.

PM: Now you are not sure of the date that you moved Pearl Waldo, however when we discussed this before this statement you mentioned something about she had been in the hospital right?

PW: Right.

PM: Just go over that again with me, how that figured into your recollection of when she moved?

PW: We got a phone call that she was sick and she needed medical treatment and so we went down there to get her into the hospital and they kept her for a few days and after she was released we loaded her furniture up and moved her back up here so that we could take care of her.

PM: So if I were to obtain her medical records for August of '81 I could put your date of the move as right after that?

PW: Right.

PM: If Larry Waldo had told the police in 1983 that he was in Jacksonville on July 27, 1981 do you have any idea of anyway to verify that or to show that this is incorrect?

PW: I would have my doubts that it would be correct.

PM: And why would that be?

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PW: He was not good on dates.

PM: If he was, if I would tell you he was in Hollywood on August 8, 1981 would you find it possible that he could have been in Jacksonville on July 27, 1981?

PW: I don't think so.

PM: And why would you not think so?

PW: If he had been away for awhile and came back his grandmother would have been happy about it and she would have been saying "oh Larry is back". But she didn't do that. I got the impression that Larry had been around for awhile.

PM: You mean when you were down there to move her you got that impression?

PW: Yes.

PM: From what conversation with Pearl Waldo?

PW: Right.

PM: Pearl Waldo was in the hospital, how long had she been in the hospital?

PW: Just a few days. That particular time.

PM: So she wasn't in the hospital on July 27th right?

PW: No.

PM: Do you know if it was a matter of custom for Larry to visit her on his birthday?

PW: Yes.

PM: You don't remember her making any mention of him visiting on his birthday in 1981 do you?

PW: No she didn't make a big deal out of it.

PM: I mean not a big deal or little deal, do you remember any comment at all like I gave Larry something for his birthday or anything that would indicate that she knew where he was on July 27th, 1981?

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PW: No.

PM: Did you know prior to my telling you, that Larry had been admitted to the which was then the MacClenny State Hospital in MacClenny, Florida in November of 1981?

PW: No.

PM: Larry indicated to the police that he had visited family in Alabama for the holidays and then was travelling apparently back to south Florida when he admitted himself to the hospital for psychiatric evaluation and was in fact admitted in November, 1981. He remained in MacClenny until May of 1982 when he apparently walked off the premises. Do you have any independent knowledge other than what we discussed or what I have told you about what Larry's whereabouts were from May of 1982 when he was released from the hospital until say July of 1982, specifically July 27, 1982?

PW: No.

PM: You wouldn't know whether or not he could have been in Jacksonville right?

PW: No.

PM: Now I have also discussed with you the fact that Larry was arrested by the St. Johns County Sheriff's Department in June of 1982 one month after he is released from the hospital and he was arrested for DUI, Driving Under the Influence and according to the police reports the vehicle he was in was a 1967 Ford 4-door blue vehicle, does that information do anything at all for you? Does it have any significance?

PW: No. At one time his brother Gary -

PM: That would be Gary Waldo?

PW: Gary Lee

PM: His twin brother?

PW: Yes, had a Ford LTD and it was blue. It was an older model car.

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PM: Do you have any recollection of approximately what years he had that car, I don't care what year car it was but do you have a recollection when he owned that car?

PW: It was in the '80's.

PM: Early '80's or I'm concerned obviously around '81, '82. Actually '82 when Larry was arrested.

PW: I'm not real sure on the years.

PM: But it was a blue Ford?

PW: A dark blue LTD.

PM: 4 door?

PW: 4 door.

PM: Do you know what kind of tags it should have had on it?

PW: It should have had Alabama tags on it.

PM: In 1982 where was Gary living?

PW: Exactly? He was in this area, but I don't know where exactly where he was living at.

PM: Has he ever lived in the Jacksonville area?

PW: Yes I do remember too, he was sitting with a man here in Jasper that was disabled and he was there to help him to the bathroom, he was a wheelchair patient and Gary sat with him.

PM: Is there any possibility that you know Gary would lend Larry his car?

PW: Gary is about the only person I know of that would lend his car to Larry.

PM: We don't know if he did or not?

PW: No. I have never known of Larry driving that much you know.

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PM: Did by any chance Larry ever tell you that he had been arrested?

PW: No.

PM: Never told you he was in jail?

PW: No.

PM: And never told you he was in McClenny Hospital?

PW: No.

PM: If you moved Pearl in August of 1981 and Larry is admitted to a hospital which is just outside Jacksonville in November of 1981 do you have any idea how you could put Larry up in that area at that time?

PW: Coming to see his grandmother.

PM: When was his grandmother's birthday, is there any date that might be significant?

PW: Her birthday was April 17th.

PM: Would Larry have called to say he was coming?

PW: Sometimes.

PM: You don't recall getting a call?

PW: I have gotten calls where he was going to come.

PM: I mean during that time to say he was coming?

PW: I couldn't say the exact day and time.

PM: But that is a possible reason?

PW: It is very possible.

PM: And when Larry travelled how did he normally get from place to place long distances?

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PW: Hitchhiking.

PM: Obviously he didn't spend Christmas holidays with your family in 1981 because he was in the hospital we agree on that?

PW: Right.

PM: Going into 1982 as I said before he was arrested in June of 1982 and he was released from jail in June of 1982, in 1982 after June do you have any recollection of seeing or talking to Larry?

PW: Anytime after '82?

PM: Of June of '82, because just to recap he was in the hospital from November 1981 to May of 1982 and then the next thing we know that we can document is that in June of 1982 he was arrested and was released I believe on June 25, 1982 so what I am asking is after that date do you have any recollection of the next time you see or hear from Larry?

PW: I have seen him since then yes.

PM: Let me try to be a little more specific. Between June '82 and December '82 during those six or seven months in there do you remember seeing or hearing from him?

PW: I think he was here for Christmas.

PM: In '82?

PW: In '82.

PM: In July of 1982 is again when his birthday is, do you have any idea where he was then?

PW: Not for sure.

PM: Was Pearl Waldo was she still living then in July of 1982?

PW: Yes she was.

PM: Was Larry very close with her?

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PW: Pretty close.

PM: Would he have called perhaps?

PW: Yes.

PM: Do you recall him speaking to her?

PW: On his birthday? Not for sure no.

PM: He wouldn't write her would he?

PW: Oh yes, he would write her letters and he called, he always called collect.

PM: The letters you mentioned, you no longer have any of those I assume right?

PW: No our house burned.

PM: So from July, '82 to December, 1982 you can't recall specifically if you saw or heard from him correct?

PW: Correct.

PM: Do you think he spent the holidays in December of 1982 here?

PW: It was '82, it had to be '82.

PM: He did?

PW: Because his mother, his grandmother passed away in September of 1983, it had to be '82.

PM: So he did spend the holidays in '82?

PW: '82.

PM: And then when he left do you know when he left, was it soon after the holidays, soon after Christmas or New Years?

PW: Yea a couple of weeks after.

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PM: As far as you know he went back to South Florida?

PW: Right.

PM: Did Larry ever mention to you that he knew an individual named Ottis Toole?

PW: No.

PM: Did Larry ever mention to you that there came a time when he notified the Hollywood Police that he had information concerning Ottis Toole and Ottis' possible connection with the murder of Adam Walsh?

PW: No.

PM: Larry has never mentioned the name Adam Walsh to you at all has he?

PW: No.

PM: Has Larry in his trips back and forth up here to Alabama, has he ever brought anybody with him?

PW: No not that I know of.

PM: In fact I showed you some photographs including one of Ottis Toole, you didn't recognize him right?

PW: No.

PM: Do you if Larry Waldo what his sexual preference was if any?

PW: No.

PM: Do you know if he was homosexual?

PW: No.

PM: Or bisexual?

PW: No.

PM: Do you know if Larry living in Hollywood, would he have occasion to tell people where he lived and that they could come see him? Would that be something he would do?

PW: If he had an address at the time, yea he would invite people over.

PM: He would?

PW: Yes.

PM: When he was living with Pearl Waldo, did you ever get any information in any form that Larry had people visit him? Do you understand what I am asking?

PW: No I don't.

PM: In other words if he is renting not renting but if his grandmother is letting him stay there, did she ever mention that Larry had friends come over or somebody came and visited Larry or did she ever mention that somebody came by looking for Larry?

PW: He had people come visit yea.

PM: So that wouldn't be unusual?

PW: No.

PM: Now Larry travelled apparently a lot back and forth to South Florida to Alabama?

PW: Yes.

PM: Knowing Larry as you seem to know him, would you find it unusual if he had met someone and gave out his address and told them to come by and see him sometime?

PW: No I wouldn't find it unusual at all.

PM: When you went down to move Pearl Waldo in August of 1981 and you saw Larry, did you notice anything unusual about Larry's behavior at that time?

PW: No.

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PM: You know from our discussion that we are investigating the death of Adam Walsh, a six year old boy?

PW: Yes.

PM: And I think you are familiar with some of the circumstances, like he was abducted, partial remains were later found?

PW: Yes.

PM: Have you ever known Larry Waldo to harm anybody?

PW: Never.

PM: Have you ever known Larry Waldo to become violent?

PW: No.

PM: Have you ever known Larry Waldo to get angry or get physically abusive with children?

PW: No.

PM: When we were talking about your going down to move Pearl Waldo up here, do you recall the address she was living at at that time?

PW: Yes. 6316 Johnson Street, Hollywood, Florida and I think the zip is 33024.

PM: Larry Waldo told the police in 1983 and whether he is correct or not on his dates, that he had visited his family in Alabama and was enroute back home and stopped and spent sometime in Jacksonville, Florida and rented a room and apparently stayed there a while, do you know anything about that?

PW: No.

PM: Larry never told you he had stayed in Jacksonville?

PW: No.

PM: And Larry was getting social security checks right?

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PW: Yes.

PM: Since he changed his residence so often, do you know how he was able to keep getting his checks sent to him?

PW: He would call them and tell them to send it to another address.

PM: When Larry was travelling back and forth from South Florida to Alabama, I know you explained he was hitchhiking, did he ever in his travels back and forth sit down and relate where he stopped and where he slept or how he got money along the way?

PW: Yes.

PM: And what did he tell you?

PW: He would stop at different churches along the way, they would give him money, food and some would buy him new clothes for him. Mostly at churches, YMCA he would stop there.

PM: How about Salvation Army?

PW: Yes he did.

PM: Did he ever mention any particular churches by name?

PW: No, there was a Catholic church down around Doven, Alabama where he particularly liked to stop at, but I don't know the name of it.

PM: Besides social security do you know if Larry was receiving any other benefits that we might be able to trace?

PW: No not in less it would be medicaid.

PM: Do you have any kind of papers left that belong to Larry Waldo or have information about Larry Waldo?

PW: Not anymore.

PM: Now Larry got arrested for DUI but he didn't have a driver's license, from your personal knowledge do you know if he was perfectly capable of driving a car?

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PW: I never knew of him driving a car.  
PM: So this came as a surprise to you that he was arrested for that?  
PW: To my knowledge he never had a driver's license.  
PM: Do you remember if Larry Waldo ever mentioned the name Betty Goodyear?  
PW: No.  
PM: No he never mentioned it?  
PW: Never mentioned it.  
PM: Does the address 141 West 10th Street, Jacksonville, Florida mean anything to you?  
PW: No it doesn't.  
PM: In Florida in Hollywood, do you know if he had any particularly close friend or anybody I could go try to find and like shed some light on Larry's whereabouts in July of 1981, more specifically than we have today?  
PW: There was a Suzie where he worked at a bar, he washed dishes in a bar.  
PM: Do you remember the name of the bar?  
PW: No I don't.  
PM: Do you remember where it was located?  
PW: It was on 441 highway south.  
PM: What kind of jobs did he usually do?  
PW: Well he would do about anything to make a little extra money. Mow yards, know whatever he could find.  
PM: Was Larry taking any mediation do you know?

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PW: The last time I saw him he was.

PM: Do you know what it was?

PW: No I don't, he said it was to keep him from hallucinating. Having bad dreams.

PM: We noted Larry gave a statement to Hollywood Police indicating it was his recollection of an account of his activities basically from December and January of 1980, '81 when he says he came up to Alabama and spent time with you folks and then headed back, wound up in a hospital, then out of the hospital, spent time in Jacksonville, met Ottis Toole and that is pretty much where the story ends, knowing that how much faith would you put in Larry Waldo's account of those activities?

PW: None.

PM: None as to the a fact or none as to the accuracy?

PW: The accuracy.

PM: You don't doubt that he met Ottis Toole and you no doubt that he remembers spending a holiday here and you don't doubt that he wound up in the hospital. But you question his ability to remember the dates?

PW: That's right.

PM: Has he shown you in the past to be inaccurate with dates?

PW: Yes.

PM: A lot?

PW: Yes.

PM: And what do you attribute that to?

PW: He was not I don't know how you would put it, he was not as intelligent as most average people are.

PM: Now Larry apparently had some psychiatric problems, do you feel that that had an influence on his ability to remember recount things?



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PW: Yes. He had a short attention span.

PM: Do you remember I mentioned to you a lady named Nancy Durando, D-U-R-A-N-D-O?

PW: Yes.

PM: Do you know who she is?

PW: I know of her, I don't know her personally.

PM: Do you know she had rented a room to Larry?

PW: Yes. He was living with her when he passed away.

PM: I interviewed Nancy Durando only because she rented the room to Larry and I was trying to track him down and his whereabouts I mean, I knew he was deceased, but in interviewing her she mentioned that there was an occasion where they were all sitting around watching television and apparently something came on regarding the Adam Walsh murder investigation and she said that Larry made the comment that he had been arrested for the Adam Walsh murder, hearing that today what is your reaction to that, how do you explain that?

PW: He would have said something like that to bring attention to himself and if he had given a statement to the police concerning anything to do with it he may have considered himself arrested if he gave a statement or something.

PM: Does the name Sally's Bar ring a bell?

PW: Yes.

PM: And how is that?

PW: I don't remember right now.

PM: Could that be the bar that he did the work in?

PW: Yes.

PM: What was the name of the lady you said that had something to do with that bar?

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PW: Susie, I don't if she was a waitress or if she ran it or what.

PM: I was asking you about churches and so forth before, do you remember if Larry ever mentioned a Church of God located just off Interstate 10 in Florida?

PW: No.

PM: The address 2130 Adams Street in Hollywood, does that do anything for you?

PW: No.

PM: Do you know if his mother lived there at one time?

PW: No she never did.

PM: I guess he just stayed in a lot of places where they would rent him a room is that it?

PW: Yes.

PM: And you mentioned a Jody right?

PW: Yes.

PM: And who is that?

PW: She had a little fruit stand on 441 Highway.

PM: Ok. But we don't know her last name?

PW: No.

PM: The Nadean Millican, N-I-L-L-I-C-A-N, that is your daughter?

PW: My niece by marriage.

PM: Niece, ok, and she is related to Larry as a sister?

PW: Right.

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PM: Did Nadean ever relay an incident to you where you said that Larry had gone to the police and confessed about a robbery that he had not done?

PW: Yes.

PM: Did she tell you how that came about?

PW: He had either read it or heard it on TV about a robbery and he went down and said he did it. Of course they laughed at him because he didn't have enough facts to verify that he did do it. He didn't know enough about the case.

PM: So I mean Larry would sometime make statements to people that weren't true?

PW: Absolutely.

PM: Did Nadean live with Larry for quite awhile? Or associate with Larry for quite awhile?

PW: Yes.

PM: Have you asked Nadean if she knows where Larry was in July of 1981?

PW: Yes I have.

PM: And what did she say?

PW: She doesn't know.

PM: In fact have you talked to many people in the family about where he was in July of '81 in hopes that somebody might remember?

PW: Yes.

PM: Anybody remember?

PW: No.

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PM: Do you remember, we spoke on the phone and going over my notes I remember you mentioning something about you were remembering that Larry stayed up here for the holidays, December, January, '82 as opposed to other years and that he stayed at your home, do you remember that?

PW: Yes.

PM: What made you remember that he was there then, December, January '82?

PW: It was our first Christmas in our new house.

PM: And while he was staying here did he have some sort of an episode, problem?

PW: He jumped up in the middle of the night and went to hollering and screaming and whenever I got in there he had a bed sheet swinging it around over his head hollering "I'll get him, I'll get him".

PM: Do you recall he had some medication?

PW: Yes, he said he had forgot to take his medication. That kept him from doing that.

PM: Do you remember who gave him medication?

PW: He said a doctor in Jacksonville.

PM: You didn't question him who the doctor was or if it was in a hospital or private doctor?

PW: No.

PM: Just for the record, what was his father's full name?

PW: Carvil -

PM: C-A-R-V-I-L?

PW: Yes, Jackson.

PM: How can you describe Larry's childhood?

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PW: Not a very rosy childhood at all. Not the normal. He was abused.

PM: Was he physically abused, sexually abused?

PW: Yes, physically.

PM: Physically by his mother or his father?

PW: Both.

PM: Both, was that ever brought to the attention to the authorities?

PW: Yes it was.

PM: Which ones?

PW: Broward County -

PM: HRS, Sheriff's Office or HRS?

PW: There was this lady that was from the Sheriff's Office that did the investigation.

PM: That would have been quite sometime ago wasn't it?

PW: Oh yes. This was back in the 60's.

PM: Ok that is about all the questions I have, is there anything you would want to tell me that you think might be of any kind of significance no matter how small?

PW: Not at this time.

PM: This will conclude the statement.

PM: As an investigator with the State Attorney's Office I have the authority to take your statement under oath, so I need you to raise your right hand and do you solemnly swear and affirm that the statement that you are about to give will be the truth, the whole truth so help you god?

CW: I do.

PM: For the record would you state your full name and date of birth?

CW: Clyde Kenneth Waldo, March 24, 1938.
