DISTURBANCE (DOC)

NARRATIVE

4/13/81, 1740 HOURS, THIS OFFICER WHILE WORKING A SPECIAL POLICE DETAIL, AT BROWARD GENERAL MEDICAL CENTER, EMERGENCY ROOM, WAS APPROACHED BY EMERGENCY ROOM RN KATHLEEN CAMPBELL AND ADVISED THAT THE ARRESTED SUBJECT JACK CHARLES WOLFF, WAS BEING ALLOWED TO VISIT WITH HIS WIFE, ADA WOLFF, WHO HAD BEEN BROUGHT INTO THE ER FOR A DRUG OVERDOSE.

ADA WOLFF HAD BEEN BAKER ACTED UNDER THE STATE MENTAL CODE BY DOCTOR DEMORES, FOR THE OVERDOSE, DUE TO THE FACT IT HAD OCCURRED SEVERAL TIMES IN THE PAST THREE YEARS. EACH TIME ADA WOLFF WAS NEAR DEATH FROM THE OVERDOSE.

THE ARRESTED WOLFF, WAS DEMANDING THAT SHE BE RELEASED FROM THE HOSPITAL AND SENT HOME. WOLFF, ADVISED THAT HE WAS GOING TO SIGN HIS WIFE OUT OF THE HOSPITAL AGAINST MEDICAL ADVISE. WOLFF, WAS TOLD HE COULD NOT, DUE TO THE FACT THAT HIS WIFE WAS BAKER ACTED FOR HER PROTECTION. WOLFF, WAS ALLOWED TO SEE HIS WIFE, BUT WAS TOLD HE WOULD HAVE TO LEAVE AFTER THE VISIT, BY DOCTOR DEMORES AND RN CAMPBELL.

AFTER THE VISIT, IN THE TREATMENT AREA OF THE ER, WOLFF, WAS TOLD BY NURSE CAMPBELL, THAT HE WOULD HAVE TO LEAVE, SO THAT HIS WIFE COULD RECEIVE MEDICAL CARE. WOLFF, REFUSED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES. WOLFF, WAS TOLD, IF HE WISHED TO FILE A COMPLAINT, TO CALL THE DUTY HOSPITAL ADMINISTRATOR, BUT IN THE MEANTIME, HE WOULD HAVE TO LEAVE THE HOSPITAL GROUNDS.

JACK WOLFF, REFUSED TO CALL THE ADMINISTRATOR OR LEAVE THE PREMISES WITHOUT HIS WIFE. THIS ENTIRE INCIDENT OCCURRED IN THIS OFFICER'S PRESENCE. WOLFF, WAS THEN TOLD BY THIS OFFICER, THAT HE WOULD HAVE TO LEAVE, OR FACE THE POSSIBILITY OF BEING PLACED UNDER ARREST FOR TRESPASSING AFTER WARNING. WOLFF, STILL REFUSED TO LEAVE. THIS OFFICER WAS ADVISED BY RN CAMPBELL, THAT HE DID NOT LEAVE, SHE WOULD PRESS CHARGES ON BEHALF OF BGMG.

WOLFF, WAS AGAIN TOLD TO LEAVE AND HE AGAIN REFUSED. AT THIS TIME, WOLFF, WAS TOLD BY THIS OFFICER THAT HE WAS UNDER ARREST FOR TRESPASSING. AS THIS OFFICER APPROACHED WOLFF, HE ATTEMPTED TO PUSH ME AWAY. OFFICER SOUTHWORTH ALSO IN THE E. R., SAW THE COMMOTION AND CAME TO THE AID OF THIS OFFICER. WOLFF, BEGAN TO STRUGGLE WITH THESE OFFICERS, TRYING TO AVOID ANY ATTEMPT TO PLACE THE HANDCUFFS ON HIS WRIST. DUE TO THE FACT, THAT THERE WERE TWO

OFFICERS, WOLFF, WAS ABLE TO BE SUBDUED WITHOUT ANY BODILY HARM TO HIS PER-  
SON.

THIS OFFICER, (IVES) WAS CUT ON THE RIGHT THUMB AND MY RIGHT RING FINGER  
NAIL WAS TORN DOWN TO THE FLESH, BOTH MINOR INJURIES. DUE TO THE STRUGGLE  
AND THE INJURY TO THIS OFFICER, WOLFF, WAS CHARGED WITH TRESPASSING AFTER  
WARNING AND RESISTING ARREST WITHOUT VIOLENCE.

WOLFF, WAS TAKEN TO THE E. R. RAMP, FRISKED, AND ADVISED OF HIS RIGHTS BY  
THIS OFFICER IN THE PRESENCE OF OFFICER SOUTHWORTH. A COMPLAINT AFFIDAVIT  
WAS SIGNED BY RN CAMPBELL AND NOTORIZED. THE PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT WAS  
WRITTEN BY THIS OFFICER AND WAS NOTORIZED. ALL THE PAPER WORK WAS TURNED  
OVER TO OFFICER GARDNER AND SENT WITH WOLFF TO BE BOOKED IN THE ANNEX JAIL.
