The following will be a voluntary sworn statement reference to an abduction/homicide/ murder that occurred on or about July 27, 1981, occurring at Hollywood Mall located at 300 Hollywood Mall, Hollywood, Florida, Broward County. This statement is being taken by Det. J. Hoffman #0038 and is being taken from witness identified as McNETT, FAYE, W/F, DOB: 7-16-27 who resides at 8551 Concord Court, Jacksonville, Florida, telephohne 904-764-3560. This statement is being taken at R.B. GAY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY located in Jacksonville, Florida. This statement is commencing on Thursday, October 27, 1983, at approximately 10:10 A.M.

Prior to taking your statement Mrs. McNETT are you aware that it is a crime under the Florida State Statutes to knowingly furnish false information while under oath?

A. I believe if you say so, I'm sorry I'm not familiar with the law.

Q. Okay I am a Notary Public for the State of Florida and I can issue oaths under the law and I'm just advising you that you know, by you maybe making a false statement you would be violating Florida State Statute.

A. Oh yes, any false statement, I'm a Notary also.

Q. Okay fine. At this time I'm going to place you under oath by virtue of my commission as a Notary Public for the State of Florida. Would you please raise your right hand? (Let the record indicate that the witnesses right hand is raised) FAYE McNETT do you solemnly swear to tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth so help you God?

A. I do.

FAYE McNETT HAVING APPEARED BEFORE ME A NOTARY PUBLIC FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA, BROWARD COUNTY, HAVING BEEN DULY SWORN DEPOSES AND STATES:

Q. For the record would you please state your complete given name, date of birth and home address?

A. FAYE R, that's F-A-Y-E, McNETT, my date of birth is July 16, 1927.

Q. And your home address?

A. 8551 Concord Court.

Q. Place of employment?

A. R.B. GAY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY INC.

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Q. How long have you been so employed at this company?

A. On a regular basis since October of '68 but for years in and out before that.

Q. And your position with the company?

A. Public relations.

Q. Okay Mrs. McNETT do you know an individual by the name of OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE?

A. Yes I do.

Q. And how long have you known this individual?

A. Probably since I came back with the company in '68, ah, I'm not sure if he was here then but for ten years checking records he has been around.

Q. How would you describe Mr. TOOLE? What type of person he was?

A. Polite, quiet.

Q. Did he ever work for you?

A. Yes uh huh.

Q. How was he at work?

A. Very good, he worked for the outside men, I'm in the office, but I never heard any complaints about his work.

Q. Okay now at one time Mrs. McNETT did you own a 1971, 4 door Cadillac black vinyl over white body?

A. Yes.

Q. And approximately when did you own that vehicle?

A. I can't remember whether I bought it in '74 or 1975 but in one of years, cause I think it was probably '75, I purchased it in that year.

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Q. And how long did you maintain ownership of that vehicle?

A. I used it for a couple years out at the house I kept it, for a couple of years.

Q. And after a couple years where did you store it?

A. I bought it down here to the office to sell it.

Q. Okay what's the address of the office here?

A. 2031 E. 19th.

Q. And you stored it in a fenced compound?

A. Yes.

Q. Okay is that fenced compound always locked, I mean when the business is closed?

A. When the business is closed it is always locked yes.

Q. Okay fine. Ah do other employees have keys to the compound?

A. Yes.

Q. Now did OTTIS TOOLE have keys to his compound?

A. I am not sure. I would think that OTTIS was one of the personnel that Mr. REAVES would have given a key to lock up if he was gone yes.

Q. Okay ...

A. He could have had a key.

Q. They trusted him with a key?

A. Yes, I mean he could have.

Q. Right.

A. Because he was (inaudible) with locking up and watching out yes.

Q. Did there come a time that Mr. TOOLE inquired of you about selling that

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car, he was interested in purchasing that Cadillac from you?

A. Yes.

Q. Do you know about how long ago that was?

A. I was checking some records, having someone, it seems 1979.

Q. '79 okay. And how much were you selling that vehicle for?

A. I don't remember the price, I'm sorry.

Q. Did OTTIS give you any money for the car in '79?

A. OTTIS had so much a week deducted from his...

Q. From his paycheck?

A. ...right and those are the records I was asking for.

Q. Okay now as money was being deducted from his payroll okay, did he maintain ownership of that vehicle, take it out of the compound and keep it at his house?

A. He could have driven it but I don't believe keeping it.

Q. He just used it?

A. He could have used it. You know he could have come and used it.

Q. Whose tags would have been on that vehicle?

A. Well this would have been my tag on the vehicle.

Q. It was never transferred?

A. No and it wouldn't have been transferred. The only way is like if you would let somebody try the car out to buy it or purchase it but I mean the transaction had not gone through until he paid the whole price, which he did not do and said that I could have it back and didn't want his money, whatever he paid into it, I don't remember the exact amount.

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Q. Alright when he indicated he would like to give the car back to you how long a time period was that he maintained the vehicle?

A. I'd have to check the records, I'm sorry.

Q. Would it be less than a year?

A. It might be just a matter of months because, yeah because somehow, I can't remember, (inaudible) records of it was so much but I believe he paid about \$300 and that would have been like \$25. a week so you can see it wouldn't have been long period of time there.

Q. I see. Now in the summer of 1981 okay, after he gave this car back to you a few months later, did you still maintain that vehicle in the compound?

A. The vehicle was in the compound from the time all of this, that he wanted to purchase it until I got rid of it this year yes.

Q. Okay so it was in the compound?

A. Yes.

Q. Now the keys to that car, did OTTIS give you back the keys to that vehicle?

A. I'm sure he must have given me back the keys, uh huh.

Q. Is it possible that he made up another set of keys for that vehicle?

A. It's possible yeah. The keys were left here on the board in the back.

Q. Now if that vehicle was taken out of the compound, for instance July of 1981 and used by OTTIS for a period of time, okay, would you have noticed it missing?

A. No I wouldn't have noticed it missing.

Q. And why wouldn't you have noticed it missing?

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A. Because I didn't notice everyday if it was there.

Q. You never checked on the vehicle periodically?

A. Never uh uh. The vehicle'd been here for so long it was just something that was there, we have if you notice quite a few vehicles out there.

Q. Right it's a large compouond.

A. Yes and there's other white cars out there and no I would not have noticed.

Q. And no employee ^{ever} brought this to your attention that maybe one day he didn't see the car in the compound?

A. No.

Q. Now you indicated to me earlier that OTTIS worked for another roofing company I believe?

A. Yes.

Q. R.J. Color King.

A. Southeast Color Coat.

Q. Southeast Color Coat?

A. Uh huh, Coat, c-o-a-t.

Q. Where they located?

A. On Market Street.

Q. On Market Street.

A. Excuse me.

Q. Southeast Color Coat that's another roofing company?

A. Yes it is.

Q. Do you know what time period that OTTIS may have worked for that company?

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A. Yes he was working for that company at the time about this automobile he purchased, he was not working for us. He was working for Southeast which was across the street.

Q. Are they still there today?

A. No they moved to Market Street

Q. Okay.

A. He worked for the other company.

Q. I just want to back up on the vehicle one time. When did you finally sell that 1971 Cadillac? You said sometime this year.

A. That was, it was in the last year that we took it over to a used car lot to sell it, to get rid of it.

Q. Did they purchase the car from you or they took it on consignment?

A. Mr. REAVES handled that. They sold it for me really.

Q. Okay fine. Other than OTTIS were there any other employees that used that Cadillac?

A. No not as I know of, no.

Q. I just wanted to see if I could recall your memory to a time period. The summer of 1981, July, I don't know if you could associate that with anything you 've done.

A. You said '81.

Q. 1981, July. Do you recall seeing OTTIS in Jacksonville during that summer?

A. It wouldn't have, ah just seeing him across the street it wouldn't have been unusual and I don't recall.

Q. Would OTTIS ever come to you or Mr. REAVES and borrow money?

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A. Pardon?

Q. Would OTTIS ever approach you or Mr. REAVES and ask for money?

A. He would if he was, he approached the people, only the one he was working for I believe, to take out money you know to borrow but it would be taken out that week.

Q. Who would that be?

A. Well he was working for Southeast Color Coat, he worked for this company previously, I do have a record of about maybe one day in '76 and about a month in '75, I have records on those dates that he worked for REAVES ROOFING but since that time he's worked Southeast.

Q. Southeast. Other than your vehicle that you mentioned did OTTIS have other means of transportation?

A. I don't know. Really, I'm sorry I do not know, I never notices.

Q. Do you know of any close friends or associates of OTTIS' that I might be able to talk to that would know more of him?

A. Only the ah, unless he had a friend among the workman and you could get a list of those, that is all I would know. Only other workman.

Q. Mr. REAVES is he around?

A. Yes he's in the next office.

Q. I see okay.

A. This is Mr. REAVES SR that has REAVES ROOFING. You're talking, if it was Southeast Color Coat that it Mr. REAVES JR, JOHN REAVES JR, that's over on Market street.

Q. So that's who.....

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A. He would know more about him.

Q. ...OTTIS would be referring to, JOHN JR?

A. Yes JOHN JR, that is JOHN SR's son that owns the other and that, I did alot of the taxes and things and that's how I'm familiar with Southeast and the other companies, we have a few companies.

Q. Do you have any of the old documentation on the '71 Cadillac, like the old ownership or anything like that, I may be able to have a copy of?

A. You can get it from WELLS BROTHERS.

Q. Fine, fine.

A. They probably still have the title.

Q. Alright Mrs. McNETT I have no other questions to ask you at this time is there anything else you would like to add to your statement at this time concerning this?

A. No I have some things coming over, they're on their way, some records that might be more explicit from the other companies.

Q. Fine no problem. I'll wait until that information arrives here. Alright I have nothing else to ask you at this time. Has everything in your statement been the complete truth as you know it to be?

A. To the best of my knowledge.
