Dear Mr. Loe:

After speaking to you today it did not take take much in my process and power of thinking to know where I stand. I've maintained the same, and exact terms, if people want to gain my cooperation.

At this point, I do not see how Florida can understand, accept, and honor my terms. We both found out that BSO will not facilitate the terms I demand in exchange for my cooperation. This attitude problem is their problem, not mine. I've always maintained the adage: "Attitude begins with the person." What you sow, you reap. BSO has sowed the attitude, and

now they reap what they have sowed.

BSO is the major "imposse". I will not ever trust them... the present BSO administration.

At this point it is necessary to secure someone, be it a high state official, e.g., the Florida Attorney General, or Governor, to legally secure the terms I require as to the thorough and detailed treatment of myself... giving me what I want.

In my letter to you dated November 11th, 1995, I cited a few of the issues, e.g., telephone access, television, media visits, coffee, smoking, food, etc., etc., etc.

These conditions, and a few others, like not disturbing my sleep, excessive noise, etc., etc., must be met before I cooperate with anyone in the United States.

You know my position. We have been through some of this before. I will not negotiate. My terms will be met, or people can just take a kite and fly it out of my life.

I will tell you right now, so listen up! I will not speak to any investigator. So do not even attempt to send me to my prison. Treatment agreements will be entered into before I go any further. The agreements will be in contract form, and I'll need to know for certain they are legally binding. I do not give a damn about ~~the~~ laws, such as the prohibitive smoking laws in Florida jails. I do not give a damn how they treat other prisoners. This involves me. I am an individual. I cut my own hay. I hammer out my own deals.

I will not let myself ever become an inmate at Broward Jail. So it is also necessary to locate me at a place I feel is acceptable, if Florida feels it's in their interest to cut hay with me.

You need to find "that" person with full power, control, and authority to enter into agreements with me if Florida ever expects to win my cooperation. Do not

All agreements will be done legally, and written in detail. I'll get them out when the person is found & authorized.

toy with me. I will not discuss any thing else except an agreement. I will not put up with any verbal attempts to get me to talk. Florida has to reach first base first with me. I will not put up with any "hum and haw". It's either "shit or get off the pot".

Tony, I'm very comfortable where I'm at. I have nothing to gain. But I'll damn sure not loose even one iota of the conditions I now have. If anything, Florida will have to meet and slightly exceed my present life conditions.

You need to be aware that I will not be tricked or fooled.

I cling to every word from the ~~not~~ mouth of people. So it's now up to you to find the person who ~~can~~ can exclusively make guarantees. I don't speak to peon investigators. They got no stroke or power to deal with me.

Call here and set up a legal call for us before Christmas.

Dear Tony:

I received your letter of January 29, 1996, and the transcript of the December 21, 1995 telephone interaction. You state the transcript was a courtesy. But it truly was my unequivocal requirement to be provided this transcript as a predicate before further communication. But I don't write now to tweak your nose... as hard as it is to refrain from doing so.

Anyway, I caught a small article in the national news section of USA TODAY, that ran on February 16th, 1996, that the case files on Adam Walsh were ordered released to the public. It cites John Walsh complaining that a successful prosecution would never happen now. But I personally doubt the files contain detrimental undermining information. I had wrote a letter to you prior to seeing this article, but haven't decided if I'll mail it to you. I just set the record straight but do not inculcate myself.

The purpose of this letter is to show you just how downright foolish Florida is in not entering deals with me.

Florida has self-screwed itself when in fact, dealing with me would of shown good faith. I say this because I truly have nothing to gain. Let me explain.

I told you in our December 21, 1995 telephone conversation, that is clearly documented on page 2 of this transcript, that "I'm trying to withdraw my appeal in Mississippi." I'm very serious!

In fact, I have my "Emergency Motion to Dismiss Appeal" completed, photo copies made, and sitting here ready to mail. I'm just waiting for an address that I should receive this week. The Mississippi Supreme Court has advised me to file an original and nine (9) copies of my Motion to Dismiss Appeal. So I'm on a roll. I'm requesting a June 3, 1996 execution date, making this date mandatory. So they got approximately 3-months to grant my motion to dismiss. The state has cried "death penalty" from every pulpit. And now its time for them to put action where their mouths have been. I lock them into this June 3rd date. So if they want to avoid

total embarrassment and future political bashing, they better not mess up. They could not explain away to the public why Donald wasn't executed when Donald volunteered to be executed. I expect to be on the record in 10-14 days from the date of this letter.

So where do this now leave Florida in the situation now at hand? It leaves Florida with a face full of shit they put there themselves. You suggest I do what my conscience dictates. Well... I did when I made contact with you. It is not Donald who needs to check the conscience meter. It is Florida. Florida needs to check its conscience meter in intelligence in this matter. It's not very smart to play hardball "we don't deal" with a guy who is begging to be executed. And I damn sure won't beg them to deal. My conscience is clear. I made an offer they should not have refused or hummed a how over. To open my door now, before I'm executed, will require much more than I originally proffered as a deal. But as of this

writing I hope only 97 more days are left to my life. So what could Florida possibly offer me? Playing it up to my conscience will not open my mouth that is now shut with the strength of sign mater. Tony, far as I'm concerned, Florida didn't even try in this matter. And the only connection to me is you. I will not speak to anyone else. I mean this 100%!
But even this connection is not in a good standing due to the attitude I've found in this matter.

Right now I feel that this cell is my crypt. But there are no tales to tell Florida since they want to play this little game.

Toney, I bet if you put the brains of those jukes down there into a bird, the motherfucker'd fly backwards! They can cheer my death all they want. Why... I'd even buy them party hats and noise makers. But I see the ineptness of their persona. A bunch of clowns in a one-ring circus act nobody comes to see. I bet they entertain each other with made up stories of pussy eaten and ~~at~~ assholes beaten. Which is

the true extent of their mental command. They cannot deal at my intellectual level. But I tend to not put you into this category. You've exhibited a rationale far above most. Not many have reached the level you have with me. But don't brag about it... they might commit you to the Looney Farm. Swear to God I planted a micro-chip in your brain. Then they could appoint Jim Lewis to represent you in competency proceedings!

Well... I'm sure you'll hear in the news that I've dismissed appeals. I'm also filing a 15-page motion for Dr. Jack Kevorkian, a/k/a, Dr. Death to be appointed as executor, and a motion to broadcast my execution to the public. Ought to get real interesting! But Kevorkian can educate the public on painless death. So I'm doing a service to science. He is the most experienced executioner in America in medically induced deaths. Talents I can relate to in a way.

I'll wait to hear from you in the mail. My death clock is ticking. There are not 11-hour appeals.

Dear Donald:

I am in receipt of your letters. I'm sorry you feel that my tape recording our phone conversation was "playing hard ball". As I am sure you are aware, I was candid with you and informed you of my intentions to record our conversation so that I would have a record of what was said. Whether you choose to believe me or not, I do not take notes well and wish to have a record that accurately reflects the substance of our discussions. Even though I am not required to do so, I am enclosing a copy of the telephone discussion transcript as a courtesy. As I have mentioned previously, I do not relish the position in which you have placed me as an intermediary. I would quite happily relinquish this role to the lead detective on the Adam Walsh homicide investigation. He is a competent and very capable individual.

The authorities here are not interested in negotiating any deals with you until you satisfactorily demonstrate to them that you have reliable information about the Walsh case. I am not suggesting that they ever would be interested in negotiating with you, that issue remains to be resolved. However, I can assure you no one will do anything until you are forthcoming and candid regarding the knowledge you claim to have. The ball is in your court. I suggest you do what your conscience dictates. Take care.

Telephone conversation from Donald Evans(DE) to Tony Loe(TL),
Assistant State Attorney dated December 21, 1995.

DE: Tony.

TL: Donald, how are you sir.

DE: Oh, just enjoying the holidays.

TL: I'll bet. I wanted to tell you right up front that I am
taping this call.

DE: Ahh well the thing about it is Tony, I don't consent to that.

TL: O.K.

DE: You see, the thing is that when I tried to get recordings.

TL: Right.

DE: Remember that.

TL: Well....

DE: You know.....

TL: You mean from the ahh video people here.

DE: Well, no, no, I'm talking about recording equipment over there
in the court of law. I said well since Marty Rich wanted a
recorder I can get a recorder too.

TL: (Laughter) I do remember that.

DE: So the thing about it is it's tit for tat on that too. You
know.

TL: Donald I don't have to tell you we are allowed. Law
enforcement are allowed to record in the State of Florida. I
don't have to tell you that at all. Because I've always been
up front with you. I'm telling you.

DE: I'm sure you can get a court order either way, Tony.

TL: But I, I am just being up front with you. I didn't want to do
it secretly I wanted to tell you Donald I want to record the
call and the problem is that I don't take notes. I'm not a
secretary and I want a make sure, this is very important what
you are telling me, and I want a make sure that I get it
right. That there's no misunderstanding. That I don't
misunderstand what you are telling me.

DE: I don't consent to that, you know.

TL: O.K.

DE: You know, I just can't. I mean....

TL: O.K. I understand where you are coming from. Ahhh, then you are the one that's going to be terminating the conversation, not me. And but you always know where to find me. And if you want to reach out for me give me a holler.

DE: See you know that's that's that's where you people mess up you know I told you in the letters don't don't be doing anything about anything that I don't approve.

TL: O.K. Wow, Donald I don't want you to feel like I am truckin with you because I don't feel that I am. All I'm doing is trying to make sure that what you tell me I get it right. Ahhh, you know I suggested that we have Mark.....

DE: Well I'm not going to tell you anything. I mean what I've asked you about is what are they gonna do to enter into an agreement. That's all I told you that I'd talk about.

TL: Right and I understand that and I'm running around telling people about it and everybody is sort of turning there backs on me. Going Donald, isn't that the guy that took everybody out on the expedition out in Arizona and they dug up half the "aah" desert.

DE: Wasn't that the guy too that they broke, violated agreements on. I mean even your own Detective over there in Gulfport knows about it. Williams, he knew about it.

TL: My Detective.... I don't know anything about a Detective Williams in Gulfport.

DE: Alright that's alright because I have nothing to gain or lose.

TL: And I understand that. Donald you picked me.

DE: I'm right now trying to do one thing. I'm trying to withdraw my appeal in Mississippi.

TL: O.K.

DE: Alright. Decide who I will go ahead and put my five chairs down there for the witnesses. You know maybe I oughta go ahead and sell occupancy. You know mezzanine.

TL: (Laughter) Upper level and lower level.

DE: You know it doesn't really matter. Alright. But the thing is is that you know all this mumbo jumbo. Oh I do apologize I didn't put that you know that appendage in that last letter.

TL: Which one?

DE: That thing I sent to the people. That I referred too. When I challenged them.

TL: I don't no what you are talking about.

DE: I just sent a letter, I don't no if you got it, dated aaah... it had yellow and white paper on December 9th.

TL: No. I, I got the one that you wrote the day we last spoke.

DE: Alright, well that.....

TL: I think that was, was that the 7th

DE: Yeah. Alright

TL: But that, that, Oh well I got the Christmas card from you too but I don't have a letter from you that would be on both yellow and white paper. I have not received it.

DE: Well I don't know what happened to it.

TL: I haven't received that. But it's the 7th I think it's been taking like seven days for it to get to me when you write it.

DE:But Ahhh, I didn't put an insert in there like I thought I would of. Because it was in the bottom of my stack and I....

TL: That's not like you Donald you are very methodical. You are always when you....

DE: Well I didn't have postage at the time. And you know and I had to wait so you know I didn't get methodical all at the same moments.

TL: (Laughter) No I don't think that ever leaves you. That methodical part.

DE: Oh I realized it after I deposited it in the mail you know. But see the thing is, is that all, you know what I mean, Well that's when I said Tony, in this last letter

TL: The one that I've not yet received

DE: I told them that I am not going to go for the pessimism.

TL: Yeah.

DE: You know I mean, them mother fuckers how much money have they made investigating cases that they ain't fuckin got yet.

TL: I don't know. Donald I, I, I, what I keep coming back to is wait a minute he told us about this case in Fort Lauderdale and up to that point I don't think it even been listed as a homicide that's what I keep coming back to. And they are going yeah well then they also dug up half the desert in Arizona and he laughed his ass off at them. So it's like.... you know.

DE: I explain all that in that letter that you haven't got yet

TL: O.K. are you sure you don't want to talk to a Detective instead of me. I mean I'm not train to do this. You know all I'm.....

DE: Tony you know what you need to do?

TL: What.

DE: Is make communications with a guy name Lt. Valentine.

TL: Lt. Valentine.

DE: Yeah. He's at the Y (?? Navajo) Sheriff's Department out there in ahhh in Arizona.

TL: Yavaho. (??? Navajo)

DE: Yavabahoorra. Are whatever it is and he will tell you exactly what they did. I mean Evan Moore quoted that in his story. I mean the only thing he said every time he found them people they were at the hotel drinking fuckin Miakis.

TL: (Laughter)

DE: I mean you know a real fuckin investigation. You no...

TL: Yeah. Yeah.

DE: You know and the thing is, is that you no I told them you no I told them even that they were suppose to keep it confidential even before we left (Talford) right.

TL: Right.

DE: Well the media was fuckin swarming the fuckin police

department out there in Arizona and they didn't even know we were coming.

TL: You're kidding me.

DE: No and aaah Yeah. And and and but you see this was a violation in the agreements too. Alright them people didn't give, the media started blasting them and they didn't know what the fuck was happening. It was supposed to be a gage on it right but when we left Mississippi it was right on the front page of the fuckin paper.

TL: When you pled guilty here I didn't tell one person it was going to happen. I went to court kept my mouth shut. And I hadn't told anyone I don't, I don't need...

DE: Tony

TL: What.

DE: And that's another thing. You know that day McCampell almost made me just fuckin just say hey take me back to the jail. When she starts preaching, you no, as long as he obey the rules and regulations of the institution. I mean shove them fucking rules up their ass. When do they understand that I don't read rule books.

TL: I understand that. I mean. It's I I've told you from the... from the first day that we sat down I told you I look you dead in the eye right across the table I said I think I understand you. You don't no me from Adam. But I think I understand where you are coming from.

DE: I'm easy Tony.

TL: Well..

DE: I don't play games.

TL: No you don't play games but I don't play games either that's why I told you where I am coming from and that's why I don't feel comfortable being in the middle of all this and I througt instead of having some.....

DE: Well it's kind of a real real hard situation you know, I mean, like I told you in that one letter that there's going to be deals and agreements made first, and and I don't care, you know, what they can say, you know they can try anything they want

TL: Yeah

DE: But it ain't gonna do know good.

TL: Yeah. Donald I understand where you are coming from. Alright, you picked me as a pipeline or as a conduit whatever you want to refer to. I'm telling people, hey, Donald Evans tells me I know all about the Adam Walsh case. Isn't that what you told me. Verbatim.

DE: Tony I told you in the letters that we were going to talk about agreements.

TL: Well, I, I get. Nobody wants to hear anything here unless I tell them something more.

DE: So don't try and get into that o.k.

TL: O.K. fine. But let me tell you what they are saying. They are saying to me. Hey, Donald Evans has got a life sentence, he's got a life, and he's got a death sentence. You know, so what! And you know the Adam Walsh thing. Hey, Adam Walsh is dead. Everybody knows that. You know and Donald Evans maybe he's looking for an escape thing he's not telling us anything, he's saying I know all about the Adam Walsh case. Well quite frankly, they are saying we aren't getting excited about this.

DE: Seems to me, Seems to me like they fired two mother fuckers over there. When they had the whole fucking plan before Fogelman took a long trip on a short rope.

TL: Yeah, that's true. I said I wish someone would have turned around and tied the knots correctly. Anyway...

DE: I mean you know, the thing is, you know they can say anything they want Tony, all right, it's all self serving, I explained that to you in this other letter.

TL: O.K. the one I didn't receive.

DE: Alright.

TL: Yeah.

DE: Alright, I don't understand, I'm going to have to check my mail logs because I know I put .82 cents on the damn thing. You know but the thing is I don't know why, you know, these people. You know, I don't care about them Tony. O.K. I can understand their attitude just like I told you in this letter you didn't get I said I can understand why Fort Lauderdale has been rated as one of the highest crime cities in America. It's because of that fuckin attitude Tony.

TL: Yeah.

DE: Have you ever figured that out.

TL: Well, Donald-I told you before I'm just a peon here and I just try to work within the system.

DE: Go to Fort Lauderdale kill somebody and get away with it. You know.

TL: I hope that doesn't happen. But there are definitely unsolved homicides here, there is no question about that.

DE: O.K. I mean but you see the thing about it is, I don't care a bout all them attitudes. They can say anything they want.

TL: Well Donald the thing.....

DE: out in the desert and this dat and the other but the thing about it is Tony, you know that Lt. Valentine his name is quoted in there. You know, if he can, you know, its like I told you even then, in the letter I told him at that time if they have any doubts I'll take a polygraph. But the thing is Tony, the polygraph is going to be done in public. I ain't got nothing to hide.

TL: Polygraph on what?

DE: On me.

TL: But what?

DE: You see if they ever had any doubts about me. But the thing is about it Tony, What have they shown to prove me wrong.

TL: Donald I don't know. I know about one piece of a pie and I know that's the Ft. Lauderdale case. That's it. You said you were involved in it, you knew facts about it.

DE: Hold on Tony, now we got to get back to this other thing here. You no I am not going to discuss the case.

TL: O.K.

DE: The thing is, you know, they either going to shit or get off the pot.

TL: I think what they are saying is, you know, Evans hasn't told us anything. And I'm going

DE: I know Tony, I know Tony, alright, we ain't gonna get that far o.k.

TL: O.K.

DE: Because that's inculpatory and I'm not going to get that far unless I have it on black and white.

TL: Donald I appreciate what you are coming from apparently, you are a smart man. You know what people are thinking long before they even think about thinking it. But what's happening is....

DE: Look here I told you before police are predictable man. They are like fuckin drones. You know, I mean they are predictable. O.K.

TL: Yeah.

DE: I mean they are fuckin the most predictable people in the world.

TL: Well, and then I guess you knew as soon as you said, if I say Adam Walsh they'll pay attention but I ain't gonna tell them anything cause they gotta follow up on it.

DE: I'm not saying, Tony, I'm not saying anything. The thing about it is, if they don't want it to be that way that's fine. O.K.

TL: O.K. I just, but that's what, I called Hollywood and what they are telling me is, we got some other guy that confessed to it. That guy knows all about the case and you know we are only inches away from charging him. Evans has already got all this other stuff. Evans isn't telling us anything why should we do anything until we know that Evans has got something. He's not indicating anything why would we buy a pig in a poke. You know is what they are saying basically and I'm going, hell, I don't know, I don't know anything about Adam Walsh. I wasn't in Florida during that time. I don't no anything about what Donald's done other than what he'd did here. And so all I know is the man said he did a homicide here. The medical examiner at the time said it was a heroin overdose. Donald Evans knows all sorts of facts about it. And you no

DE: Even a twenty dollar bill, huh.

TL: Absolutely, and I'm going, you know the man proved himself to me. That's why I am paying attention. And its like nobody else seems to want to pay attention. I don't know. But I don't, I'm not

DE: Do you still think that they are still rated as one of the highest crimes cities in the world?

TL: Donald That's, I mean all I am telling you, I keep coming back to I'm not getting anybody to

DE: And then Tate asked me do you think there is an attitude or compliance. You know what do you call it.....

TL: Complacency.

DE: Complacency over at the jail. I mean I was about to spit my fuckin lunch out of my gut man.

TL: Yeah.

DE: You know.

TL: But see where I am coming from. What's happening is sort of like when you would posture with me about BSO I would tell you I don't have any control over them. Now you yelling at me about Hollywood. And I'm saying I'm not the Chief down there. I don't run that Department. All I'm doing is saying this man is telling me he knows about this.

DE: Hollywood runs right up underneath BSO, O.K.

TL: Yeah.

DE: O.K. the thing about it is Tony, you know, I've told you in this letter I'm exercising discretion in this situation.

TL: Then that's your privilege. Donald you don't even have to call me. I understand that.

DE: I know, I mean I'm saying I came to you to do one thing to try to be peaceful, try to be open and try to do one thing, do it right. But the thing about it is I'm not going to put myself into a treatment situation like I endured with the Smith case.

TL: O.K. and I understand what you are saying. Just like you are being open and I'm not being nothing but open with you. And certainly I'm being peaceful I don't like I don't relish being in the middle of this. You got a beef with Hollywood I wish you would tell the detective. Hey shove it up your rear end. Instead you only wanta talk to me. You know what I mean. I'd rather say to my boss, hey lets fly this detective out there that doesn't think Evans has got anything.

DE: And that would be a mistake.

TL: Well but thats, my point is, you're yelling at me and I got know control over Hollywood.

DE: Tony, I am being very very, you know, I'm just, I'm just here.

TL: O.K.

DE: I mean you know I am very content.

TL: I know you are, I mean, you told me in your letter. You got your smokes what you couldn't have here. I appreciate that. You got T.V. There was a problem with that. I understand there's, you got nothing to gain by leaving there and I understand that. Got nothing at all and that's what I'm telling them. Why would he tell us this if he has nothing to gain. He's got nothing to gain by leaving that facility.

DE: Tony, you know, I mean, I you know, Mississippi I will back down there real soon. You know. I mean they can come up with either fuckin games they want and I'm looking for this, looking for that. But that ain't it, Tony I'd rather solve this and not even fuckin be out of here.

TL: Well then.....

DE: But the thing about it is that I'm sure that they are just operating on a bunch of speculation and conjecture. You know as far as what they got now. Because you know ahh, I can't see how they got anything myself, you no what I mean. By my point of view.

TL: (laughter) Donald, that's why I'm telling them I think you'll oughta listen to what he's saying. And they are going (noise with month)

DE: Tony, Tony. Have I ever, Tony, when it comes down to situations that you and I have been involved with, I've always been, I feel I've always shot you straight.

TL: That's what I feel and that's why I'm telling him them you

need to listen to Donald Evans.

DE: Tony, Tony only when somebody went sideways on me did I ever bark.

TL: Fair enough.

DE: O.K. that's the only time. And most of the time they found out that I a formidable evil if they push me. I mean I didn't lose down there Tony.

TL: ----- No Way. I told you Donald, I told you

DE: Dead man laying out on the concrete. Got two fuckin top jailers fired. You got a fuckin Lt. with a broken fuckin noise. How could I lose Tony.

TL: Donald who sat across the table from you, the first he met you face to face, and said until you feel like you won you are not leaving this facility.

DE: You are not the only one who said that.

TL: O.K. well who told you that within a week of him getting on the case.

DE: Even Jack Santos told me that.

TL: O.K. but who told you that the week they got on the case?

DE: You know you guys did.

TL: Oh, no, you guys, me.

TL: Donald they are no more formidable opponents then you. And just like I said in the paper, Donald Evans is every smart.

DE: Tony, Tony, Tony no I didn't even complete 9th grade and I got a G.E.D.

TL: Donald you are very smart and don't try to BS me by saying you're not. I know you are and I will never under estimate you. You are always ten steps ahead of everybody else of what's going on. And I know that so don't try to B.S. me about that.

DE: Tony, Tony it's just the study of psychology. People are predictable. It's like the law of gravitvity for each action there is a equal opposite reaction. You know. Remember that one?

TL: Sure.

DE: And you know, you know, it's nothing but you know these people are you know by the book by the book. I mean, got damn they think they are the only ones to have read it.

TL: (laughter)

DE: I mean they are predictable and I'm not you know I'm not trying to cut them down or anything Tony. I'm just saying why don't they fuckin grow up and deal with somebody like a human being.

TL: Well...

TL: I think that's the only thing that I've done. is...

DE: And you have done that with me Tony, you see the thing about it is you know and I told you about it in this other letter here, if you can't get people down there to cooperate. Well Florida's got an ally up there in Washington D.C. that use to be a former Attorney General or Prosecutor you know down there in Miami. You know Janet Reno.

TL: Sure.

DE: You know, I mean I'm not trying to get her into that but you see the thing about it is you no the bullshit has to stop because one thing Tony, I want them people you no if she calls the table to say hey, what have you got to prove Donald wrong about Arizona but we got this cop that said that testified like I put in there in a deposition with Hilliard Moldoff that I stop talking because they broke agreements. You're own fuckin jurisdictional cop right there Robert Williams. Alright that deposition was taken on the 31st of, 1st of March, 1994.

TL: O.K.

DE: O.K. and the thing about it is Tony, I mean there's your own man telling you what happened. You know, and they're going to sit there and tell me that something different happened.

TL: I see, that's before I was on the case Donald, all I can do is tell you

DE: Tony, I mean, why are you going to fuck a man over that's got a shovel in your fuckin hand out there where it is 110 degrees in the fuckin shade. Man

See what was stated? You opened this door and I want full equality in a record for myself. So get a transcript to me fast, by Priority mail.

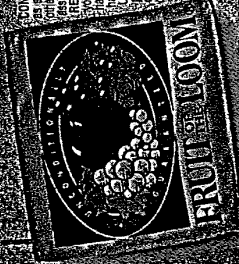

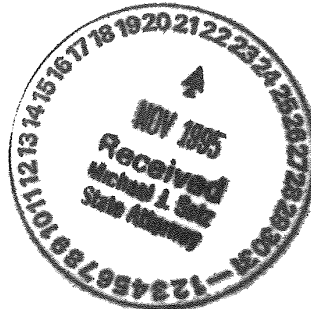

Dear Mr. Loe:

This is the most serious letter that has ever been penned to you from my hand. It's a difficult letter for me to endeavor upon. It is my opinion - that has reached true solidification - resulting from past interactions between us, that you are a source of reason concerned with important rather than trivial matters, which I can only illustrate by the contrastable ineptitude of flowing ignorance daily exhibited by the BSC hierarchical dunderheads. You proved to be a man of your word in the course of our legal wranglings. That is how to deal with me, gently without abusing me in any capacity.

It's pretty obvious that I have nothing to gain by imparting information to law enforcement. Kentucky thought I'd let them abuse me and deny me my basic habits that are my foundation to cope. It don't take much guts to abuse a man like me when there is a steel door between me and cops. Even the lowest coward will at times pick a fight sure to be won. But is it intellectually wise to kick a man in the nut sacks that can help you?

Many times I imparted to you that the numbskulls at BSO worried about the wrong things. What I mean about "wrong things", is their childish games of harassing me from every angle, eg., telephone access, television, media visits, smoking, coffee, food, etc., etc. I don't think you'll find any criminal justice teachings that states these harassments are a way to get a person like me to cooperate. Especially when I know in my mind information that was kept from coming out due to the abuses by BSO. I'd look at them jerks every day wondering what is wrong with them. In my mind

I'd laugh, albeit with a certain amount of pain at that trivial bunch of jerks, especially the self-proclaimed expert "cold-crimes unit" BSO has more than once bragged about. Yet, I sat for 18-months on the 8th floor, right above their heads, one of their most sought after people. But for some reason, BSO expended greater mental energy doing things like taking the television from my cell-block, waking me up every 15-minutes, etc., etc., etc. They damn sure got a dog and pony show, when what they really needed was the courage, heart, and brain the Great Wizard once possessed in Oz. I make not one joke, for I am very serious as I stated at the beginning of this letter.

Right now I am very content. I have a peace in my environment. The habits I partake of are at my leisure, and I'd actually loose to tell what I so much want to tell. It is not at the top of my list of desires to want to be brought back to Broward County. In fact - I'd like to avoid another stay in Florida. But

I hope we can somehow come to terms. I mean Florida when I refer to "me". I've debated for years inside of myself trying to fix upon a course and way to open up and tell it all about a horrible murder. Right there in your jurisdiction. I've wanted to at times tell one of my media sources, but this will not achieve what I require in treatment agreements, that are necessary, before I open my mouth. Furthermore, I will not ever speak to any detective connected to BSO or other agency that has interest in the information only I possess. It will be my exclusive choice that is non-negotiable, as to the persons and forum I choose when I tell all. I'll now give warning that no one, unless I approve, will ever attempt to confront me in any capacity because I'll clam up. It will be wise to keep foremost in your mind that they need me, more than I need them.

It really does bother me that I have to be cryptic with you. As I implied above - you have always been honest with me. It is

only because of this honesty that you have honorably engendered, that I for the first time ever reach out to you exclusively with the door that can and will bring to a close a major case. My door is not very complicated, from my side of the door. But your side of the door, based upon my past experiences, has potential negotiation problems. Because I will not ever allow myself to fall into a custody situation like that at Broward Jail, or any County Jail in Florida. I'm truly very comfortable where I'm at now. But I'm willing to give you and those above you in your office a chance to do the right thing with me, on this case, I find it necessary to only allude to in this letter. I've truly racked my brain trying to come up with a lawyer I could feel trust in enough to contact about this matter, and have approach you. But there is not such a lawyer known to me. I'm sure you are cognizant as to my overall feelings toward lawyers anyway. In fact - a lawyer, any lawyer, would go

ballistic to get next to me on the case I allude to in this letter. There are a number of reasons why I say this.

Like anything else I step into, I am prepared for any situational encounter that may or may not arise in the matter I seek to come to terms on. I feel you respect my intellectual capacity. It would serve everyone best if this matter I now seek you out about, does not become ~~too~~ botched, so that great embarrassments are avoided. I don't personally get embarrassed, so don't feel that I do. This is a ball that's in your court, on your field, and in your geographical ball park. It would be very foolish to ignore the truly great intensity this matter I ~~am~~ allude to holds.

The first and foremost thing we can do is talk on the phone. But I will make only one (1) demand at this primary stage. Since this is classified as an investigation I want very strict confidentiality. I cannot emphasize this enough. I feel you can maintain this. When we

talk a decision will be made as to how to proceed. It is NOT any of this prison business what you and I have to discuss. This is a confidential legal matter. If I wanted other people to know about this matter, I'd be writing to the media giving them facts not cited herein. I'm very confident the media would go ballistic. If someone gets nosy when you call to set-up a legal call for us, you just cite that it's confidential. Do not entertain conversation. This is not a talk show. It's very serious business!

To set-up a legal call for me to call you collect, you must call here and set an exact date and time. They seem to entertain a dog and pony show here to even achieve a legal call. You can call:

Try to set the legal call up for the week of November 27th, right after Thanksgiving. I cannot emphasize enough the confidential forum I

require. You know how sensitive I am about doing things my way. So respect me as I respect you. I'll not ever lead you with astray. You will understand much more when we talk. You gotta be there at the date and time you set the legal call up for. Remember, we are in different time zones. I believe Florida is two (2) hours ahead.

I'm maintaining copies of this letter. One day I may find it necessary to show that I tried to gain cooperation in the matter I allude to in this letter. It would not be intelligent if subsequent actions are made to become necessary for me to reveal what I just tried to reveal to a Florida authority by this letter. I am very serious. This is why I have taken time to write to you. It's not like I don't have other things I could be doing. Send me a letter if you desire or decline to talk to let me know if we are on for the week of November 27th.
