On the above stated date and time the undersigned was called out to accompany Sgt. D. Naylor and Det. J. Gibbons to Indian River County Fla. in an investigation of an unknown m/w human head found at mile marker #130 in Indian River County on the Florida Turnpike.

Upon our arrival to the above mentioned location we were conducted to the morgue at Indian River County hospital where Dr. Franklin Cox was in attendance for the examination. The undersigned photographed the human head at 3:00 AM (0300 hrs.) 8-11-81 in the presence of Dr. Cox, Det. Naylor and Det. Gibbons.

After photographing the human head the undersigned returned to mile marker #130 with the above mentioned detectives and with representatives of the Indian County Sheriff's Dept. and Highway Patrol where a search was conducted for physical evidence was conducted. No physical evidence was found at this time.

At 12:40 PM (1240 hrs) the undersigned took possession of the human head which had been identified as that of ADAM WALSH and was then flown to the Broward County Medical Examiner's Office by Channel 7's helicopter to turn over same to Mr. D.P. Hughes (See property slip signed by Mr. Hughes at 2:15 PM (1415 hrs.).

Photos taken by this writer were turned over to Det. Hoffman at headquarters and the negatives were filed in homicide case folder.

NOTE: LATENT PRINTS ON FILE IN HOLLYWOOD WERE TURNED OVER TO SGT. NAYLON FOR FUTURE POSSIBLE IDENTIFICATION. TIME TURNED OVER 12:55PM (1255 hrs.).
