THE UNDERSIGNED OFFICER CONTACTED THE CLERK AT THE LIL GENERAL STORE LOCATED AT 2960 TAFT STREET IN REFERENCE TO POSSIBLE INFORMATION THAT HE HAD REGARDING THE MISSING JUVENILE ADAM WALSH. THE UNDERSIGNED CONTACTED THE CLERK IDENTIFIED AS GEORGE McMULLEN, W/M 9-4-37 OF 6305 DAWSON STREET PHONE #961-1364. MR. McMULLEN STATED THAT HE HAD OBSERVED THE MISSING JUVENILE AT APPROX 1430 ON 7-27-61 NEAR THE NORTH WEST CORNER OF THE SEARS MALL PARKING LOT. AT THIS TIME HE HAD OBSERVED THE WHITE MALE SPEAKING WITH TWO TEENAGE WHITE MALES STANDING NEXT TO A 1980 OR 81 FORD OR CHEVY WHITE IN COLOR. TWO DOOR POSSIBLY A CHEVETTE WITH A CB ANTENNA ON THE TRUNK. THE TWO WHITE MALES THAT HE WAS SPEAKING WITH ARE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) 19 TO 14 YEARS OLD, 5'7", LONG BLONDE HAIR, WEARING DARK BLUE SHORTS AND A YELLOW T-SHIRT.
- (2) WHITE MALE 14 TO 15 YEARS OLD, SHORTS AND PERSCRPTION TYPE GLASSES, NO FURTHER INFORMATION.

MR. McMULLEN STATED THAT THE YOUNG JUVENILE WAS SPEAKING WITH THESE TWO WHITE MALE TEENAGERS NEXT TO THIS VEHICLE UPON WHICH THE DRIVER'S DOOR WAS OPENED. MR. McMULLEN DID NOT SEE THE JUVENILE ENTERED THE VEHICLE. NO FURTHER INFORMATION.

ANONYMOUS PHONE CALLER ADVISED CAPTAIN KING, OF THE HOLLYWOOD P.D. THAT THE ABOVE VICTIM WAS IN AN ABANDONED BUILDING AT THE ABOVE LOCATION. THE BUILDING HAD THE MARKINGS OF BBC ON THE FRONT OF IT. INVESTIGATION BY THIS OFFICER AND LT. CHAMBERLIN, ALSO OF THE HOLLYWOOD P.D., REVEALED THAT THE BUILDING WAS TOTALLY SECURE, BUT LOOKING INSIDE, IT APPEARED THAT SOMEONE LIVED THERE OR HAD LIVED THERE, AS THERE WAS CLOTHING AND A MATTRESS ON THE FLOOR. THE INSIDE OF THE BUILDING WAS IN TOTAL DISARRAY. IT SHOULD ALSO BE NOTED THAT THERE WAS SEVERAL BEER CANS, TOBACCO, A WINE BOTTLE AND A REFRIGERATOR INSIDE. REPORTEE (ACCETTURO) ADVISES THAT HE WAS IN THE HOLLYWOOD MALL ON MONDAY, THE SAME DAY AS WALSH, ADAM WAS REPORTED MISSING. HE FURTHER ADVISES HE SAW ADAM THAT DAY AND THAT HE SAW TWO WHITE MALES, ONE DESCRIBED AS TALL WITH DIRTY BLOND AFRO TYPE CURLY HAIR, SHOULDER LENGTH, IN THE TOY SECTION IN SEARS. AS ACCETTURO WAS LEAVING THE MALL, HE SAW THE SAME TWO WHITE MALES GET INTO A GREEN VAN AND SPEED OFF. TODAY, ON 07/31/81 AT APPROXIMATELY 2250 HOURS, BOTH REPORTEES STATED THAT THEY SAW THE SAME TWO WHITE MALES THEY SAW IN THE MALL ON MONDAY AT THE CONCA D'ORO RESTAURANT, LOCATED AT 1833 TYLER STREET, REMOVE A BLANKET FROM A GREEN VAN, (THE GREEN VAN HAD TURTLE PAINTED ON ONE SIDE) AND PLACE THIS BLANKET INTO A BLUE STATION WAGON, BEARING PENNSYLVANIA TAG BDD929. AT THIS TIME, THE REPORTEES ARE NOT SURE, BUT IT APPEARS THAT ONE OF THE WHITE MALES GOT INTO A WHITE VAN WITH AN UNIDENTIFIED W/F AND DROVE AROUND YOUNG CIRCLE. THE STATION WAGON WAS REGISTERED TO A B/M, ABRAMS, JOHN S, OF 320 LOCUST AVENUE, ADMORE PENNSYLVANIA, ZIP CODE 19003. THE UNDERSIGNED SPOKE WITH ABRAMS, 02/26/54, WHO IS NOW STAYING AT 1704 POLK STREET, THE POLK HOTEL, ROOM #18. ABRAMS STATED THAT HE KNEW NOTHING OF ANYONE PLACING A BLANKET INTO HIS CAR. HE STATED HE WAS AT 1833 TYLER STREET (CONCA D'ORO RESTAURANT) TONIGHT, ALONG WITH W/M ETHRIDGE, JAMES, 06/15/55, WHO AT THIS TIME, HAS NO CURRENT ADDRESS AND WITH W/M, CADORETTE, DOUG, 05/31/42, WHO IS ALSO STAYING AT THE POLK HOTEL, 1704 POLK STREET, ROOM #18. ALL THREE SUBJECTS STATED THAT THEY KNEW NOTHING ABOUT ANYONE PLACING A BLANKET INTO THE VEHICLE. INSIDE ABRAMS' VEHICLE WERE SEVERAL BLANKETS, CLOTHES, DISHES AND

MISCELLANEOUS HOUSEHOLD GOODS. ABRAMS STATES THESE BELONGINGS BELONG TO ETHRIDGE. ETHRIDGE STATES HE WAS JUST KICKED OUT OF HIS APARTMENT TODAY. THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS FOR ETHRIDGE IS 1725 TAYLOR STREET, APARTMENT 30. FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE ABOVE SUBJECTS, ETHRIDGE AND ABRAMS BOTH WORK FOR THE DIPLOMAT HOTEL (MAINTENANCE) AND W/M CADORETTE WORKS FOR THE ????? POOL, LOCATED AT 21 AND PEMROKE ROAD. THESE THREE SUBJECTS, ETHRIDGE, ABRAMS AND CADORETTE STATED THEY DID NOT SEE A VAN AT THE CONCA D'ORO RESTAURANT, 1933 TYLER STREET, NOR WERE THEY IN THE MALL ON MONDAY.
