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The following will be a voluntary sworn statement reference to a homicide/ murder that occurred on or about July 27, 1981, occurring at Sears Mall, located at 300 Hollywood Mall, City of Hollywood, County of Broward, State of Florida. This statement is being obtained by Detective J. Hoffman #0038 and Detective Buddy Terry of the Jacksonville Police Department Homicide Unit. This statement is being obtained from the suspect identified as TOOLE, OTTIS ELWOOD, W/M, DOB: 3/5/47, who is currently serving time at Raiford State Prison and is presently at the Jacksonville County Police Jail. This statement is commencing on Wednesday, October 26, 1983, at approximately 10:42 P.M.

DET. HOFFMAN: Prior to taking your statement, OTTIS, are you aware that it is a crime under Florida State Statutes to knowingly furnish false information while under oath?

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: At this time, I'm gonna place you under oath as virtue of my commission as a Notary Public for the State of Florida, Broward County, okay?

MR. TOOLE: Okay.

DET. HOFFMAN: Do you know what it is to be placed under oath?

MR. TOOLE: That means tell the truth.

DET. HOFFMAN: Fine. Okay. At this time, OTTIS, will you please raise your right hand. (Let the record reflect that the witness' right hand is raised). OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE, do you solemnly swear to tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth so help you God?

MR. TOOLE: I do.

DET. HOFFMAN: Before we get into this statement, OTTIS, I'm gonna advise you of your rights under the law like I've done on previous statements, okay.

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DET. HOFFMAN: You have the right to remain silent and refuse to answer questions. Do you understand?

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Anything you do say may be used against you in a court of law. Do you understand?

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: You have the right to consult an attorney before speaking to the police and to have an attorney present during questioning now or in the future. Do you understand?

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: You have the right to consult an attorney before speaking to the police and to have an attorney present during questioning now or in the future. Do you understand?

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: If you cannot afford an attorney one will be appointed for you before any questioning if you wish. Do you understand?

MR. TOOLE: Yea I understand that.

DET. HOFFMAN: If you decide to answer questions now without an attorney present, you still have the right to stop answering at any time until you talk to an attorney. Do you understand?

MR. TOOLE: Yea I understand.

DET. HOFFMAN: Knowing and understanding your rights as I have explained them to you are you willing to answer our questions without an attorney

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present?

MR. TOOLE: Yes.

DET. HOFFMAN: Now OTTIS, just a little while ago, I finished a statement from you regarding your whereabouts from July 24th when you were up in Newport News, Virginia, until you arrived in Jacksonville.

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Correct?

MR. TOOLE: Right okay.

DET. HOFFMAN: In that statement, okay, you indicated that you got back from Newport News, you stayed in the Jacksonville area for a couple of weeks.

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Earning money doing various things before you ever left Jacksonville, okay. Then I showed you from my investigation that I was able to put you back here in Jacksonville no earlier than the 25th of July, correct?

MR. TOOLE: Yea that's right.

DET. HOFFMAN: Then you went on and told me you stayed there for a long period of time and then I showed it to you that it was impossible for you to kill ADAM WALSH, is that correct?

MR. TOOLE: Right.

DET. HOFFMAN: And then you told me you didn't kill ADAM WALSH and then you got upset emotionally and you started crying and then you said no I did kill the boy okay. So at this time I'm gonna take another statement from you, okay.

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MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Now in this statement are you gonna tell me the complete truth as you know it to be.

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay. You're not gonna lie while you're under oath.

MR. TOOLE: No sir.

DET. HOFFMAN: Now you're the one who requested for me to take another statement at this time is that correct?

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Cause I told you I wasn't gonna ask you any more questions I was gonna leave tonight and come back tomorrow. Is that right?

MR. TOOLE: Right.

DET. HOFFMAN: And you're the one who initiated and told me I'd like to give you another statement is that correct?

MR. TOOLE: Uh huh.

DET. HOFFMAN: You haven't been tricked or fooled into giving this statement have you?

MR. TOOLE: No.

DET. HOFFMAN: Are you giving this statement on your own free will?

MR. TOOLE: Yes.

DET. HOFFMAN: Cause you want to?

MR. TOOLE: Yes.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay, OTTIS, we're gonna go back to the time you left

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Newport News, Virginia, okay. I showed you and I told you that I contacted people up in the Salvation Army who have documentation that they wrote you a check for seventy-one dollars and ninety-three cents on July 24th, 1981.

MR. TOOLE: Right.

DET. HOFFMAN: And that from there you went directly to the bus terminal.

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay, now in your own words you tell me and Detective Terry what time you got on the bus, what time you think you arrived here in Jacksonville and what you did from that day on.

MR. TOOLE: I'd say it was eleven, eleven thirty in the day time.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay you're getting this time from the schedule that . . .

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: . . . that I showed you that the bus company was able to furnish for you with.

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Alright so now you're on the bus from Newport News and you arrive in Jacksonville, sometime on July 25th, 1981, that being a Saturday Correct?

MR. TOOLE: Yea that's correct. That's right.

DET. HOFFMAN: Now take it from that day, what you did from the time that you parted the bus until whatever.

MR. TOOLE: As soon as I got - got back off of the bus here in Jacksonville, I went up to - I had a set of keys to the gate.

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DET. TERRY: What gate are you talking about, OTIS? What company?

MR. TOOLE: Southeast.

DET. TERRY: Southeastern or Reaves Roofing Company.

MR. TOOLE: Oh Reaves Roofing Company.

DET. TERRY: Is that the one on East 19th Street.

MR. TOOLE: It's on east, yes it's on East 19th Street. It's on 19th and Blair Streets.

DET. TOOLE: 19th and Blair.

DET. HOFFMAN: Now that gate we're referring to, what's kept behind that gate?

MR. TOOLE: That's uh, well that's company trucks are always parked there.

DET. HOFFMAN: And what else was parked there besides a company truck?

MR. TOOLE: My Cadillac is parked in the yard there.

DET. TERRY: What did it look like. Which Cadillac was it?

MR. TOOLE: A 1971 Cadillac with a black vinyl top and a white bottom.

DET. HOFFMAN: That would be the car that you purchased from MRS. McNATT.

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay, was it night time or was it day time.

MR. TOOLE: It was in the day time.

DET. HOFFMAN: Was the gate locked?

MR. TOOLE: Yea I had a set of keys to the gate.

DET. HOFFMAN: Reaves was closed that day, you didn't work. All their

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equipment was locked up behind that gate.

MR. TOOLE: They could have been out somewhere. Cause lots of times if there ain't nobody around there, they lock the gates back.

DET. TERRY: The gates were locked.

MR. TOOLE: I have always had a set of keys to all the, all the gates.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay. So you go in there and you get your car.

MR. TOOLE: I go in and I get my car.

DET. TERRY: Did you have spare keys in the car.

MR. TOOLE: Yea I had spare keys. I always had a spare key made for every car I had.

DET. HOFFMAN: Do you kept it with you when you travel?

MR. TOOLE: At my mother's house. It was burned but it wasn't pushed down.

DET. TERRY: That's the one on Day Avenue.

MR. TOOLE: Yea it's on 708 Day Avenue.

DET. TERRY: Okay.

MR. TOOLE: I had some money buried in a tin can underneath the house. I had three hundred dollars, over three hundred dollars in the can. Cause I always had hidden money, different times when I didn't wanna tote money on me underneath the house.

DET. HOFFMAN: Alright. What did you do then?

MR. TOOLE: Well I got the money, went down to the station, I filled the tank up.

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DET. HOFFMAN: What gas station did you go to?

MR. TOOLE: That's a Shell Station right down near, no it coulda been the Shell Station. Otherwise it was a gas station right there on Mc - on McDuff, sometimes I would go down there and buy gas at the mini-market or at the station down there, it could have been the Shell, I ain't really sure, but I always go to that Mini Market and fill up the car all the time.

DET. HOFFMAN: So you filled up your car with gas. Did you speak to anyone or see anyone that knows you or that you know from the time you arrive on the bus until you picked up your car?

MR. TOOLE: I ain't that, that positive.

DET. HOFFMAN: Did you see your wife?

MR. TOOLE: I could have.

DET. HOFFMAN: What about JOHN REAVES?

MR. TOOLE: I don't think I did.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay. What did you do after you filled your car up with gas?

MR. TOOLE: I left, I got on the freeway.

DET. HOFFMAN: Alright. You're sayin freeway. Are you talkin about Interstate 95, are we talkin the Florida Turnpike.

MR. TOOLE: Interstate 95.

DET. HOFFMAN: You're positive.

MR. TOOLE: Positive.

DET. TERRY: Now what was that?

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MR. TOOLE: Goin south.

DET. HOFFMAN: What time would this have been?

MR. TOOLE: Oh shoot that was still, that wasn't too, wasn't too far up in the day.

DET. HOFFMAN: Was it morning?

MR. TOOLE: Yea it was pretty well in the morning.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay. Did you take any clothing with you? Suitcase?

MR. TOOLE: Well lots of times I kept clothes in the car.

DET. HOFFMAN: Did you have a suitcase with you from Virginia? When you were traveling on the bus?

MR. TOOLE: Yea a had a little, little zipper bag, bag with clothes in it.

DET. HOFFMAN: Okay. So you got on the Interstate you said. Prior to you gettin on the Interstate . . .

MR. TOOLE: Yea.

DET. HOFFMAN: Did you have to go anywhere and pick up any tools or anything to that nature?

MR. TOOLE: No cause I had everything right in the car.

DET. HOFFMAN: What was kept in that car while it was stored there?

MR. TOOLE: I had all kinds of tools in the car, shovel in the car, I had a machete underneath the seat.

DET. HOFFMAN: Alright so you had everything in the car and you're traveling on Interstate 95 southbound. Okay.

MR. TOOLE: And sometimes I would run that Alabama license plate tag on it. But I had, had lots of different tags on it. On different cars that I had bought, I was keeping them in the trunk of the car.

DET. HOFFMAN: When you picked up the car from that locked gate, was the tag already on the car? You didn't have to put a tag on it.

MR. TOOLE: No I didn't have to put no tag on the car.
